


Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Winds will be out of the SE on Monday night, weak at around 4-8 MPH.
- Low temps tonight will drop down to near 60F.
- Please reference the updated fog slide for a more detailed discussion on Tuesday morning's widespread fog risk.


Sustained Winds (2 AM CT)

Low Temperatures Monday Night









Fog Report

- (No change) The middle portion of this week holds the potential to see some decent shots at fog in the Tuesday
 Thursday timeframe. Onshore flow will be the theme for the next few days until Thursday evening when a cold front will swing through the area and take any fog chances out to sea.
- Higher than normal confidence that fog will be a concern Tuesday AM thanks to all model guidance showing a rather strong signal for a surface temperature inversion. We are currently favoring after 10-11 PM tonight (reference slide 2) for the on-set of the dense fog, becoming more widespread and dense especially after midnight tonight. Right now we think this fog can linger through 9-10 AM on Tuesday morning being both widespread and dense...after about 10 AM we anticipate the fog to start to become less widespread.






Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Right now Tuesday is expected to be drier as well, however, an iso sprinkle/shower or two (10-20%) looks possible in the afternoon hours.
- Winds look to stay generally out of the SE on Tuesday and rather light, 5-10 MPH sustained.
- High temps for our stations look to be sitting in the upper 60s / lower 70s, locally higher inland.
- Lower confidence on Fog right now on Tuesday after 10 AM. We will need to fine-tune on Tuesday AM how long the fog will likely linger throughout the day as the data right now is split. We do think there's an increased risk that fog can re-develop into the PM hours at this distance.


Sustained Winds (2 PM CT)

High Temperatures Tuesday








Wednesday, February 10th, 2021

Short-Term Forecast Discussion


Similar to the first 2 days of the week, right now favoring the AM hours to be on the drier side of things, with a slight sprinkle/shower chance possible into the PM hours.

- ➤ Winds look to increase on Wednesday out of the South, sustained at 8-13 MPH, gusting up to 15-20 MPH at times.
- High temps for our stations look to be sitting in the upper 60s / lower 70s, locally higher inland.
- Right now we think there's an increased chance for fog risks pre-dawn Wednesday AM, but given uncertainty in the model data, confidence remains on the lower side in terms of the the expansiveness. Check back.


Sustained Winds (2 PM CT)

High Temperatures Wednesday











Long-Range Forecast Discussion


- ➤ Chances for precipitation look to come back into the picture WED FRI.
 Currently targeting THU evening for the best widespread rain chances.
 Temperatures largely stay above normal this week before a frontal passage THU evening, ushering in colder air into next weekend.
- The pattern turns much colder than normal for week 2 here...with a bit more influential jet stream we think the pattern can continue to grow wetter vs normal.
- "Normal" conditions regarding temps vs normal look in store for the 2nd half of February to early March...we think precipitation may still stay on the active side of things.
