




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- **Dry stretch expected to continue for today.**
- **Sustained winds around 5 – 10 MPH for most of the day, closer to 8-13 MPH after sundown for the boarding station. Gusts to 15 MPH possible for the boarding station at night. Winds continue out of the SE .**
- **High temps look to be in the low to mid 70s.**
- **We continue to favor any fog development to stay inland and north of our stations this morning.**


Sustained Winds (11 AM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (1 PM CT)




High Temperatures Monday




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- Dry conditions are expected for Tuesday.
- Sustained winds for the AM and early PM hours 5-10 MPH with gusts to 15 MPH possible. After about ~6PM sustained winds closer to 10-15 MPH for the boarding station through midnight with gusts 15-20 MPH. Winds generally coming out of the SE.
- High temperatures Tuesday look to be in the low to mid 70s.
- **Keeping an eye on potential fog inland E of our stations, currently not favoring fog for our stations on Tuesday.**


Sustained Winds (2 PM CT)



Simulated Radar Snapshot (1 PM CT)




High Temperatures Tuesday




Short-Term Forecast Discussion

- **Anticipating overall dry conditions for Wed. A ~20% chance for a few isolated showers in the PM. Coverage looks rather minimal.**
- **Sustained winds in the AM 10-15 MPH for the boarding station with gusts to 20 MPH. Sustained winds look to pick up closer to 13-18 MPH for most of our stations after ~1PM. Gusts 18-23 MPH possible at the boarding station through midnight. Winds generally coming out of the S/SE.**
- **High temperatures look to be in the mid to upper 70s.**
- **Currently not favoring fog for our stations on Wed.**


Sustained Winds (1 PM CT)

High Temperatures Wednesday





Long-Range Forecast Discussion

- The main weather feature in the next 7 days will be an approaching cold front on THU. A few scattered chances will continue into FRI, quieting down for the rest of the week. Temps the next 7 days look to be near normal to slightly above normal.



- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have near normal to slightly below normal risks for temp and precip. Not eyeing a specific threat for a tropical storm or hurricane at this distance.

- Right now we are favoring near normal temperatures for the back half of November with slightly above normal precipitation risks. Tropical threats look quite minimal as we get towards the end of the season.
