

## EPS Ensemble 10-days Tracks




- We continue to favor the Gulf to remain quiet at least for the next 7-10 days.




## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Dry conditions are expected through today.
- Winds the rest of the afternoon will be sustained 25-35 MPH with 35-45 MPH gusts possible for the boarding station. Winds continue out of the NW. Winds weaken a touch to 20-30 MPH sustained after ~9 PM and through the nighttime hours with gusts 30-40 MPH.
- Lows look to be in the low to mid 60s for most stations, slightly cooler closer to downtown Houston.
- **No fog anticipated for our stations.**


## Sustained Winds (11 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (8 PM CT)




## Low Temps This Evening




## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Anticipating a dry day for our stations on Friday.
- Winds will *\*slowly\** weaken some Thursday night into Friday AM, but will still remain elevated. By daybreak, sustained winds 20-30 MPH for the boarding station for much of the day, gusts 30-40MPH. Sustained winds 18-23 MPH and gusts 25-30 MPH closer to downtown Hou/610 bridge. Winds continue out of the NW for Fri and then will weaken once again Friday after sundown to 18-23 MPH sustained for the boarding station.
- High temps look to be in the low 70s.
- **Fog is not expected for Friday.**


## Sustained Winds (9 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (12 PM CT)






## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- No precip is expected for our Saturday.
- Winds will finally start to subside on Saturday. The breeziest of winds will come pre-dawn at 15-20 MPH sustained at the boarding stations before turning 10-15 MPH for the rest of the day and coming from the NW.
- Highs look to be in the low to mid 70s on the day Saturday.
- **Not expecting fog for Saturday.**


## Sustained Winds (9 PM CT)





## Simulated Radar Snapshot (1 PM CT)



## Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- Temps look to average out normal to slightly above normal the next 7 days. expecting an overall drier week.
- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have near normal to slightly above normal temps with slightly above average risks for precip. Not eyeing a specific threat for a tropical storm or hurricane at this distance.

- Right now, we have risks for about average temps and below average precip for the first half of November. Tropical risks are on the lower side, but not a threat that should be 100% eliminated.
