


## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Continuing to favor a dry rest of the day
- Winds are looking to come from the S/SE sustained 18-23 MPH with gusts 23-28 MPH. A few localized gusts to 30 MPH will be possible beyond sundown tonight
- Lows tonight likely drop back into the mid 70s
  - *No fog expected today.*


## Sustained Winds (7 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (10 PM CT)




## Low Temps this Evening




## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- While most of Sunday looks to stay quieter, a few isolated showers will be possible beginning ~mid-day. Chances of this look to be rather low ~10-20%. Bulk of rain chances likely stay to the north.
- Winds on our Sunday look to be coming out of the S, sustained 15-20 MPH with gusts 23-28 MPH
- Temperatures look to get into the lower 80's F over open waters. Warmer temperatures further inland.
- *No fog expected.*


## Sustained Winds (3 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (3 PM CT)






## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Overall drier conditions are favored for Monday. Any chances look to be quite minimal (10% or less). Rain chances look to mostly remain to the north/ east.
  - Winds late Sunday night into early Monday morning will gradually calm, becoming sustained closer to 8-13 MPH with gusts 13-18 MPH. Winds look to be sustained from the SSE.
  - Highs look to sit in the upper 70s / lower 80s over open waters. Temperatures approach 90 F further inland
- No fog expected Monday


## Sustained Winds (1 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (1 PM CT)








## Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- Near normal temps expected over the next week, moisture risks look rather limited and further off to the northeast for the next few days.
  
- Working into Mid-May, we are favoring near normal temps for this time of year and for precipitation to stay on the active side of things. Increased moisture risks likely continue across the Southern US.
  
- The weeks <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> (Mid/Late May) period likely features more above normal temperatures and above normal moisture, similar to our current week 2 thoughts.
