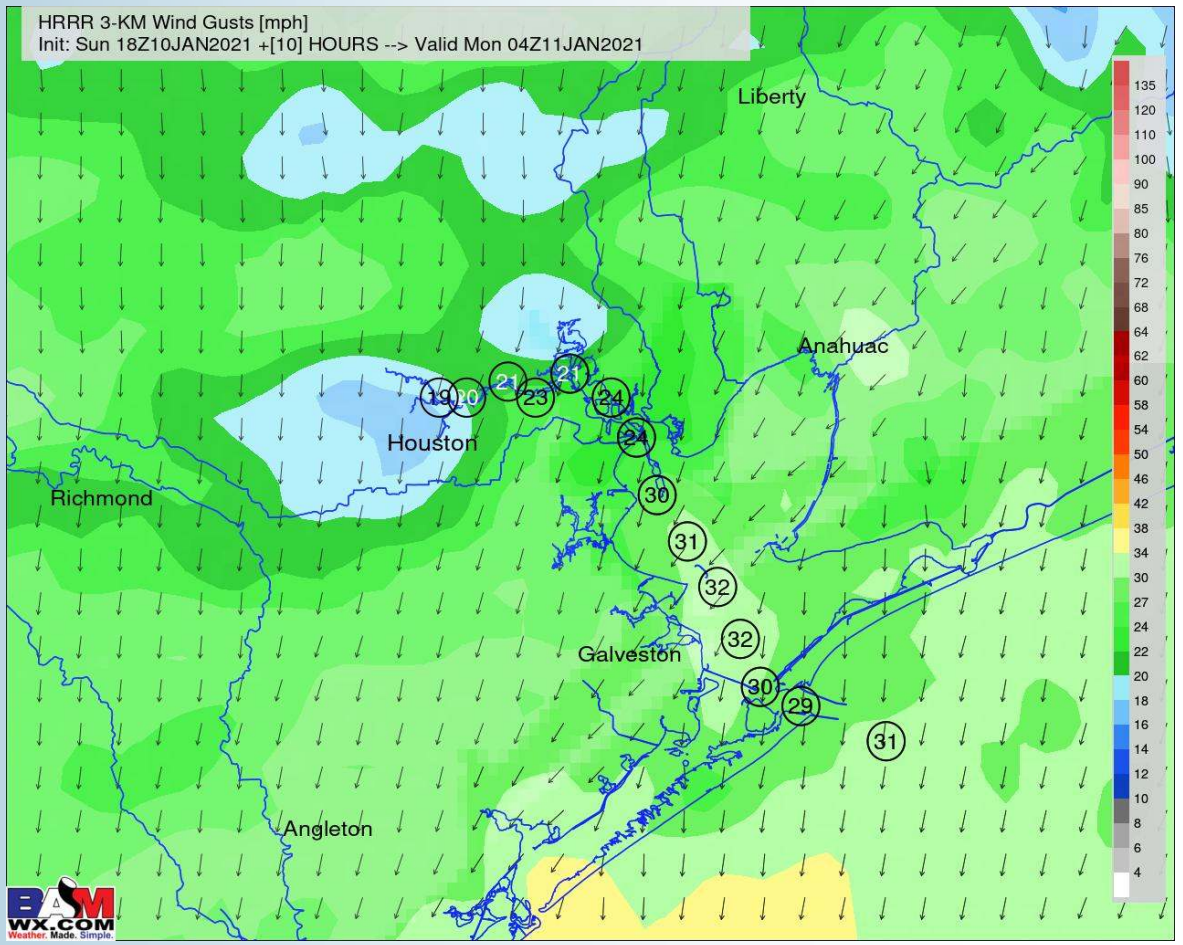

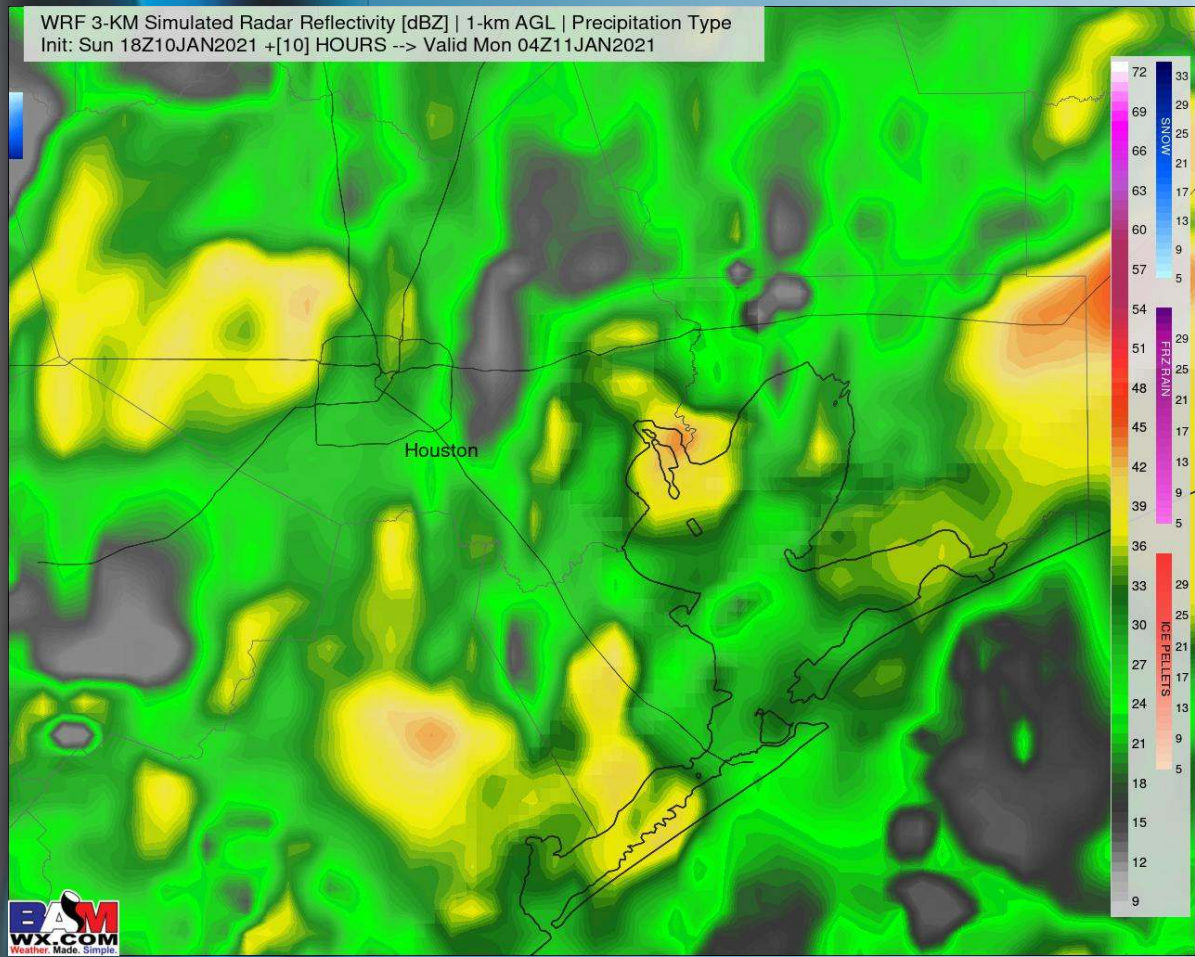
Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- A widespread area of broken moderate to locally heavy rain continues this afternoon for the area. Under some of the heavier rain showers, visibilities could reduce to 1 – 3 miles at times. Rain continues off/on though 12AM with some spotty sprinkles/mist lingering into the AM.
- Winds look to generally be out of the NE/ ENE throughout the rest of the day with a gradual increase in winds. Winds are currently sustained at 15 – 20 MPH+ with gusts of 20 – 30 MPH. This likely continues though the evening hours with a few gusts of 30+ not out of the question. Isolated higher gusts will be possible under any stronger pulses of rain/ storms that can form. Winds begin to slowly shift more out of the north approaching midnight.
- Temperatures inland are in the upper-30s with 40s over water, with most areas dropping into the mid-30s tonight.
- No fog is anticipated but lower visibilities will be possible under more moderate/ heavy burst of rain mainly this afternoon and evening.

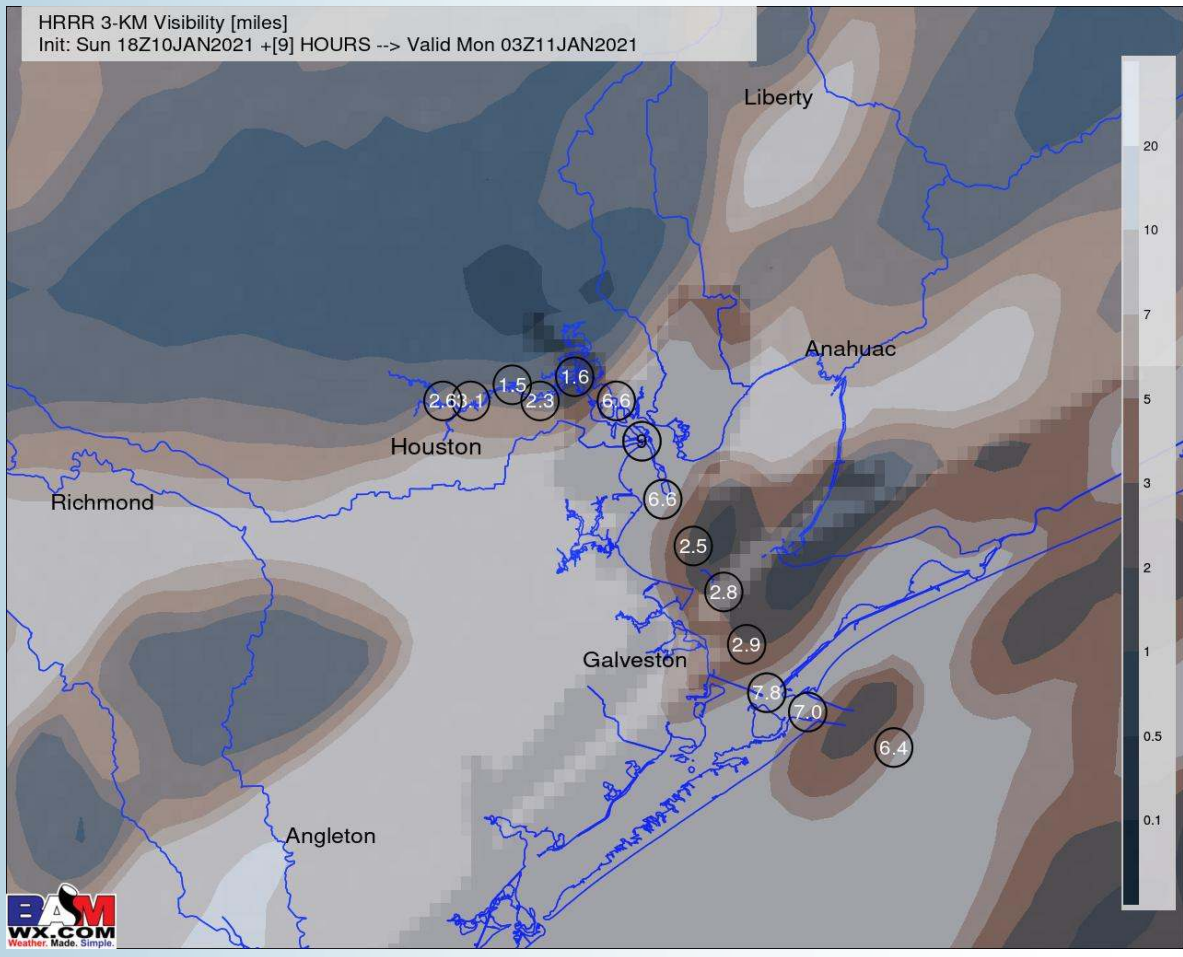
Sustained Winds (2 PM CT)

Scattered lower vis. under heavier rain:

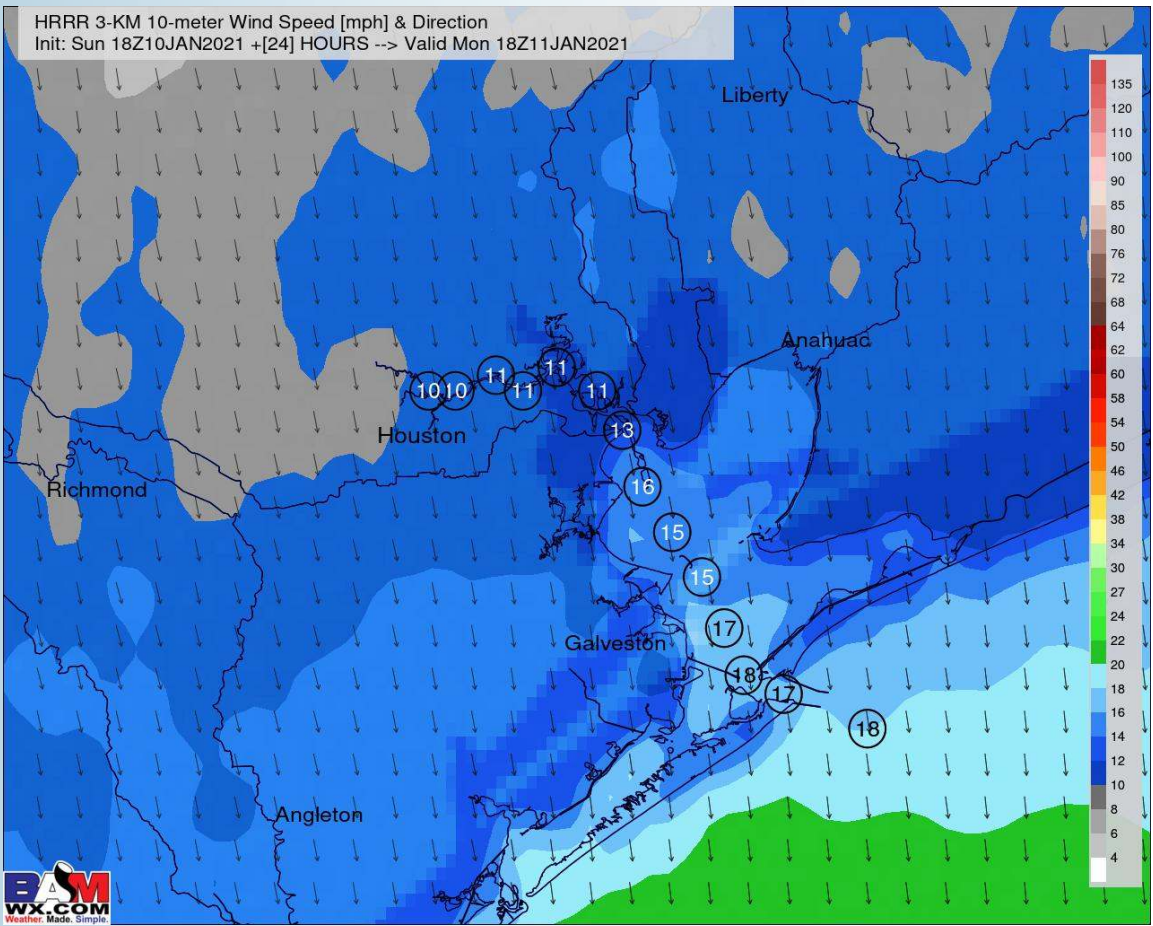


Short-Term Forecast Discussion

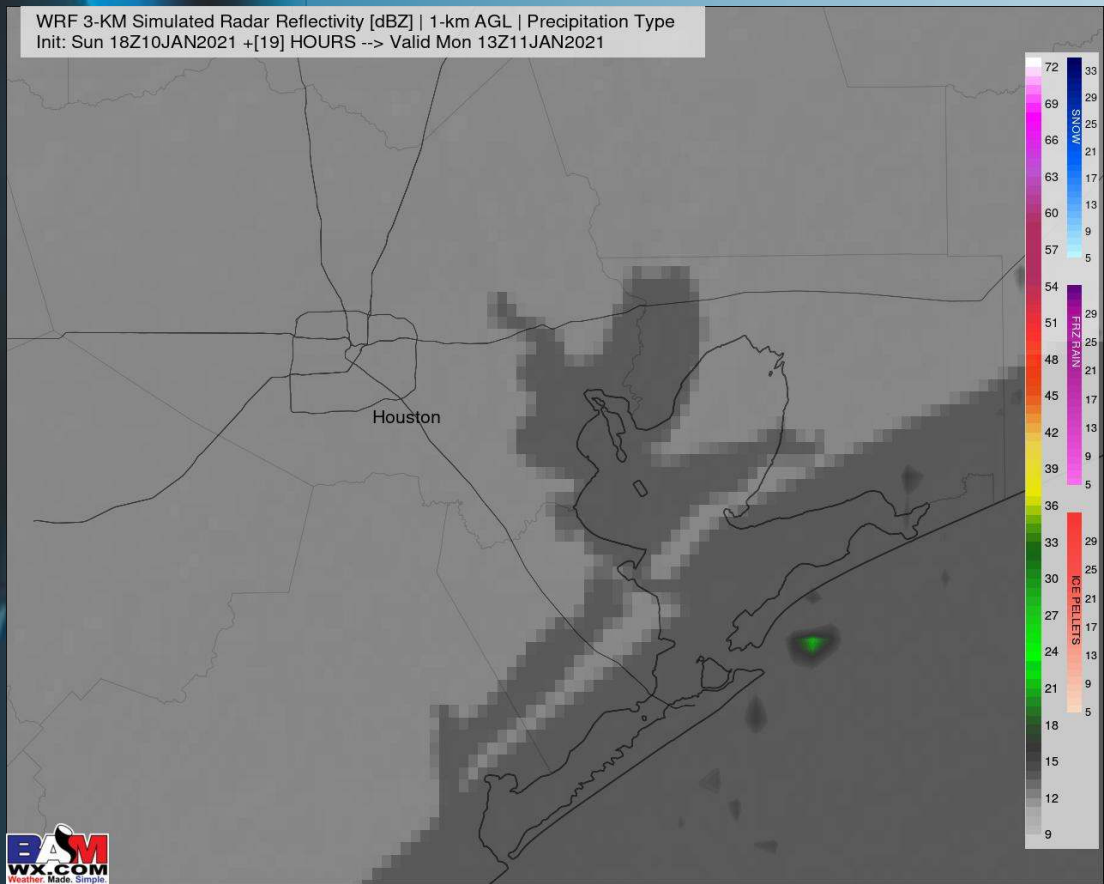
- As the low departs off to the east, drier weather is anticipated on Monday, with the exception of a few spotty showers lingering through 2-3 AM, perhaps a few sprinkles into the early AM hours.
- Winds look to remain out of the N throughout the day on Monday. Sustained winds in the AM for most of the area look to continue to remain around 15 – 25 MPH before calming down to around 10 – 20 MPH about 10-11 AM. Gusts of ~25-30 MPH for the boarding station in the morning will give way to gust potential around 15 – 25 MPH about 10-11 AM.
- High Temperatures will be in the mid 40s.
- No fog is expected Monday

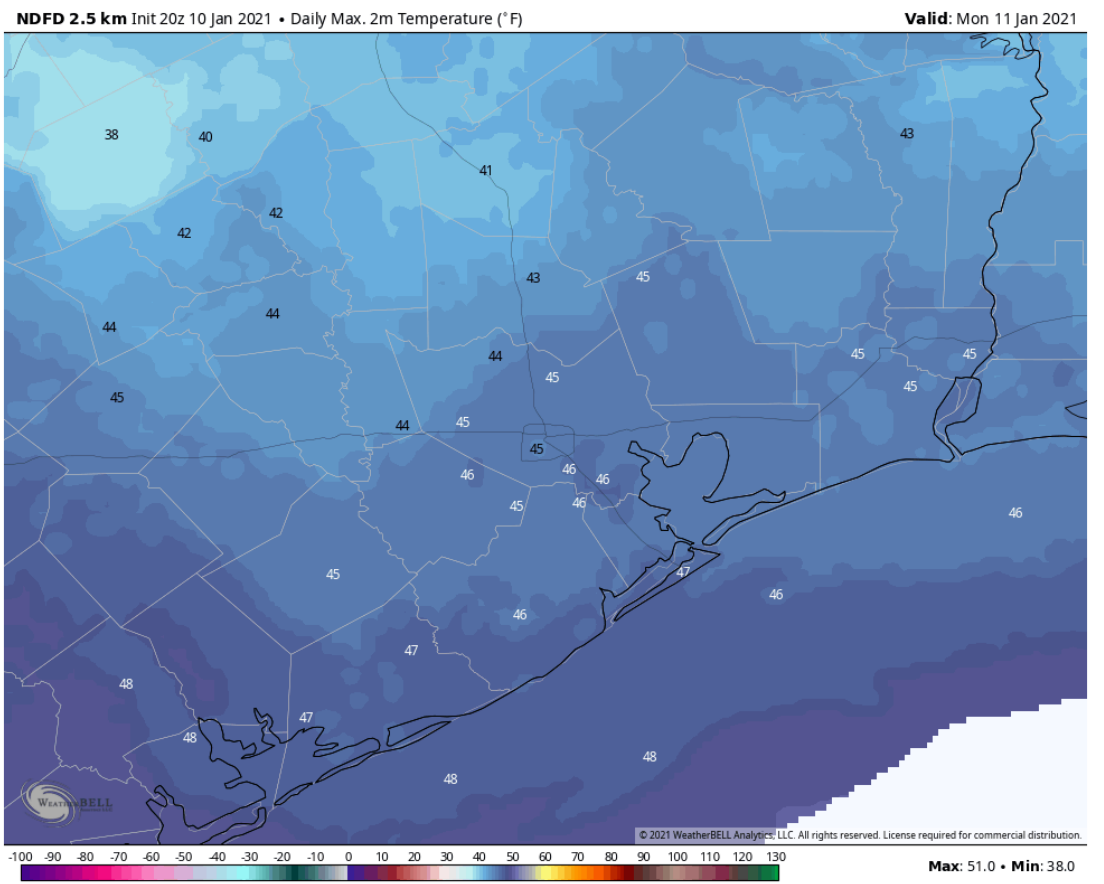
Sustained Winds (12 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (7 AM CT)



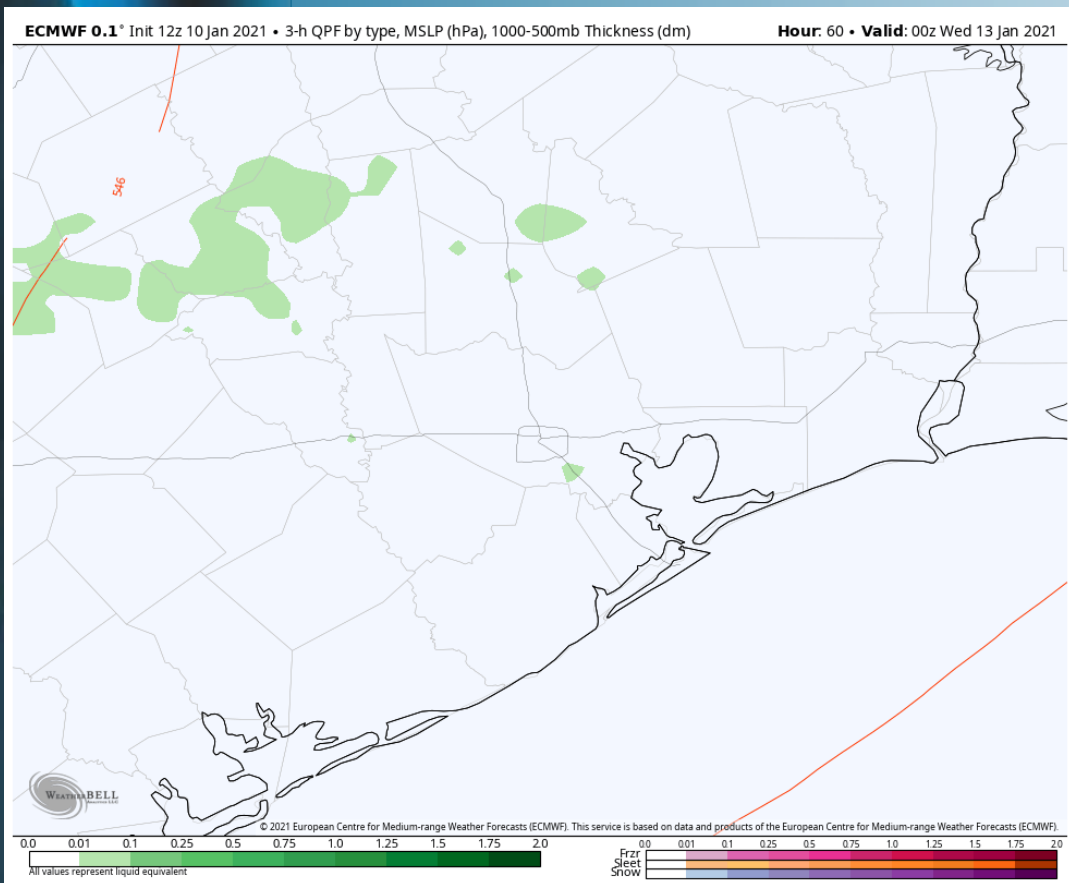

Short-Term Forecast Discussion

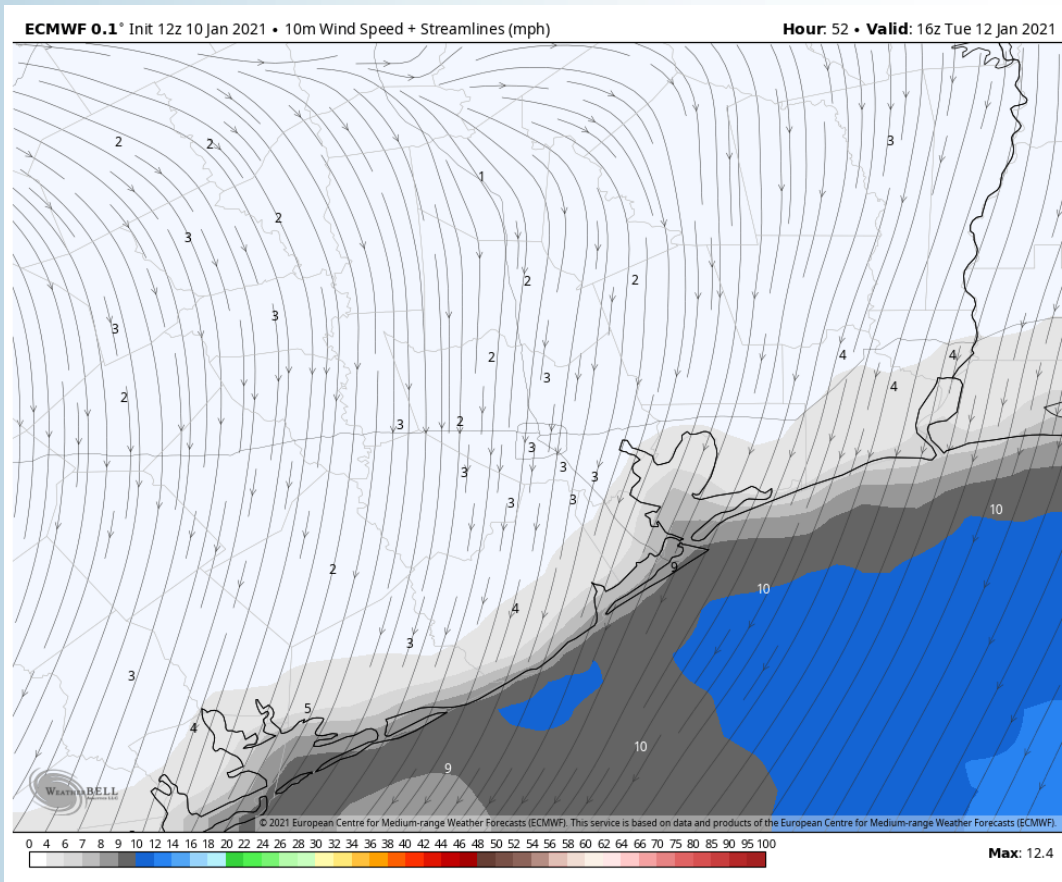
- Tuesday will be a mostly dry day, but cannot 100% rule out a few sprinkles late in the day given a weak disturbance moving through the area.
- Winds will come from the N/ NE sustained at 5-15 MPH with the boarding station having gusts 15-20 MPH early in the day. Working into the afternoon winds will shift NW with sustained winds dropping to ~ 5 MPH and gusts dropping to 10 MPH
- High temperatures for Tuesday will be in the low 50s.
 - No Fog anticipated at this time.

Simulated Radar Snapshot (6 PM CT)

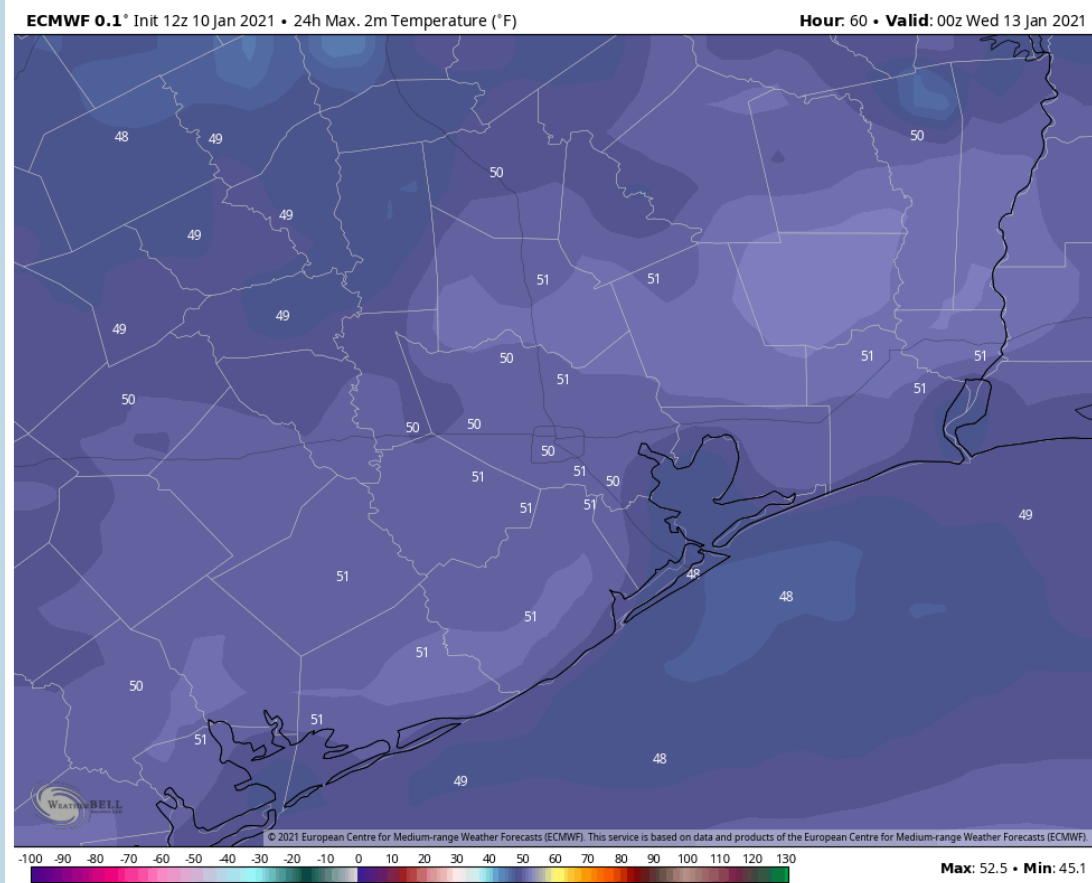


Tuesday, January 12th, 2021

Sustained Winds (10 AM CT)



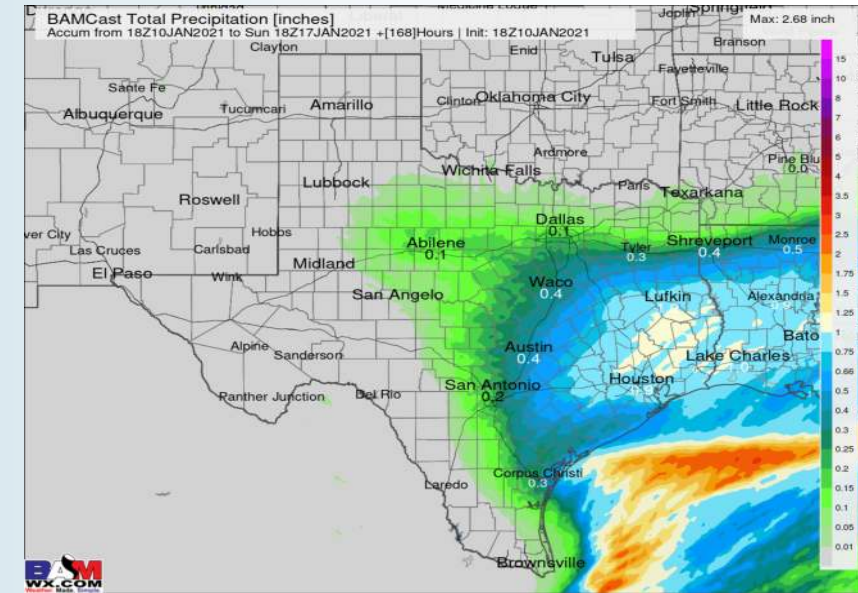
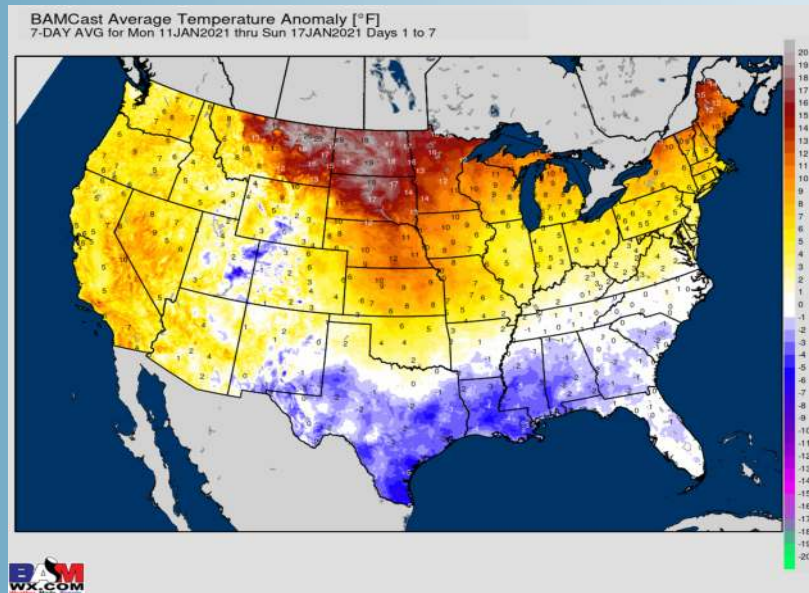
High Temperatures Tuesday



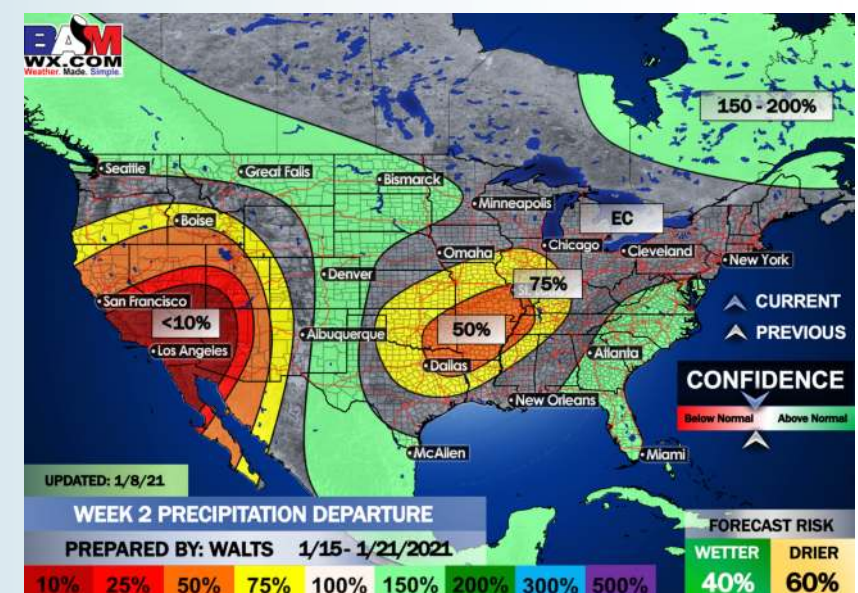
Week 1 Forecast

Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- Below normal temperatures in the wake of the upcoming low pressure system are anticipated through WED before temperatures begin to moderate into next weekend. Outside of the low pressure system tomorrow, mostly dry conditions are anticipated this week with only minor chances on Friday.
- Our latest favored week 2 guidance features the Houston area at below normal temps and about normal precipitation. Periodic shots of precipitation will be possible as these fronts pass the area.
- Our latest weeks $\frac{3}{4}$ outlooks feature the Houston area with above normal temperatures and slightly below normal precipitation. Periodic frontal passages will offer up some moisture with longer stretches of drier weather in between.
