

Euro Ensemble Tracks (Next 10-days):




Keeping an eye on the tropics/ Gulf of Mexico for increased activity, especially 10 – 15 days from now. This does not necessarily mean that a hurricane will form and does not mean that HOU will see this activity, but something to be mindful of as guidance is trying to hint at a very loosely organized wave **potentially**** somewhere in the June 18-22 window. We will continue to monitor.**


Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- A very stray shower (~10%) will be possible out through mid-day, but favor drier conditions as a whole.
- Winds are anticipated to be from the SSE, sustained around 10 – 15 MPH. Gusts around ~15-20 MPH will be possible.
- Highs look to get into the mid to upper 80's F over open waters. Temperatures into the lower 90's can be expected further towards HOU metro.
- *No Fog anticipated today.*


Sustained Winds (3 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (12 PM CT)




High Temperatures Today




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Winds looks to be a bit calmer, coming out of the South at 8-13 MPH with gusts 13-18 MPH.
- High Temps look to reach the upper 80s mark with lower 90s inland.
- *Not expecting fog Friday.*


Sustained Winds (1 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (9 AM CT)




High Temps Friday




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- At this distance Saturday is looking dry
- Winds will continue to stay generally calmer, out of the South at 8-13 MPH with gusts to 15 MPH.
- High Temperatures will be similar to the past few days, mid to upper 80s around the area with lower 90s closer to HOU metro.
- *No fog anticipated Saturday.*


Sustained Winds (4 PM CT)

High Temperatures Saturday





Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- The next 7 –days look to be less active vs the last few weeks for the HOU area with scattered/ spotty chances late weekend into next week. Activity starts to pick up again after next WED. Overall Temperatures look to run at near normal.


- Week 2 is anticipated to be an active stretch of weather for the HOU with temperatures running slightly below normal. We will also need to keep an eye on tropical mischief arises in he week 2 timeframe as well..

- The weeks ¾ (mid to late June) period likely features more cooler than normal temperatures and above normal moisture, similar to our current week 2 thoughts.
