

# Houston Pilots Extended Range Visibility Report



## Tuesday, 11/16/21

Currently not favoring fog for Tuesday, winds appear to be elevated for the morning hours.



## Wednesday, 11/17/21

Same as with Tuesday, not favoring fog for our stations on Wed, winds are still elevated for the AM hours.



## Thursday, 11/18/21

Not expecting fog for our stations on Thu. \*However, briefly reduced visibility will be possible as a front pushes through in the AM hours.\*

## Forecast Discussion


**Precip:** Today looks to be a dry day.

**Wind:** Winds start to decrease slowly throughout the day. Winds remain elevated at 20-25 MPH sustained for the boarding station through about ~8AM, closer to 15-20 MPH out through 6 PM. Gusts 25-30 MPH possible until 8 AM. Gusts then calm some to 18-23 MPH through 6 PM. Beyond 6 PM, winds are 8-13 MPH with gusts to 15 MPH. A N wind is favored most of the day.


**Temps:** Highs are favored to only reach the mid-to-upper 60s F.

**Visibility:** No fog is expected for our stations.


## Sim Radar Snapshot: 11 AM CT






## Sim Radar Snapshot: 12 PM CT

- Precip:** Once again, no precipitation anticipated for Sunday.
- Wind:** Winds will generally be out of the SSW on Sunday, sustained 3-8 MPH for most of the day, closer to 5-10 MPH after sundown for the boarding station.
- Temps:** High Temperatures look to be in the low to mid 70s on Sunday.
- Visibility:** Currently not expecting fog for our stations.

## Forecast Discussion


**Precip:** Dry conditions are expected to continue for Monday.

**Wind:** Winds for most of the day anticipated to be 8-13 MPH sustained with gusts to 18 MPH possible for the boarding station. After sunset, sustained winds look to pick up closer to 10-15 MPH at the boarding station through midnight with gusts 15-20 MPH. Winds Mon AM coming out of the SSW, with a more southerly flow for the PM hours.


**Temps:** Highs on Monday look to be in the mid to upper 70s F.

**Visibility:** Currently not favoring fog for our stations on Monday.



# Houston Pilots: 11/13/21



- An overall inactive stretch is anticipated the next 7 days, with chances picking back up late next week THU-FRI. Temperatures are anticipated to average out to slightly above normal this week.
- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have near normal temperatures with slightly above normal risks for precip.
- Right now, we are favoring slightly above average temperature risks and slightly below normal risks for precip for the back half of November.
