




Fog Report


Below Normal	Above Normal
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- **Widespread fog is expected to continue out through about 9-10 AM this morning. Beyond 9-10 AM, we favor fog to become much more patchy in nature and a few breaks in the cloud deck will be possible. Overall best chances to hold on to fog would be near the boarding station while the chances to see breaks in the fog would increase the further you work to the 610 bridge station.**
- **The better chances for the breaks in the fog look to wind down beyond the 4-5 PM window where fog likely will gradually re-introduce itself in more of a widespread and dense nature. The further we go into the evening hours, the more dense and widespread fog will likely become. Locations South of Morgan's Point will once again be looking at periods where visibility is less than 1 mile.**





Locations N of Morgan's Point will continue to be the area where fog is likely not as widespread.***





- **Monday comes with lower confidence as multiple details affecting fog are still a bit uncertain.**
- **Fog is favored for all of our stations into the morning hours of Monday, but the uncertainty comes in whether fog can linger through the entire day and into Tuesday morning, or whether the fog can lift into the afternoon hours with the passing of the cold front. *As of now* we are favoring for Monday mid-day to feature to a possible break in the fog before potential reformation Monday evening with the front then passing in the early AM hours Tuesday and wiping the fog out, but these details can certainly change.**


Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Today is not expected to see any widespread rain showers working through the area and should generally stay precipitation free, however some mist/ light drizzle from our low clouds / fog will still be possible.
- The first half of the day we are anticipating winds to be 8-13 MPH sustained. After ~1 PM, sustained winds coming from the south are favored at 10-15 MPH with a few gusts 15-20 MPH possible
- Highs today will likely be sitting in the upper 60s over water, warmer over the land


Sustained Winds (12 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (1 PM CT)




High Temperatures Today




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Sunday's precip will be similar to today- an overall drier day is anticipated, however an isolated pocket of mist/drizzle will still be possible at any point
- Sunday we are anticipating winds to continue coming out of the S, sustained at 8-13 MPH with a few gusts 13-18 MPH not out of the question.
- Highs will be in the upper 60s for the boarding station


Sustained Winds (2 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (1 PM CT)




High Temperatures Sunday




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Overall high uncertainty on the forecast (winds/precip/fog) on Monday as there is a decent spread within guidance on timing and features with an approaching front. Right now we are favoring a few iso AM showers to give way to better PM chances which includes the potential of a few thunderstorms. Details certainly need refined going forward.
- Winds starting out Monday will be sustained 8-13 MPH with a few isolated gusts 13-18 MPH possible at the boarding station. Lower confidence exists on Mon Evening as guidance really varies on timing/ placement of our next front
- High temps Monday will hover around the upper 60s over the water


Sustained Winds (8 AM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (3 PM CT)





High Temperatures Monday





Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- Temps will continue to stay above normal for the next 7 days with no arctic air expected. Aside from minimal precip chances the next few days, late Monday and into Tuesday look to hold the next best potential for more widespread rains across the area
- Early March we continue to favor slightly above normal temps with below normal precipitation for this time of year.
- Into mid-late March we are favoring above normal temps for Texas and below normal precip as the upper air pattern does not look favorable for precip.
