



Fog Report

> Confidence is high in is in the reduction of visibility/ fog being present but confidence is down due to exact timing with model variance and not matching with current conditions. Mist/ haze will continue through the afternoon. As we work later into the evening ~5-7PM fog will begin to reestablish itself as we work into the morning. As the front passes tomorrow early tomorrow morning and winds shift to be more northerly we could see fog lift around 10AM. Into the evening fog will reestablish itself into Saturday.

The greatest risk for fog/ haze will be for stations south of Exxon Station I but stations to its north may have patchy isolated fog..




Today will have some light showers in the area with the bulk moving out around the 7-9PM timeframe. Isolated sprinkles are possible into the overnight into FRI.

- Check slides above for info on fog. Fog is likely to persist throughout the day


Simulated Radar Snapshot (10 PM CT)



- Once again, confidence is high that fog will be present but the timing of changes in fog conditions is where confidence is low. Fog Thursday night will linger into Friday morning as we favor patchy fog to be around the area out through at least the ~9-10 AM timeframe. The best potential period for improved visibility will come ~10 AM into the early afternoon hours ~1-3 PM for stations north.
- Into the evening and nighttime hours Friday night, winds will have a bit more of a northerly flow so while fog will still be favored for locations south of Morgan's Point, if we back off the fog potential in the coming reports the wind direction would likely be the reason why. North of Morgan's Point iso patchy fog cannot be ruled out but is not currently favorable.






- Today's system will continue to bring light rain showers in the morning moving out around the 10AM timeframe with isolated sprinkles through the day.
- Sustained winds will be out of the SW ~3-8 MPH for stations all stations. Around 7-9PM winds will be 8-13 MPH south of Morgan's point with general E direction. 9-11 PM winds will be out of NE
- ➢ High temperatures will be in the mid 60s.


Sustained Winds (5 PM CT)



Short-Term Forecast Discussion


- Into Saturday some sprinkles will persist and have the possibility of an isolated t-storm into the late evening around 8-11PM and into SUN.
- Winds will be out of the E/NE with Morgan's point and points south will be at 10-15 MPH while points north will be at 5-10 MPH. Around 10AM-12 PM winds will shift E. Around 5-8 PM sustained winds will shift SE.
 - High temperature will be in the low 60s
- We are looking at fog lasting from FRI into SAT afternoon. Details will be fine tuned closer to the event







 Above normal temperatures in the wake of last weekend's low pressure system are anticipated for most of the week.
Mostly dry conditions are anticipated this week with chances on FRI and SAT.


- Our latest favored week 2 guidance features the Houston area at above normal temps and below normal precipitation.
