






Short-Term Forecast Discussion


- Line of precipitation off to the west/ southwest is expected to have limited impacts towards the HOU area as continued weakening is expected (good data agreement on this plus recent radar trends). At this point, it only looks like isolated showers out through midnight. IF the line can survive, rainfall would be light in nature (not favored).
- Winds continue out of the SSE for today, sustained in the 10-15 MPH range, occasionally gusting up to 20-25 MPH across the boarding station. Winds may calm down a bit closer to the 8-13 MPH range after sunset.
- ➤ Low temperatures look to get into the upper 70's F / upper 80's F for our stations. Slightly cooler towards the HOU metro.
 - Fog is not expected for today.

Simulated Radar Snapshot (5 PM CT)



Low Temps Fri Morning








Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- ➤ Most of Friday morning through about 1 PM will see scattered-to-isolated showers across the boarding station.


 After a brief lull of rainfall into the afternoon, expecting another increase in showers and storms from 4-9 PM along and out ahead of the cold front.
- ➤ Winds will slowly be calming throughout the morning into the afternoon sustained from the SSW around 7 12 MPH. A cold front is anticipated to swing through around 10 PM midnight. After this front passes winds will pick up sustained closer to 15 25 MPH (sustained winds approaching 30 MPH not out of the question towards the boarding station around midnight early SAT AM). Gust from 30 40 MPH will be possible late Friday into Saturday morning.
- Mid 80s are again favored for the day Friday. Warmer temps expected towards the HOU metro.
 - Fog is not expected for Friday.

Simulated Radar Snapshot (6 PM CT)




Friday, October 15th, 2021

High Temps Friday








Short-Term Forecast Discussion


- > A much cooler and drier day is expected on Saturday, remaining quite windy as well.
- ➤ Winds are still expected to be 15-20 MPH sustained near the boarding station on Saturday, at times still up to 25 MPH sustained out of the NNE. Periods of gusts up to 25-35 MPH will be possible. Windiest / gustiest conditions expected in the AM hours of Saturday.
- Mid 70s are favored for the day Saturday.
 - Fog is not expected for Saturday.

Simulated Radar Snapshot (2 PM CT)




Saturday, October 16th, 2021

High Temps Saturday











Long-Range Forecast Discussion


- out about normal for this time of year with hit and miss rain chances possible today before a cold front works through Friday night. The rest of the weekend is anticipated to be dry, carrying over into early next week.
- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have below average temps with slightly below average risks for precip. Not eyeing a specific threat for a tropical storm or hurricane at this distance but will need to continue to monitor for potential development.
- Right now, we have risks slightly below normal temps and normal to slightly below normal precip for the weeks 3/4 period. We will continue to monitor for tropical disturbances during this time.
