

## Thursday, 11/25/21

Not anticipating fog for our stations on Thu. Briefly reduced visibility will be possible under a heavier shower in the AM as a front is expected to push through later.



## Friday, 11/26/21

Not anticipating fog for our stations on Fri. Elevated winds from the NE look to continue into Fri AM.



## Saturday, 11/27/21

Keeping an eye on light winds that could aid in fog potential, but currently not anticipating fog on Sat for our stations.


## Sim Radar Snapshot: 9 AM CT

**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions for our stations today.



**Wind:** Elevated winds continue into Monday AM from the N/NNE at 20-25 MPH for the boarding station with gusts 25-30 MPH through 11AM-Noon where winds calm to 13-18 MPH for the rest of the day. Gusts 18-23 MPH possible through the rest of Monday at the boarding station. Winds closer to midnight turn more ENE.

**Temps:** High temperatures look to be in the upper 60s to low 70s F.

**Visibility:** Fog is not anticipated today.


## Sim Radar Snapshot: 10 AM CT

**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions to continue for our stations on Tuesday.


**Wind:** Sustained winds for most of Tuesday look to be 8-13 MPH at the boarding station with gusts to 18 MPH possible through sundown. After around sundown, winds look to pick up closer to 13-18 MPH at the boarding station with gusts to 25 MPH through midnight. Winds out of the ENE in the AM, veering to Easterly by ~noon and then out of the SE by sundown.

**Temps:** High temperatures Tuesday look to sit in the upper 60s to low 70s F.


**Visibility:** Currently not favoring fog for our stations on Tuesday.

## Forecast Discussion


**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions to continue for our stations on Wednesday.



**Temps:** High temperatures Wednesday look to sit in the mid 70s F.

# Houston Pilots: 11/22/21



- Quiet conditions anticipated for the first half of the week before a front works through on our Thanksgiving Thursday.
- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have slightly below normal temperatures and slightly above normal risks for precip.
- Right now, we are favoring slightly above normal risks for temperatures and near normal to slightly above normal risks for precip for the first half of December.
