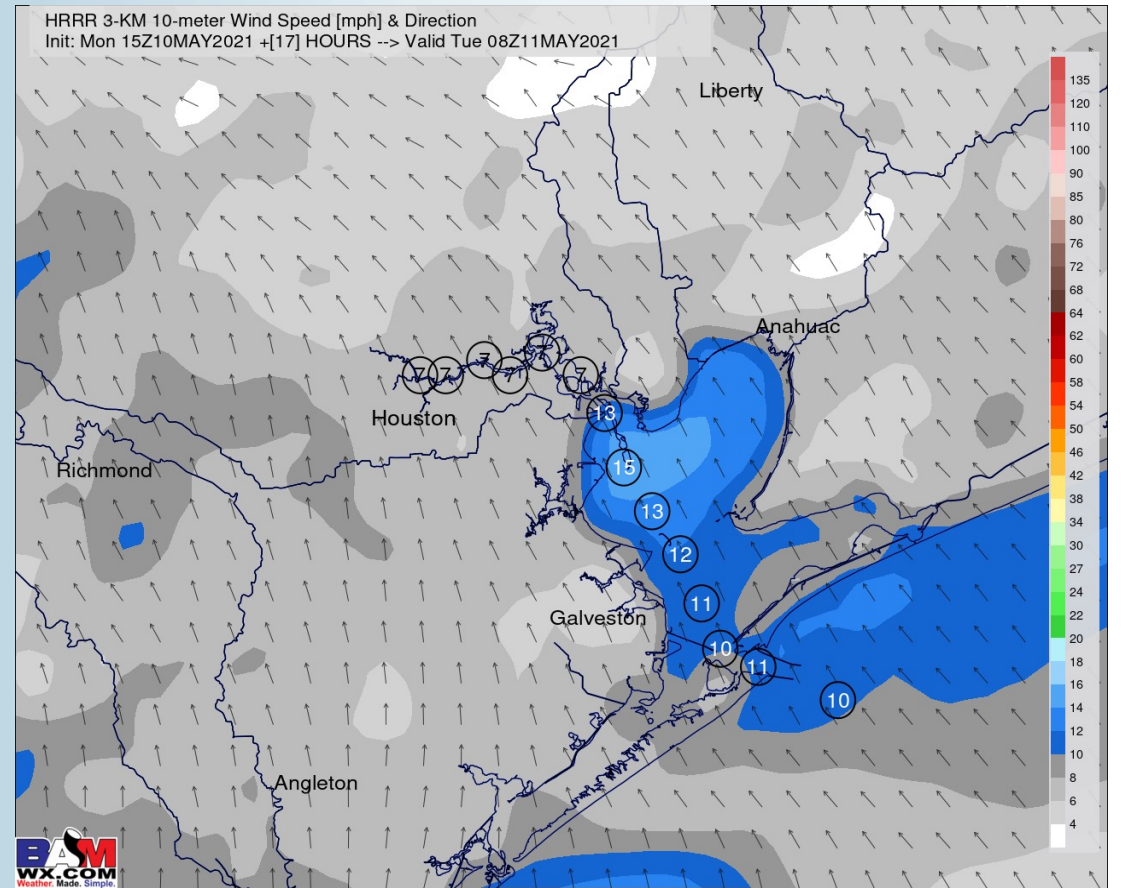

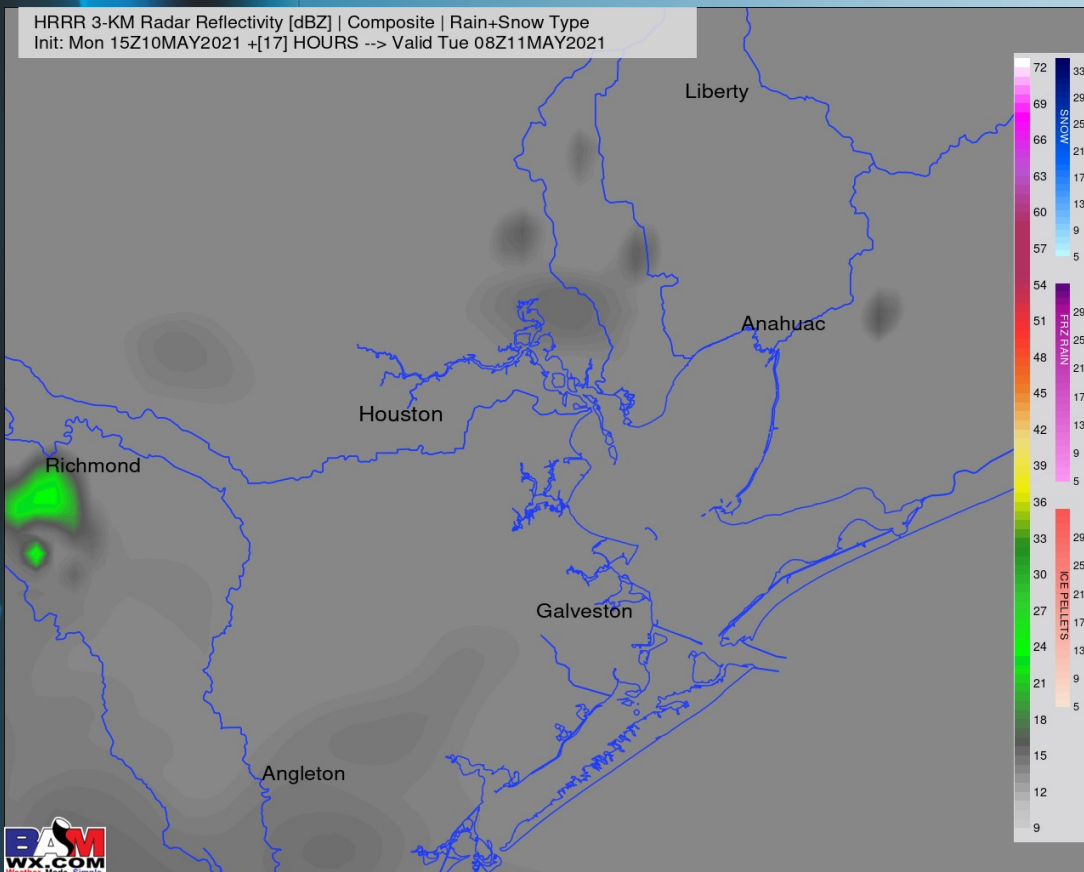
Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- **Precipitation is anticipated to still be quite limited overnight tonight. After midnight tonight and pre-dawn Tuesday there's a 10-20% chance of an isolated shower, but we anticipate overall widespread dry conditions for our Stations.**
- **Winds tonight drop down out of the SE at 5-10 MPH sustained.**
 - **Low temps tonight are expected to consistently linger into the mid 70s.**
 - ***No fog expected tonight.***

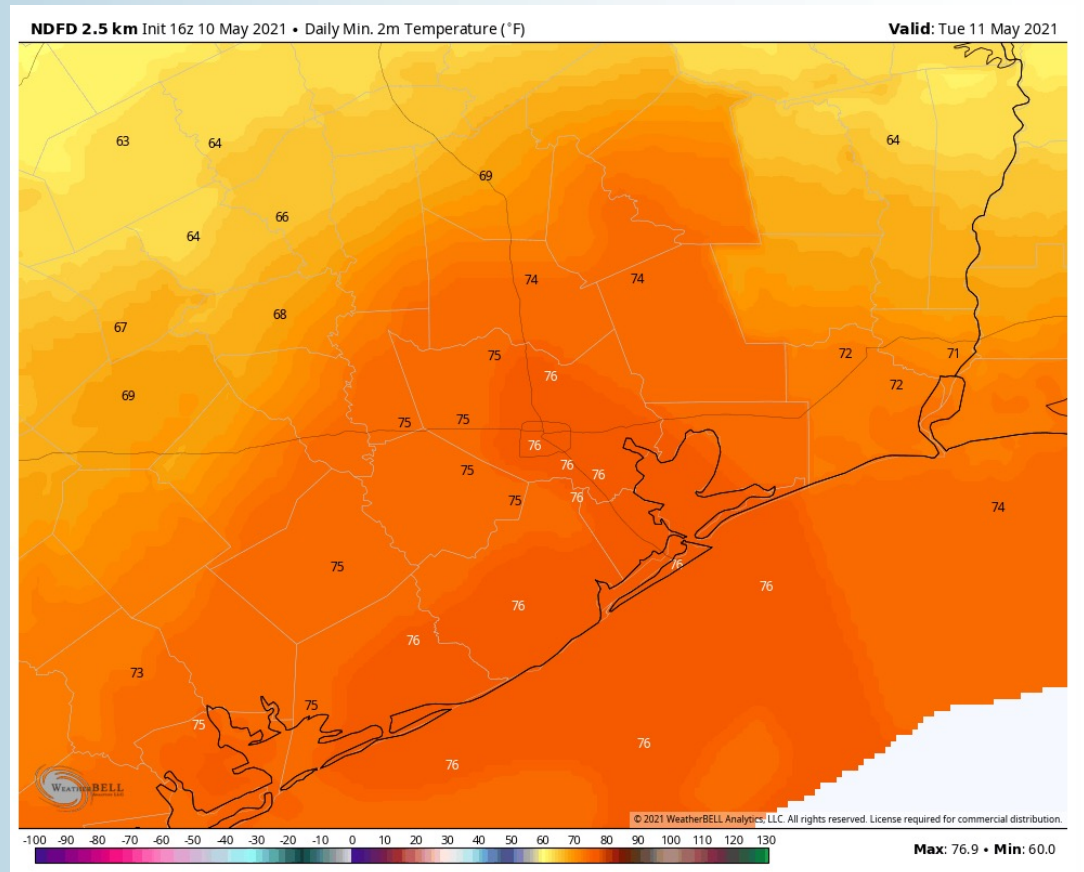
Sustained Winds (3 AM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (3 AM CT)



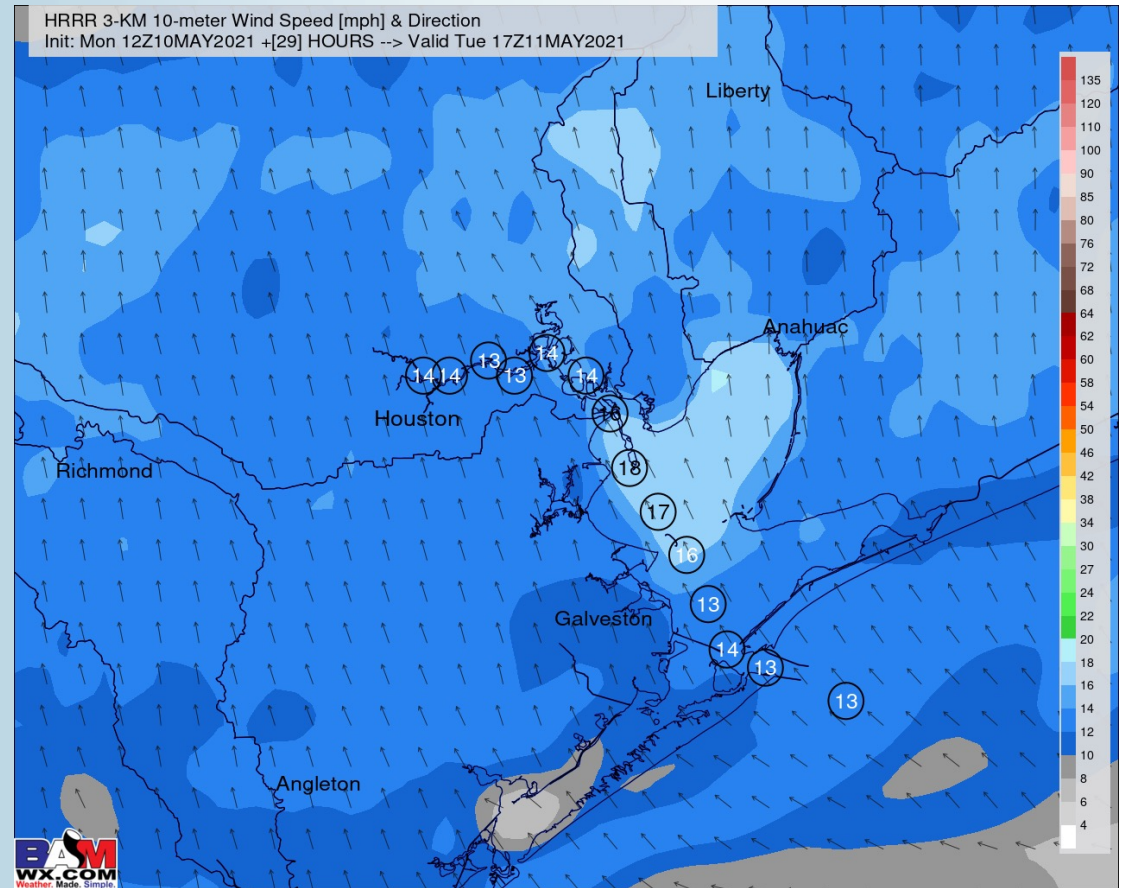
Low Temps Tonight



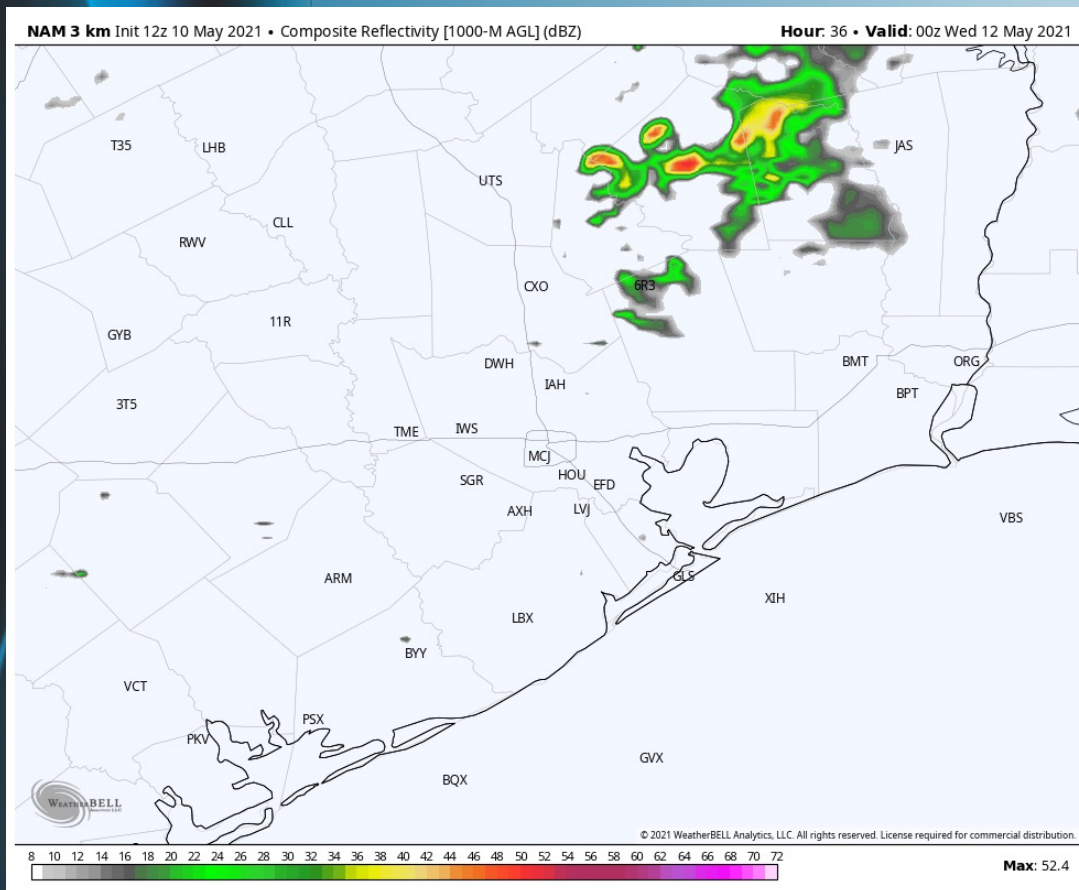
Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- While much of the daytime hours on Tuesday will be quiet, we are watching into the evening hours for an increase in precipitation - currently favoring mostly beyond sundown. We also currently still think the better precipitation activity will be closer to the Houston metro areas vs open water Stations.
- Winds will continue coming from the SE on Tuesday, sustained 8-13 MPH with gusts 13-18 MPH possible. Winds look to be shifting direction Wednesday morning out of the north.
- Tuesday's high temps will be a bit warmer inland, but still sitting in the upper 70s for most stations.
 - *No fog expected Tuesday night.*

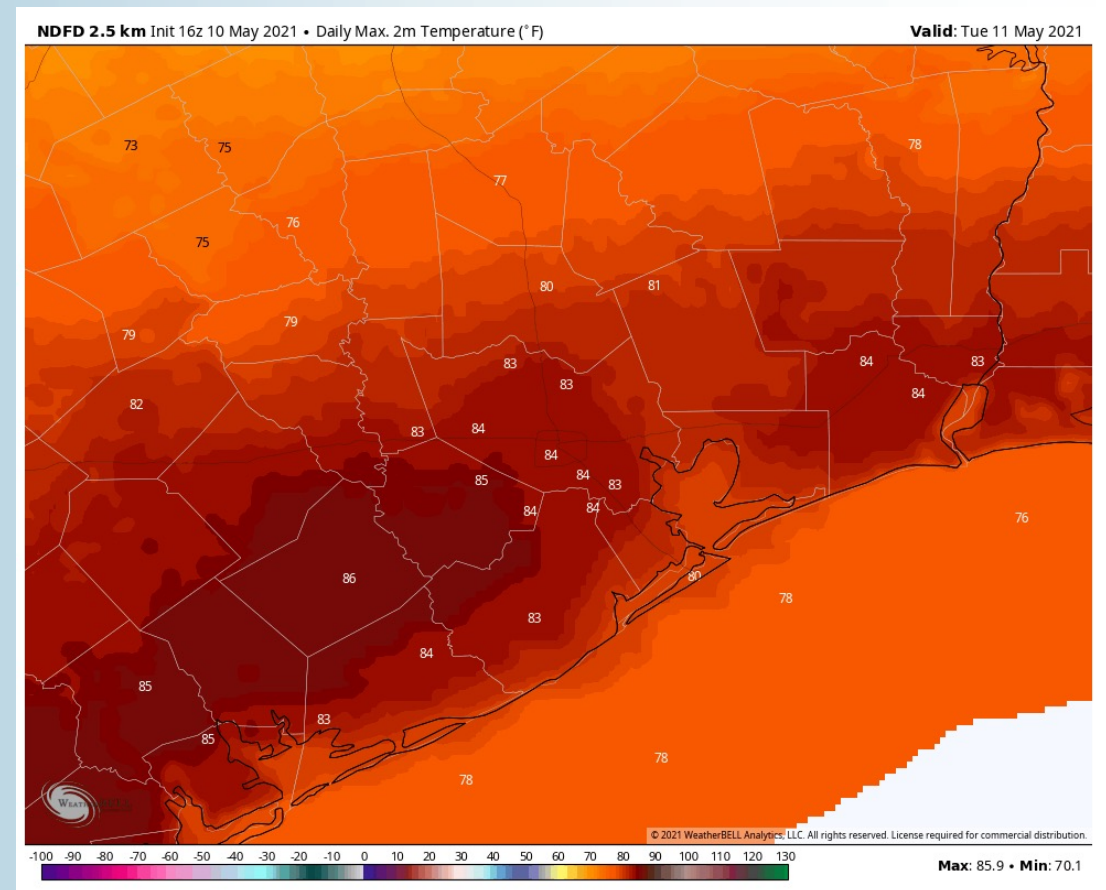
Sustained Winds (12 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (7 PM CT)



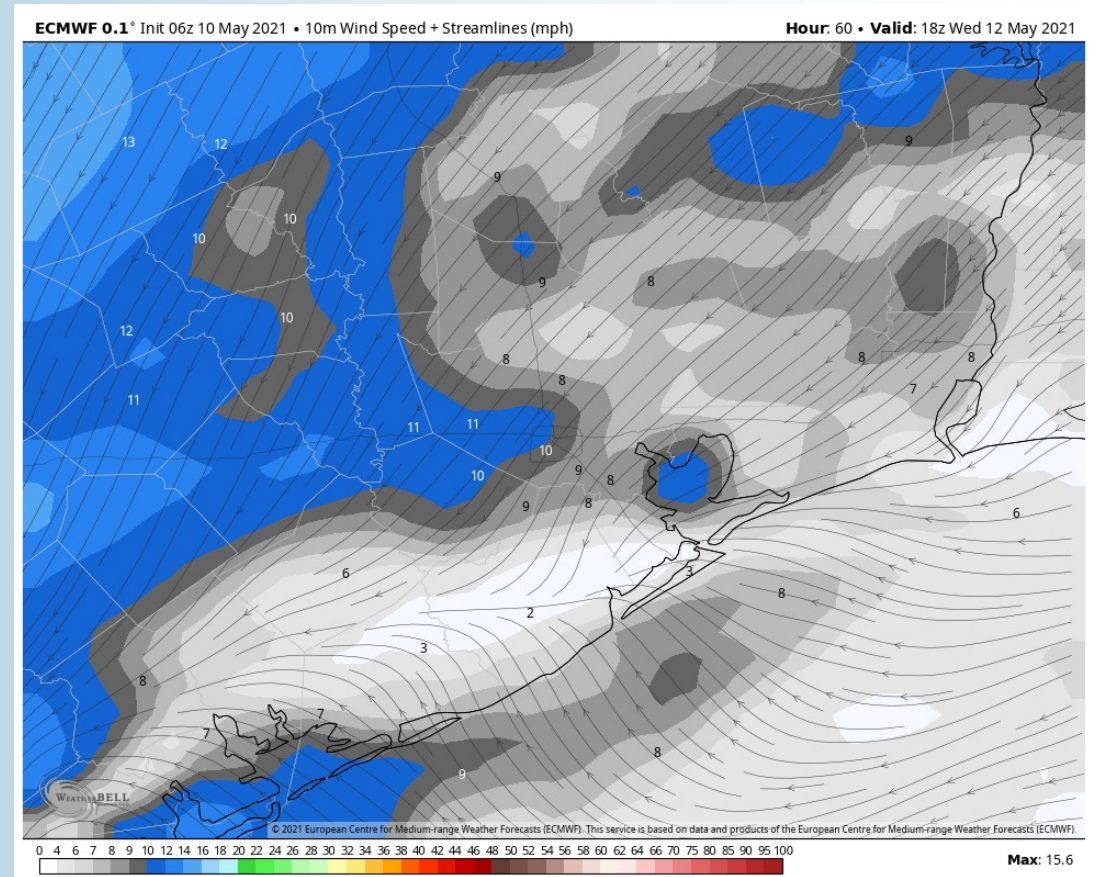
High Temps Tuesday



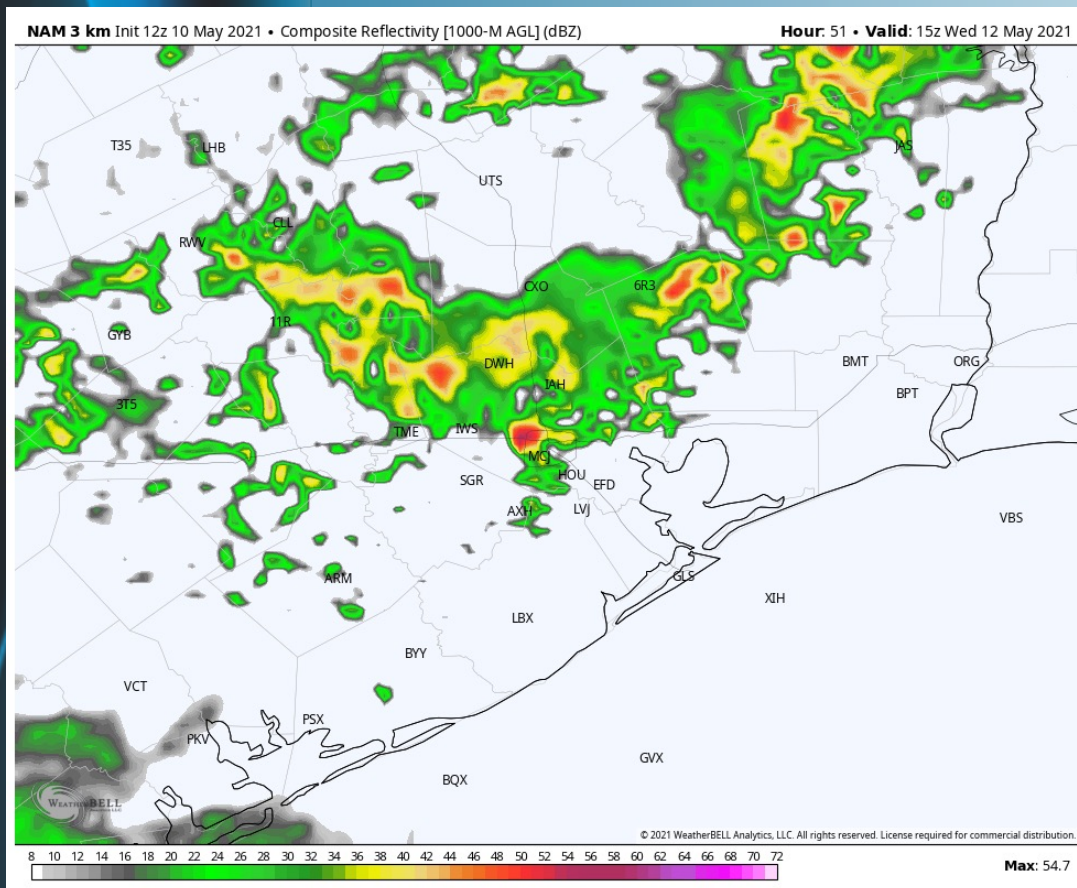
Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Precip chances are expected to be fairly frequent on Wednesday morning into early afternoon, tapering to lower percentages and most north after early afternoon to the evening hours here.
 - Winds are expected to shift from the SE to the ENE mid-morning Wednesday. Winds are also expected to weaken down to more ~5-10 MPH in this transition as well.
 - High temperatures are expected to be in the mid-to-upper 70s over our Stations, slightly warmer in-land.
- *No fog expected Wednesday night.*

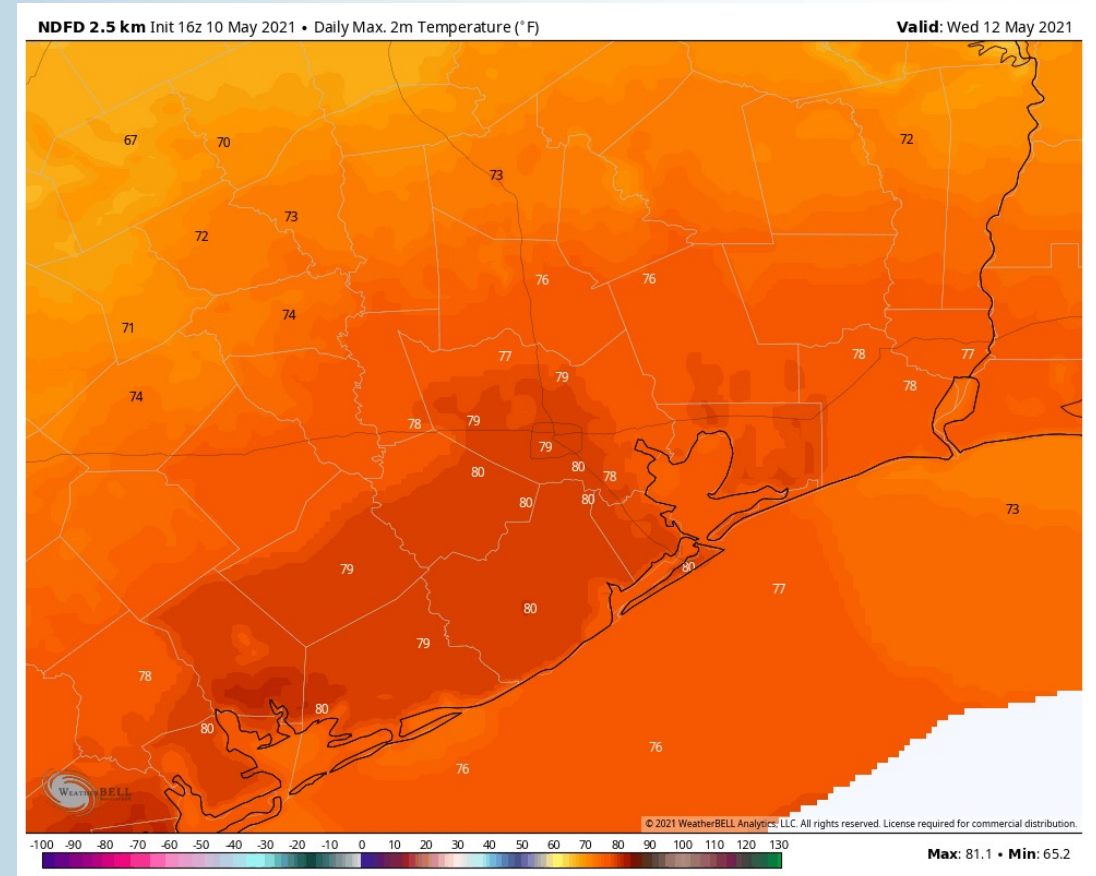
Sustained Winds (1 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (10 AM CT)



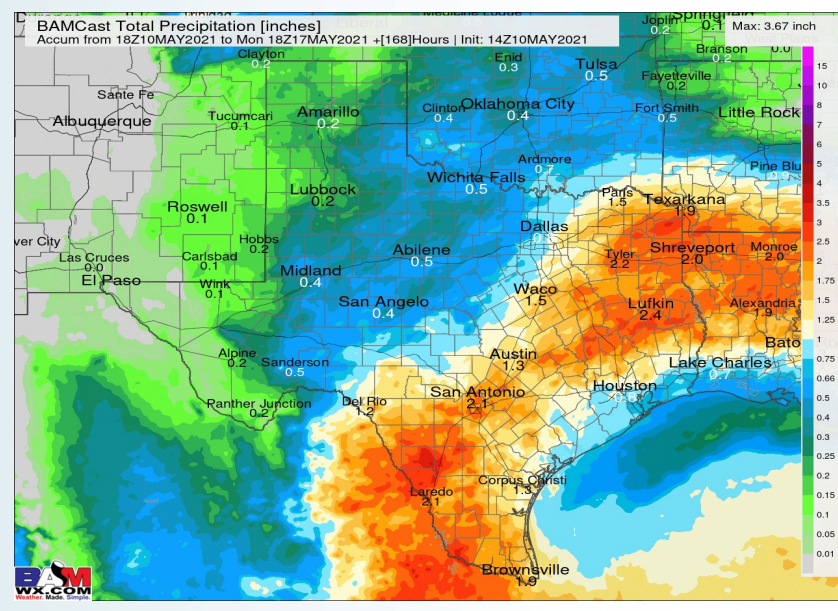
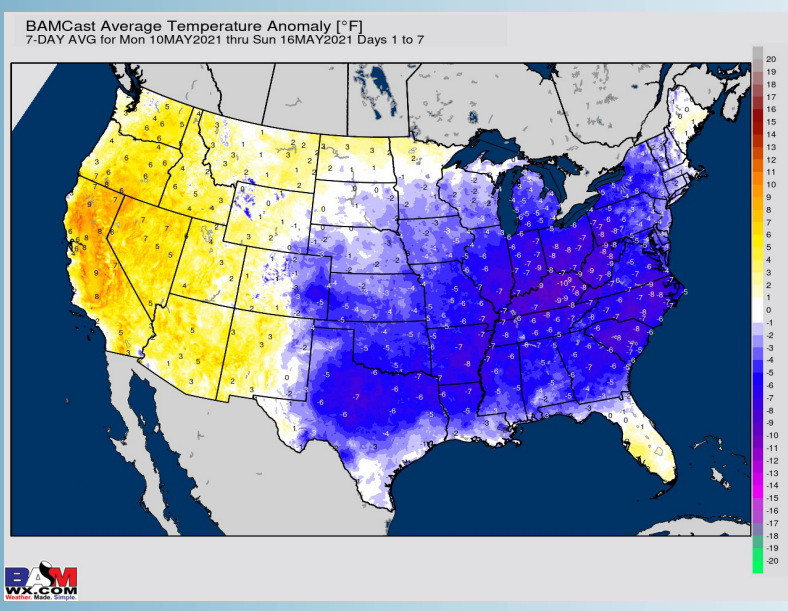
High Temps Wednesday



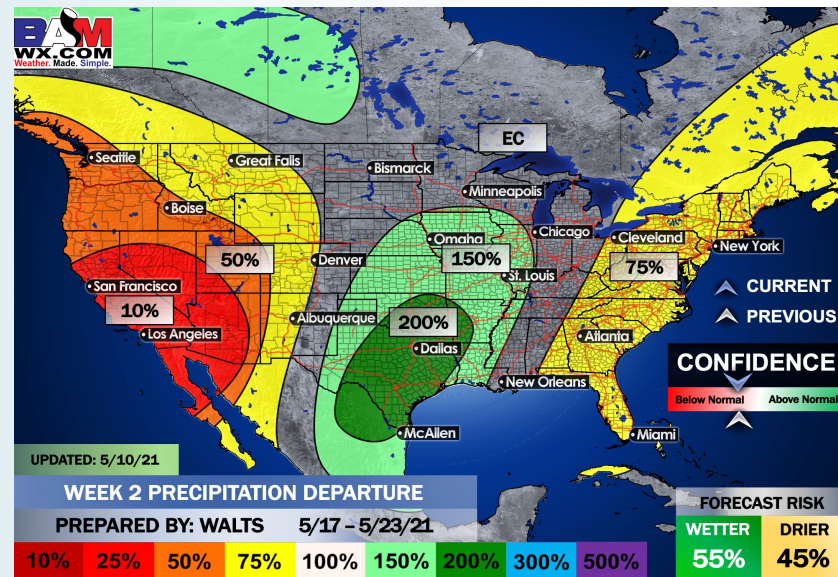
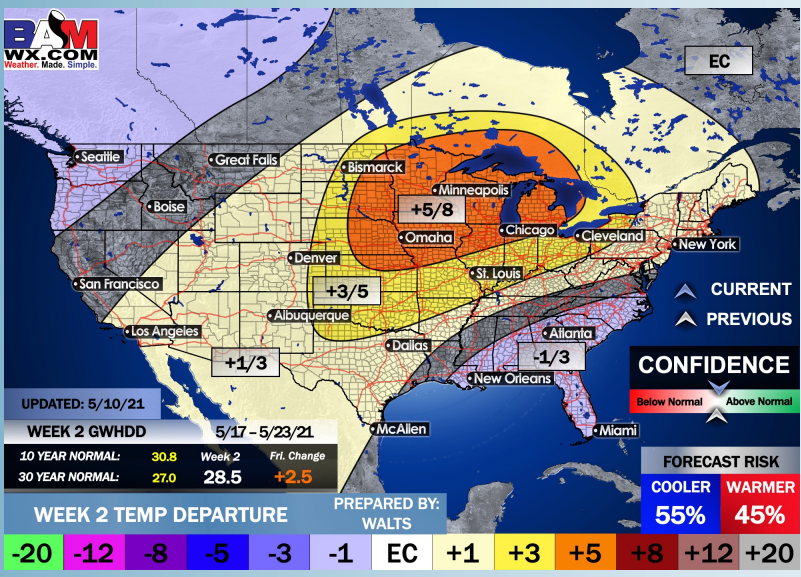
Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- Precip chances increase especially mid-week here, becoming more quiet late work-week, but eyeing additional chances late weekend. Temps look to average slightly below normal.
- Working into late-May, we are favoring slightly above normal temps for this time of year and for precipitation to stay on the active side of things. Increased moisture risks likely continue across the Southern US.
- The weeks ³/₄ (Late May-Early June) period likely features more above normal temperatures and above normal moisture, similar to our current week 2 thoughts.
