## **Short-Term Forecast Discussion**


An overall dry day is expected today across the boarding stations, with a few isolated showers to the west possible in the PM hours.

NE winds sustained around 10 – 15 MPH over open waters with gusts near 20 MPH will begin to shift out of the SE into the early afternoon (should be ESE by roughly  $\sim 2 - 4$  PM). Winds into the afternoon continue to be out of the SE sustained around 8-13 MPH with gusts around 20 MPH possible.


High temperatures look to get into the mid to upper 60's F over open waters.

As of this morning, we are not anticipating fog tonight into Tuesday morning, as winds look to stay up just enough to reduce the threat.


# Sustained Winds (4 PM CT)


#### **Short-Term Forecast Discussion**

Spotty rain chances will be possible in the AM hours of Tuesday into the early afternoon as a warm front moves through the Houston area...dry weather improves after 4-5pm CT.


- After the warm front passes in the AM, winds should begin to pick up into the PM. Winds look to be sustained around 10 – 15 MPH with gust of 20 - 25 MPH possible.
- High Temperatures look to get into the mid to upper 70's F on Tuesday.

TUE night into WED morning may offer up a better potential for fog as winds relax WED morning out ahead of another boundary. Data is not picking up on this yet but will need to be monitored.


# Sustained Winds (4 PM CT)

### **High Temperatures Tues**






# Wednesday, March 31st, 2021

#### **Short-Term Forecast Discussion**


A cold front is anticipated to sweep north to south on Wednesday, with a thunderstorm chance increasing right now from ~11am – 6pm CT as it stands right now.

- Winds stay out of the south through late morning on Wednesday around 4-8 MPH. Winds shift out of the north as a cold front sweeps through after 12/1pm CT, increasing to winds sustained ~13-18 MPH (gusts up to 25-35 MPH possible).
  - High Temperatures look to get near 70 F on Wednesday over open waters.
- > Not expecting fog on Wednesday night at this time.


### Sustained Winds (2 PM CT)





#### Long-Range Forecast Discussion

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**Houston Pilots** 


- Precipitation chances this week will be spotty at best, looking to be quite below the "normal" for this time of year. Temperatures will average out slightly below normal as a whole over the next week as well.
  - Currently anticipating Houston to be far enough removed from the subtropical jet influence for near normal to slightly below normal moisture risk for the week 2 timeframe. Temperatures are anticipated to average out to near normal.
- Expectations are for a more favorable pattern for precipitation risk for the Houston area for weeks 3 + 4. Temperatures are anticipated to average out to near normal for this time frame.
