





## Fog Report

## Friday, January 22, 2021

- Confidence continues to be higher than normal for our reduced visibility (fog/mist/light showers) to linger around the area in an on/off fashion into the weekend, however we have really seen guidance struggle with exact timing on when fog lifts/breaks. With that said, we are currently in favor of reduced visibility gradually increasing for the boarding stations as we go throughout the morning hours before potential improvement in visibility as we get into the early afternoon hours with the passing of a weaker boundary. Currently favoring visibility to decrease as we work more into the morning hours before the ~11 AM- 1 PM timeframe when we see that weak boundary pass through the area that will shift our winds to the North and provide a bit less favorable set up for fog.
- If the wind shift is weaker than expected, areas south of the Exxon station run the risk of holding on to reduced visibility into the afternoon/evening as a low cloud deck/ fog will be possible. Regardless of the effects of the boundary, the threat for fog/reduced visibility for areas S of Exxon look to gradually weaken heading into the overnight (~9-11 PM and beyond) as winds have more of a northeasterly direction and are a bit stronger.)






#### **Short-Term Forecast Discussion**

- A front moving through this morning will bring light rain showers and will move out around the 10-11AM timeframe with isolated sprinkles possible through the rest of the day.
  - ➤ Sustained winds will be out of the SW ~3-8 MPH for all stations slowly shifting N into the noon timeframe. Into the afternoon and evening winds will shift E/NE around 7-9PM with wind speeds at 8-13 MPH south of Morgan's Point.
  - > High temperatures will be in the mid 60s.
  - Check slide above for fog info. Potential increase in visibility into the afternoon.


#### **Simulated Radar Snapshot (8 AM CT)**

#### Visibility (9 AM CT)










- For areas North of Morgan's Point, while reduced visibility is possible starting around 12-1 AM and lasting out through the early morning hours (8-9 AM) in a patchy nature, atmospheric profiles are not as supportive of this even though reduced visibility is being output. This time period will need to be watched closely and will be updated in our afternoon report. Currently not favoring fog for this window, however as mentioned above it is still a risk to monitor
- Confidence does increase however for the pattern into the daytime hours Saturday. A northeast wind of 8-13 with gusts 13-18 MPH for the boarding station likely keeps the fog threat diminished throughout the day before the fog threat will return again around the ~11 PM timeframe Sat night into Sunday morning. Fog/ reduced visibility will be favored in a patchy nature for that time period for all boarding stations the way things currently look








#### ➤ Saturday will have some isolated sprinkles/ mist throughout the day. A rumble of thunder cannot be ruled out ~8-11PM timeframe.

- ➤ Winds will be out of the E/NE with Morgan's Point and points south sustained at 10-15 MPH and gust of 15-20 MPH while points north will be at 5-10 MPH. Around 10AM-12 PM winds will shift E. Around 10-11 PM winds will shift SE.
  - > High temperature will be in the low 60s


#### **Sustained Winds (12 PM CT)**




# ➤ Sunday scattered showers/mist will likely persist due to fog and a potential isolated t-storm could be possible with the highest likelihood ~6-11PM

- ➤ Sunday winds will be SE at 5-10 MPH north of Morgan's Point and 10-15 MPH to the south. ~6-9 AM winds will shift S. Winds will increase to 15-20 MPH ~10AM-12PM. Gusts will be ~20-25 MPH throughout the day.
- High temperatures Sunday will be in the mid 60s.
- We are looking at fog continuing to persist into SUN AM. We will fine tune as we get closer


#### Simulated Radar Snapshot (6 AM CT)





# Long-Range Forecast Discussion


