

EPS Ensemble 10-days Tracks




- We continue to favor the Gulf to remain quiet at least for the next 7-10 days.

Short-Term Forecast Discussion



Sustained Winds (5 PM CT)

- Dry conditions are anticipated today.
- Winds look to be elevated again for Thu. Sustained winds 20-30 MPH for the boarding out through about noon with gusts 30-40 MPH possible. After the ~Noon timeframe, sustained winds of 25-35 MPH are favored with 35-45 MPH gusts possible for the boarding station. Winds coming out of the NW for today. Winds weaken a touch to 20-30 MPH sustained after ~10 PM and through the nighttime hours. **Peak winds look to come 2-8 PM.**
- High temps sit in the mid 70s.
- **No fog anticipated for our stations.**

Short-Term Forecast Discussion


- Anticipating a dry day for our stations on Friday.

- Winds will **slowly** weaken some Thursday night into Friday AM, but will still remain elevated. By daybreak, sustained winds 20-30 MPH for the boarding station for much of the day, gusts 30-40MPH. Sustained winds 18-23 MPH for our other stations and gusts 25-30 MPH closer to downtown Hou/610 bridge. Winds continue out of the NW for Fri and then will weaken once again Friday after sundown.


- High temps look to be in the low 70s.

- **Fog is not expected for Friday.**


Sustained Winds (12 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (12 PM CT)




High Temps Friday




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- No precip is expected for our Saturday.
- Winds by 1 PM will fully shift out of the NW. Expecting sustained winds closer to 20-30 MPH sustained with gusts 30-40 MPH possible the rest of the day/evening at the boarding station.
- Highs look to be in the low to mid 70s on the day Saturday.
 - **Not expecting fog for Saturday.**


Sustained Winds (9 PM CT)





Simulated Radar Snapshot (1 PM CT)



High Temps Saturday





Week 1 Forecast





Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- Temps look to average out normal to slightly above normal the next 7 days. expecting an overall drier week.
- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have near normal to slightly above normal temps with slightly above average risks for precip. Not eyeing a specific threat for a tropical storm or hurricane at this distance.

- Right now, we have risks for about average temps and below average precip for the first half of November. Tropical risks are on the lower side, but not a threat that should be 100% eliminated.
