






- Current visibilities around the Galveston station show visibilities already lifting to 8 miles of visibility. Taking a look at specialized satellite products, some lower clouds/ patchy fog continue to be possible for stations 75/76 and points north.
- Latest guidance suggest this can continue to be possible out through about the 8 AM timeframe this morning. Guidance above shows patchy nature.
- > As the sunrises fog should start to lift pretty quickly.







9 PM CT FRI Visibility (miles)

Medium - High

- We still have above normal confidence on a more widespread dense fog threat heading into Saturday morning.
- As it stands now, will need to watch the 7 10 PM timeframe, especially from stations J to station D, for patchy fog development.
- ➤ The potential for fog continues to expand throughout the overnight into the evening as winds weaken and shift more out of the east (both more favorable for fog production). Best window looks to be in the 2 AM to 9 AM window with patchy fog perhaps lingering through about 10 − 11 AM. At times fog can reduce visibilities less than 0.5 miles (especially in the window). All stations at risk to see the fog.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: About 10% chance for a very light streaming shower/drizzle through about 5 PM today. Beyond 5 PM, a very isolated pocket of light drizzle cannot be ruled out but would favor mainly dry.

Wind: Sustained winds look to be 8-13 MPH out of the SE out through about 3 PM. Winds calm down just a bit thereafter closer to 5 – 10 MPH. Gusts 14-20 MPH will be possible as well.


Temps: High temps look to be in the upper 70s to low 80s F on Thu.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: An approaching cold front will be the catalyst for widespread showers/ storms on Saturday. While exact timing will need fine tuned, the overall thinking is that precipitation chances start to ramp up after 9 AM for some scattered showers/ storms. Better potential exists around 12 PM – 4 PM for storms, some which could be strong to severe in nature (strong wind gusts the main threat, secondary threat for hail). Beyond this period rain showers continue to be possible into the evening. Chances drop off after 9 PM with only isolated light showers towards midnight.

Wind: Light SE winds will be the theme throughout the morning / early afternoon sustained around 5-10 MPH. From about 2-4 PM, the cold front passes and winds begin to sharply shift out of the north. Sustained winds look pick up to 20-25 MPH sustained with gusts of 35-40 MPH late into the afternoon/ evening.


Temps: High Temperatures look to get into the mid 70's F.


Visibility: More information on fog potential Saturday morning in slides above. In addition, heavier rain will certainly hold the potential to reduce visibilities as well.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Sunday is expected to be a dry day, but will need to watch getting into the early morning hours of Monday for precipitation chances to return.

Wind: Winds will continue to be from the north throughout the day. Winds look to be sustained around 15 – 25 MPH in the morning before weakening slightly to 10 – 20 MPH into the evening. Gusts of 30 – 35 MPH will be possible in the AM with gusts of 25 – 30 MPH in the PM.


Temps: High tempers look to get into the upper 50's F


Visibility: Not favoring fog for Sunday with northerly / elevated winds.

Wind Speed 10 AM CT
























- Cold front moving through tomorrow certainly will hold the potential for heavier rain. Aside from this, a generally less active week.
- > The week 2 timeframe is expected to have above normal temperatures and below normal risks for precipitation.
- > Right now, we are favoring above normal risks for temperatures and near normal to below normal risks for precip for the end of December and the first week of Jan.
