


Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Precip has moved in a bit earlier than anticipated this morning, but we are expecting rain chances to stick around for much of the day. While a few stronger storms cannot be fully eliminated, severe weather is not favored at this time. Precipitation will be generally moderate in intensity.
- After a brief period of more Northeasterly winds for the next few hours, we are expecting winds to shift back more to the E/ SE during the afternoon with sustained winds expected at 15-20 MPH, gusting at times up to 20-25 MPH.
- High temps today should sit in the mid 70s
- *No fog expected, but reduced visibility will continue to be possible as long as precip is around the area*


Sustained Winds (3 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (2 PM CT)




High Temps Today




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- While something very isolated cannot be ruled out in the back half of the day Sunday, we are in favor of quieter weather after the round of precip works out of the area in the early AM hours of Sunday.
- Winds Sunday will be coming more out of the S/ SE at 13-18 MPH with gusts locally higher.
- High Temps will be sitting in the upper 70s / lower 80s on Sunday
 - *No fog expected Sunday*


Sustained Winds (2 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (7 AM CT)




High Temps Sunday




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Monday will feature much drier weather than what we've seen over the past few days across the area, but rain chances will continue to remain present. Keeping an eye on the ~mid-AM hours for a few scattered showers that look rather light at this distance. Chances are only favored to be ~20%
- Monday's wind will continue coming out of the S, 13-18 MPH with gusts to 18-23 MPH
- High Temps will be rather warm, sitting in the upper 70s/ lower 80s for most stations. Inland temps look to work into the upper 80s
 - *No fog expected Monday.*


Sustained Winds (4 PM CT)

High Temps Monday





Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- Near normal temps with increased precipitation risks are favored over the next 7 days



- Working into Mid-May, we are favoring slightly above normal temps for this time of year and for precipitation to stay on the active side of things. Increased moisture risks likely continue across the Southern US

- The weeks ³/₄ (Mid/Late May) period likely features more normal conditions for SE TX. Temps and precipitation are favored to be near normal for this time of year
