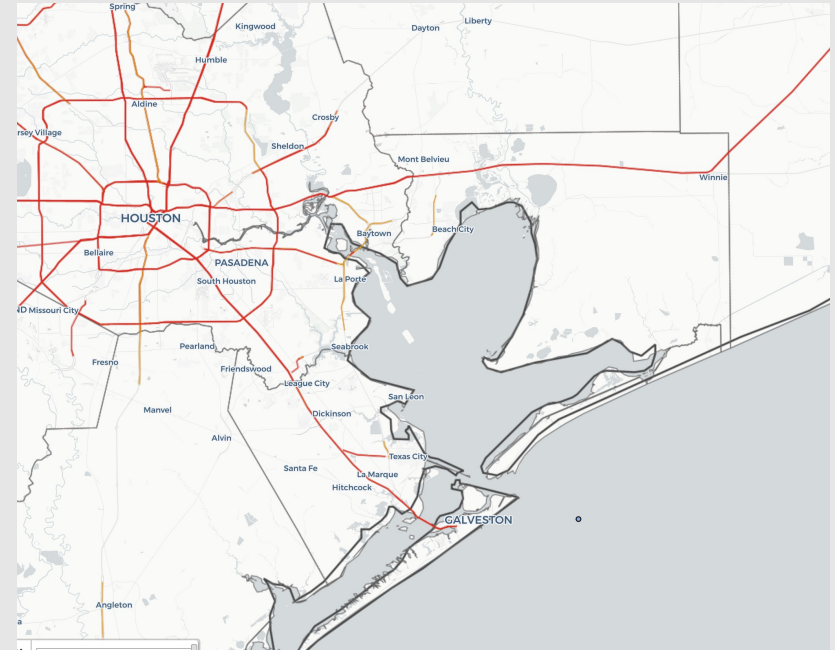

Houston Pilots Extended Range Visibility Report



Wednesday, 11/17/21

Currently not favoring fog for Wednesday, winds appear to still be elevated for the AM hours out of the South.



Thursday, 11/18/21

Not expecting fog for our stations on Thu. *However, briefly reduced visibility will be possible as a front pushes through in the AM hours.*



Friday, 11/19/21

Not expecting fog for our stations on Fri. Elevated winds out of the NE inhibit this potential.



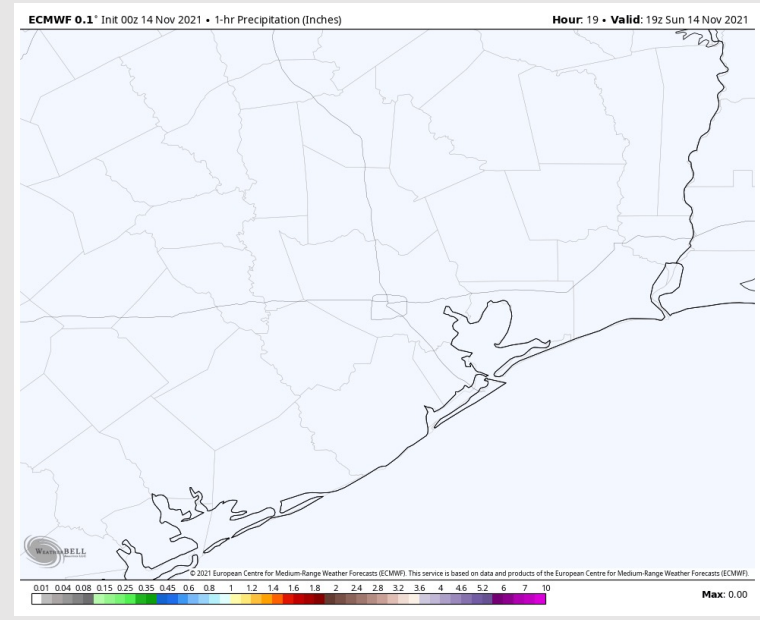

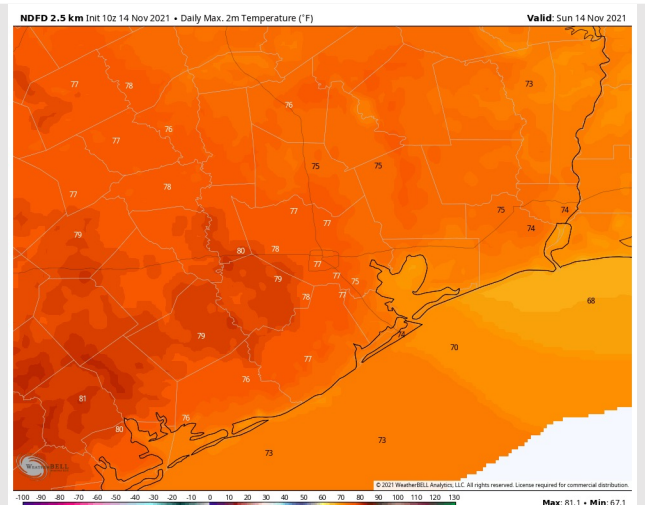
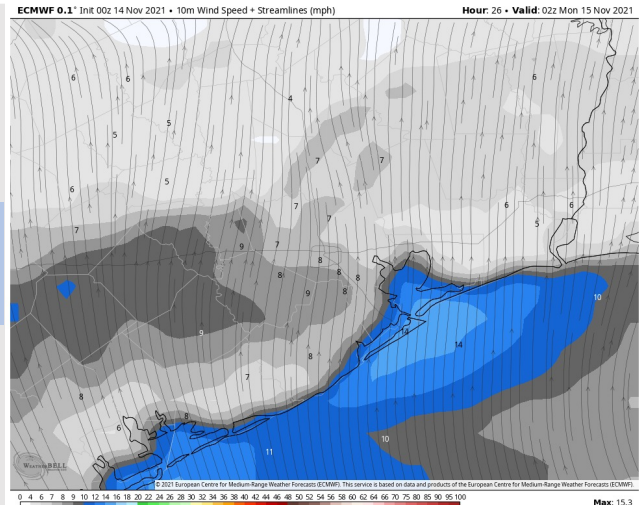
Forecast Discussion

Sim Radar Snapshot: 1 PM CT

- Precip:** Once again, no precipitation is expected for today.
- Wind:** Sustained winds 3-8 MPH for much of today, closer to 5-10 MPH after sundown at the boarding station. Gusts to 15 MPH possible at nighttime. Winds generally coming out of the south on Sunday.
- Temps:** High Temperatures look to be in the low to mid 70s today; upper 70s towards HOU.
- Visibility:** Currently not expecting fog for our stations.

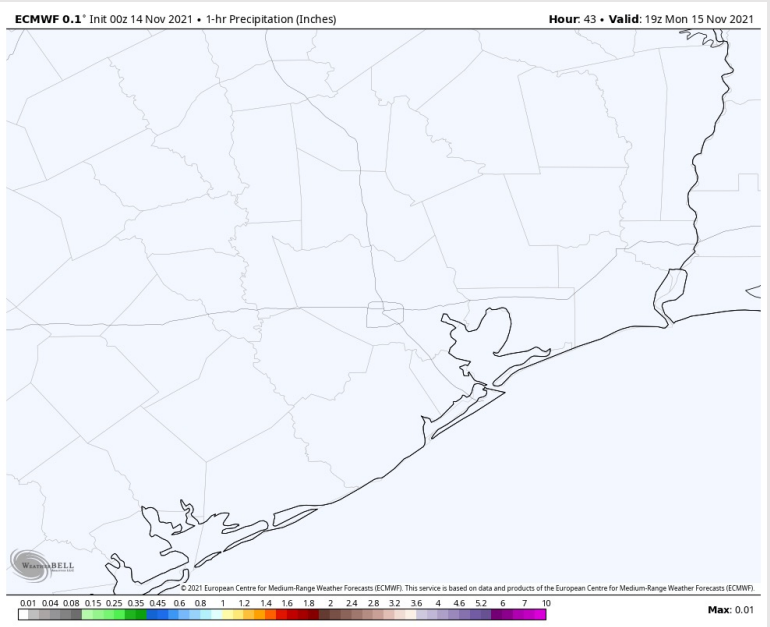

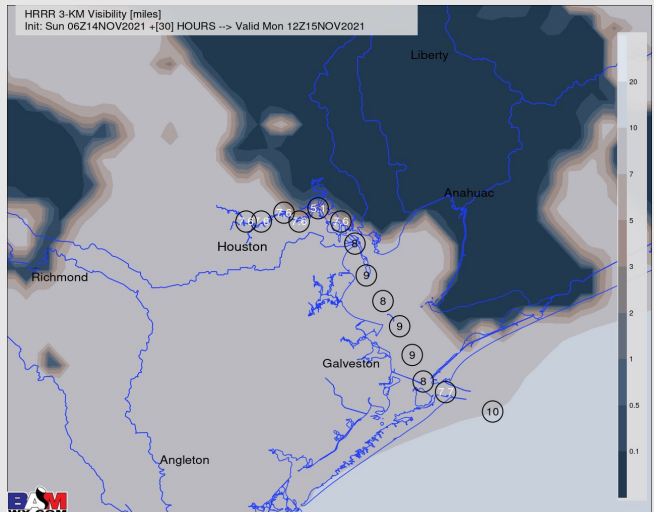
Forecast Discussion

- Precip:** Dry conditions are expected to continue for Monday.
- Wind:** Winds for most of the day anticipated to be 8-13 MPH sustained with gusts to 18 MPH possible for the boarding station. After sunset, sustained winds look to pick up closer to 10-15 MPH at the boarding station through midnight with gusts 15-20 MPH possible. Winds Mon AM coming out of the SSW, with a more southerly flow for the PM hours.
- Temps:** Highs on Monday look to be in the mid to upper 70s F.
- Visibility:** Keeping an eye on fog potential as some data suggests fog over land E and N of our stations. Currently not favoring fog over our stations, however, on Monday.

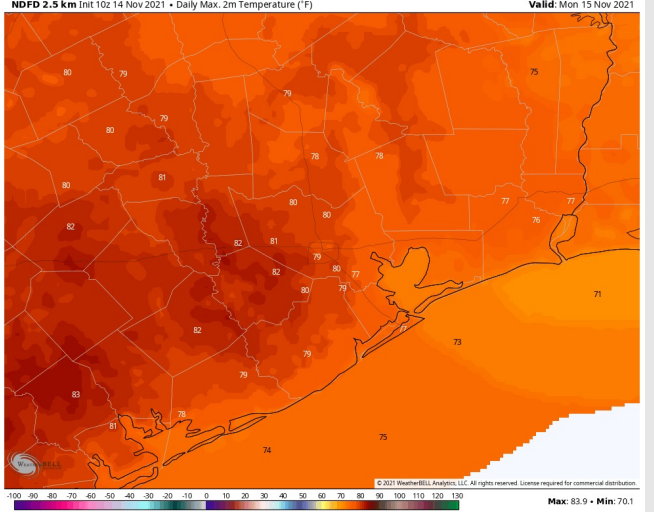
Sim Radar Snapshot: 1 PM CT

High Temps Monday



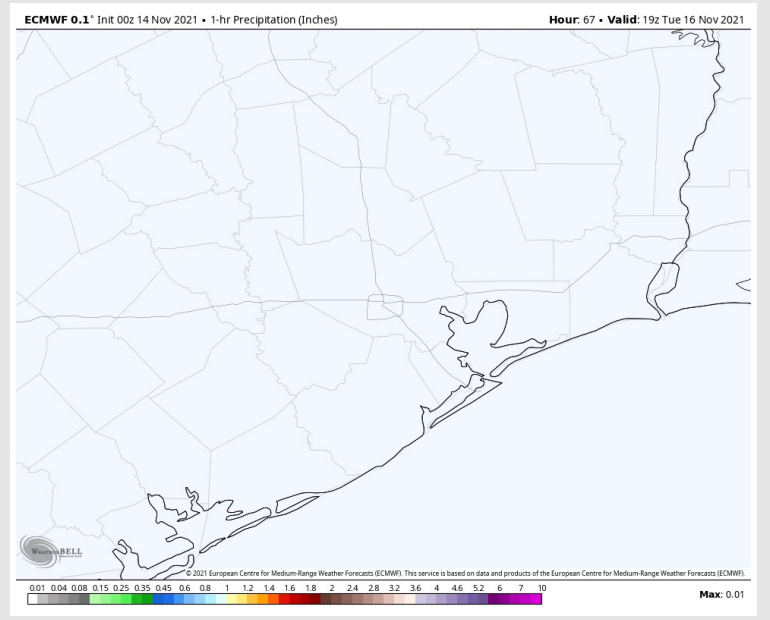

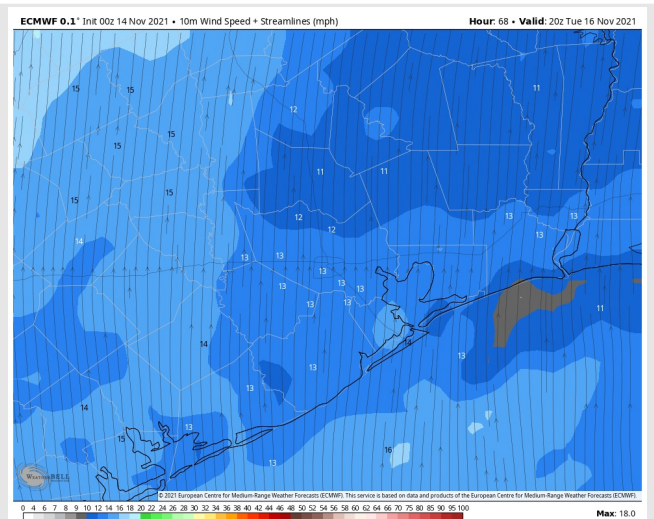

Sim Radar Snapshot: 1 PM CT

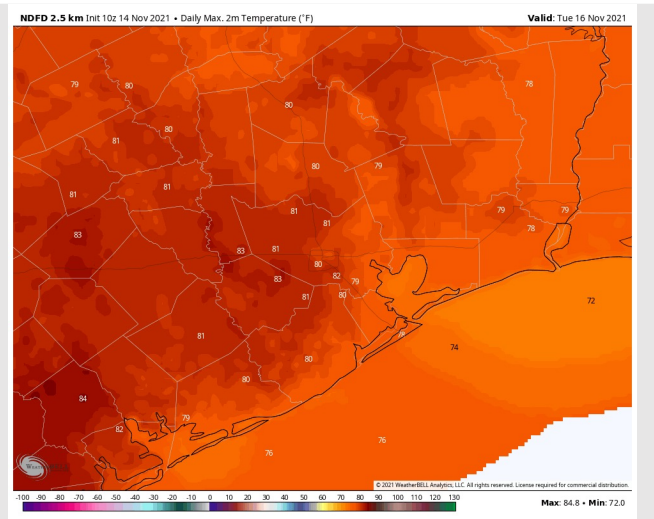
- Precip:** Anticipating another dry day for Tuesday.
- Wind:** Winds look to be elevated for most of Tuesday, 13-18 MPH sustained with gusts 18-23 MPH at the boarding station through sundown. After sundown winds pick up at the boarding station closer to 15-20 MPH sustained with gusts 20-25 MPH through midnight. Winds are generally out of the south on Tuesday.
- Temps:** High temperatures Tuesday look to be in the mid to upper 70s.
- Visibility:** Currently not anticipating fog on Tuesday.



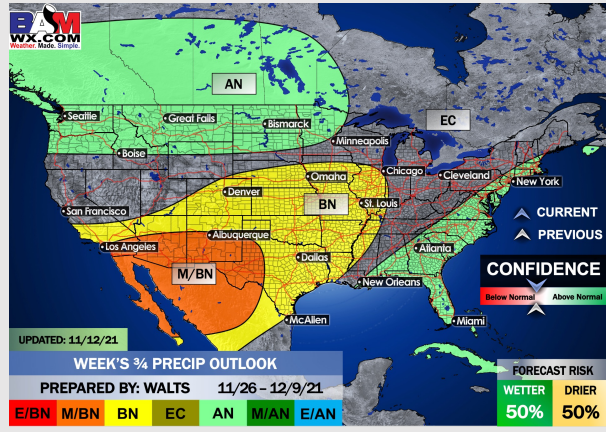
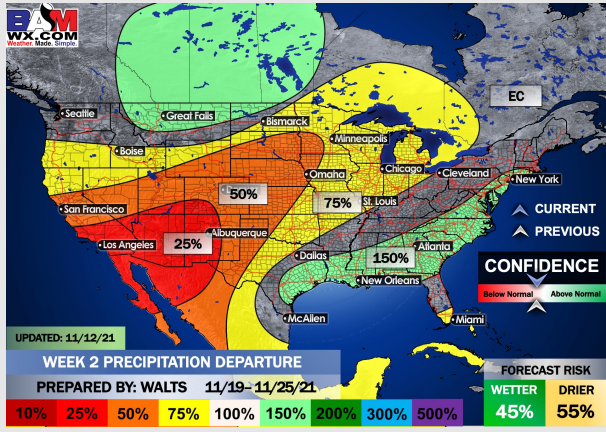
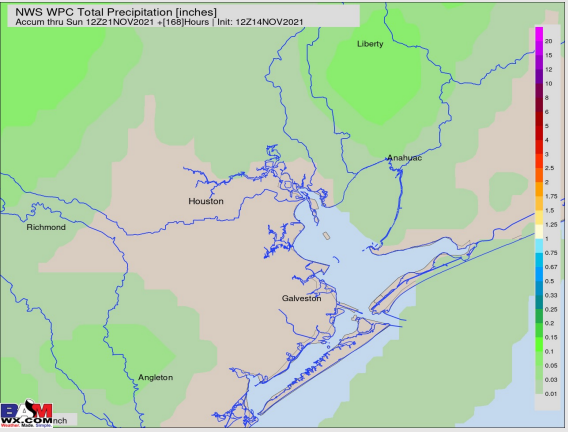
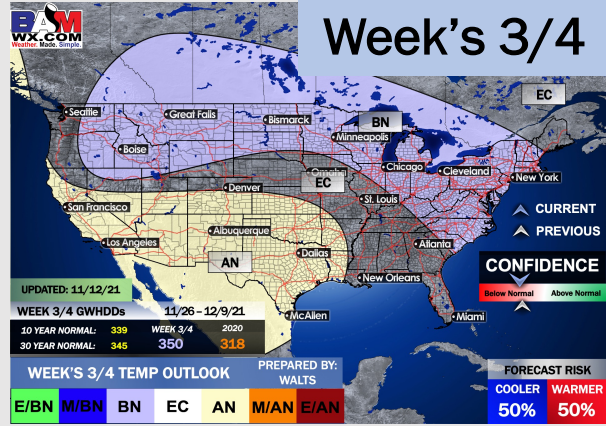
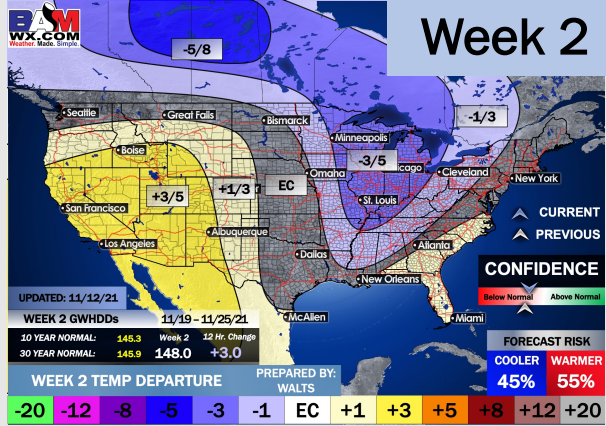
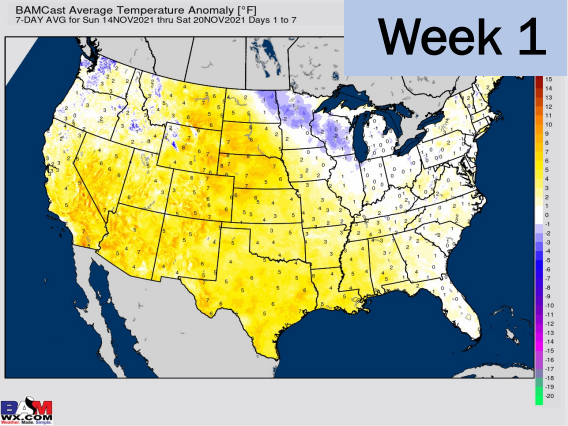

Houston Pilots: 11/14/21



- An overall inactive stretch is anticipated the next 7 days, with chances picking back up late next week THU-FRI. Temperatures are anticipated to average out to slightly above normal this week.
- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have near normal temperatures with slightly above normal risks for precip.
- Right now, we are favoring slightly above average temperature risks and slightly below normal risks for precip for the back half of November.
