

Fog Report

Tuesday, March 30thth, 2021



We think sea fog is going to be possible tonight, with still some lower confidence on expansiveness (due to weather model disagreements), from 1am-8am CT Wednesday morning (right now looking more like from stations 1/2 Bravo to 37/38).

- **We think after 8am CT, the threat can start to diminish out of the Bay areas.**
 - > This threat will need to be fine-tuned more in this afternoon's report.



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

Short-Term Forecast Discussion


Spotty rain chances will be possible in the late AM hours of today into the early afternoon as a warm front moves through the Houston area...dry weather improves after 4-5pm CT.

- Winds look to be out of the South today, sustained around 12 – 17 MPH with gusts of 20 - 25 MPH possible (isolated gusts up to 30mph possible at times through 5/6pm CT).
- High temperatures look to get into the low to mid 70s F today over the Boarding Stations.
- Please refer to the fog slide above this slide for fog risks tonight into Wednesday morning.






Simulated Radar Snapshot (12 PM CT)



High Temperatures Tues






Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- A cold front is anticipated to sweep north to south on Wednesday, with a thunderstorm chance increasing from ~12pm – 6pm CT as it stands right now.
- Winds stay out of the South through late morning on Wednesday around 4-8 MPH. Winds shift out of the North as a cold front sweeps through after 12/1pm CT, increasing to winds sustained ~15-20 MPH (gusts up to 25-35 MPH, isolated higher possible).
 - High temperatures look to get near 70 F on Wednesday over the Boarding Stations.
- Not expecting fog on Wednesday night to Thursday morning at this time.


Sustained Winds (3 PM CT)

High Temperatures Wed





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
Short-Term Forecast Discussion

Thursday is anticipated to be a dry day, with high pressure overhead. The forecast, overall, into the weekend looks to remain dry for the area as well.


- Winds stay out of the Northeast through the morning hours at 13-18 MPH, weakening after lunch through the evening to 8-13 MPH sustained.
- High temperatures look to dip down to the low to mid 60s F over the Boarding Stations on Thursday.

 Not expecting fog on Thursday night at this time.


Simulated Radar Snapshot (3 PM CT)







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Houston Pilots

- Precipitation chances this week will be spotty at best, looking to be quite below the "normal" for this time of year. Temperatures will average out slightly below normal as a whole over the next week as well, but nothing notable.
 - We are starting to eye increasing rainfall potential vs normal in the HOU area for week 2, temps are still anticipated to be slightly above normal as well.
- Expectations are for a more favorable pattern for precipitation risk for the Houston area for weeks 3 + 4. Temperatures are anticipated to average out to near normal for this time frame.








Week 2 Forecast
