

## European Model Tracks




• No tropical activity is expected in the next 7-10 days.




## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Another dry day is anticipated.
- Winds much of the day look to be coming sustained 5-10 MPH. Direction looks to be coming out of the NE for most of the day before turning more SE near sundown.
- Highs today look to top out in the upper 70s for most stations.
- **Fog is not in the forecast today.**


## Sustained Winds (12 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (12 PM CT)






## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Dry conditions expected to continue for Monday.
- Sustained winds 5-10 MPH for our stations on Monday, gusts to 15 MPH possible at the boarding station. Winds generally coming out of the E for most of the day.
- High temps on Monday look to be in the upper 70's F.
- **Fog is currently not expected for our stations on Monday.**


## Sustained Winds (2 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (12 PM CT)






## Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Dry stretch we have been seeing the past few days expected to continue for Tuesday.
- Sustained winds 5-10 MPH for most of the day, closer to 8-13 MPH after sundown for the boarding station, gusts to 15 MPH possible in nighttime. Winds generally coming out of the E/SE for Tuesday.
- High temps Tuesday look to be in the upper 70s to low 80s.
- **Currently not expecting fog for our stations on Tue, keeping an eye on potential fog N of our stations.**


## Sustained Winds (12 PM CT)



## Simulated Radar Snapshot (11 AM CT)








## Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- The first half of the next 7 days looks to be rather inactive before the approach of another frontal boundary late WED - SAT. Pockets of heavier rain will be possible with this. Temperatures will average out near normal to slightly below normal.
- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have below normal temps with about average to slightly below average risks for precip. Not eyeing a specific threat for a tropical storm or hurricane at this distance.
- Right now, we have risks for slightly below average temps and about average precip for the first half of November. Tropical risks are on the lower side, but not a threat that should be 100% eliminated.
