

Tropical Update:




Tropical activity in the Gulf of Mexico is not anticipated in the next 7-10 days.


Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- The afternoon hours feature low end chances (~20-30%) of a few hit and miss pop up showers and thunderstorms. Severe weather is not anticipated, and any coverage of cells will likely fade as we work into the nighttime hours.
- Winds will continue coming out of the SSE at 8-13 MPH sustained with gusts 13-18 MPH possible at the boarding station. Increased winds are possible inside a more moderate pulse of rain, but would be short lived.
- Lows fall back into the upper 70s / lower 80s.
 - *No fog is in the forecast this evening.*


Sustained Winds (11 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (6 PM CT)




Low Temps This Evening




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Sunday will be a similar set up regarding the precip forecast- best opportunities for rain coming in the afternoon hours in a very scattered fashion. Severe weather is not anticipated.
- Winds are favored to come out of the SSE and look to be a bit calmer, sustained 5-10 MPH. Once again, inside any precip cell, a few locally stronger winds cannot be ruled out.
- Expecting another day with highs in the upper 80s / lower 90s.
 - *No fog is anticipated for our Sunday.*


Sustained Winds (5 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (1 PM CT)




High Temps Sunday




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Anticipating a similar forecast for Monday- hit and miss chances for a brief pop up shower/ t-storm will be possible with the best opportunities coming in the afternoon hours.
- Winds out of the S at 5-10 MPH with gusts to 15 MPH can be expected for Monday.
- Monday continues the theme of highs in the upper 80s / lower 90s.
- *Not expecting fog for Monday.*


Sustained Winds (6 PM CT)

High Temps Monday





Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- The next few days will continue to feature spotty, hit and miss pockets of precipitation before next Tue-Thu look to hold slightly better potential for more widespread rains. Temps will continue to sit near average to slightly below



- The pattern ahead looks to continue in regards to precipitation from average in the week 2 period. Temperatures are anticipated to run below normal as well.

- The weeks ³/₄ (late July into August essentially) period likely features more seasonable to cooler than normal temperatures, while precipitation looks to run at or above normal in this period as well.
