

## Sunday, 11/14/21

Still not in favor of fog Sunday, however there continues to remain a low end threat that will be fine tuned as we get into the range of hi resolution guidance.



## Monday, 11/15/21

Keeping an eye on fog potential for Monday, some data suggests this. Northerly winds Mon AM could inhibit this potential.



## Tuesday, 11/16/21

Not favoring fog for Tuesday at this distance.

## Forecast Discussion



**Precip:** With the front now behind us, dry conditions are favored the rest of today.

**Wind:** By ~3 PM, winds will be out of the N and sustained at 13-18 MPH with gusts 18-23 MPH possible for the rest of the afternoon and evening hours at the boarding station. By 8 PM, winds look to come more out of the NE.


**Temps:** Low Temps fall back into the upper 50s/ lower 60s for most stations.

**Visibility:** No fog into the overnight hours.

## Forecast Discussion


**Precip:** Dry conditions are anticipated for our stations on Fri.

**Wind:** Winds starting at daybreak Friday will be calmer at 5-10 and generally coming out of the NE. Winds mid day may start to vary a bit in direction as they look to be calmer. Around ~10 PM Fri, winds pick up quite a bit and come out of the NNE at 20-25 MPH sustained with gusts 25-35 MPH possible into early Sat morning.



**Temps:** High temperatures Friday look to be in the mid 70s.


## Sim Radar Snapshot: 1 PM CT

**Precip:** Currently favoring Saturday to be dry.



**Wind:** Winds will continue at 15-25 MPH sustained with gusts to 35 MPH possible out through ~10 AM before slowly calming. By mid afternoon, winds are 8-13 MPH with gusts to 18 MPH. Winds generally coming out of the N.

**Temps:** Highs Saturday are favored to only reach the upper 60s

**Visibility:** Not fog is expected for Saturday.
