

# Tropical Update:




**Tropical activity in the Gulf of Mexico is not anticipated in the next 7-10 days.**




## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Favoring the rest of today to stay precip free.
- Winds after ~5 PM are expected to generally come out of the SW at 8-13 MPH with a few gusts locally higher. Near ~2 AM, winds may turn a bit more WSW.
- Low temps tonight to fall back upper 70s/ lower 80s.
- *Fog is not favored for this evening.*


## Sustained Winds (6 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (11 PM CT)






## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Continue to favor Monday to be a dry day. Watching for a ~10% chance of an isolated storm if temps overachieve in the 4-8 PM window.
  
- Winds early Monday will slowly shift from SW to W and remain generally light, 5-10 MPH. Winds likely shift back to out of the south into the afternoon after ~3 PM and will be more 8-13 MPH sustained.
  
- Low to mid 90s will be the forecast for Monday. Once again, heat index values near 100 F possible.
  
- *Fog is not anticipated for the day Monday.*


## Sustained Winds (6 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (2 PM CT)






## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Tuesday looks to start out dry, but a few very isolated showers will work back into the forecast ~late morning and into the afternoon hours. Low end chances (~20-30%) as coverage will likely be rather minimal.
- Winds will generally be coming out of the SE at 5-10 MPH.
- Expecting a similar setup for Tuesday, highs ranging from the upper 80s near the boarding station to the mid 90s closer toward the 610 bridge. “Feels like” temps near 100 F will be possible.
- *No fog expected Tuesday.*


## Sustained Winds (5 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (3 PM CT)








## Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- Continuing to favor quieter weather moving forward as we start to feel more the influence of an upper level high pressure system. Thanks to this higher pressure, temps will continue to stay slightly above average for this time of year.
- The quiet weather from week 1 ahead looks to bleed into week 2 with below normal moisture risks expected. Temperatures are anticipated to run below normal as well.
- The weeks  $\frac{3}{4}$  (first half of August) period likely features more seasonable to cooler than normal temperatures, while precipitation looks to run around normal in this period as well. One thing to watch into mid-late August is the increased potential of tropical activity.
