


Forecast Discussion

Precip: Anticipating dry conditions on Friday


Wind: Winds are anticipated to start to veer more out of the ENE today and weaken a touch getting into the afternoon. Winds will be the lightest towards the Buffalo Bayou where sustained winds will be closer to 5 – 10 MPH. Towards the boarding station, sustained winds will be closer to 10 – 15 MPH. Winds start to pick up after sunset, more out of the east. Winds look to be sustained around 10 – 15 mph, at times, closer to 17 MPH for the boarding station. Gust near 20 – 25 MPH will be possible getting into this evening.


Temps: High Temps look to be in the upper 50s to low 60s F Visibility: Currently not favoring fog for our stations on Friday.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers and thunderstorms will be favored for most of the day Saturday. Slightly lower confidence on exact start time, but right now favoring mid-morning. Best time for more widespread storms will be into the afternoon hours of Saturday. There is a low end risk that some of the storms tomorrow could be strong to severe in nature with strong wind gusts and tornadoes possible.

Wind: Winds continue to shift more out of the SE throughout the morning hours of Saturday. Winds will be out of the SE throughout the day, sustained around 10 – 17 MPH (windiest towards the boarding station). Gusts around 25 MPH will be possible (stronger in storms). Winds slowly start to slow down into Sunday morning as winds shift more out of the South.


Temps: High temps rebound nicely to the mid 70s.


Visibility: Late tomorrow afternoon has a low confidence fog threat, especially after 5 PM through Sunday morning. This will need to be fine tuned in later forecast updates.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Showers and thunderstorms are possible in the AM hours proceeding the passage of a cold front. The afternoon/ evening hours are anticipated to be on the drier side.

Wind: Winds will start out the day on Sunday generally from the south before a cold front passes mid day. As this cold front passes will start to pick up through the evening hours. Winds on Sunday night likely become sustained closer to 15 – 20 MPH with gusts of 25 MPH possible. Timing and details will need to be fine-tuned in regards to this.


Temps: High temps look to get into the low to mid 70's on Sunday.


Visibility: As mentioned in the previous slide, will need to watch for some fog in the morning hours of Sunday before a cold front passes the area. This doesn't look to occur closer towards the 12 – 4 PM timeframe.

Wind Speed 9 PM CT






High Temps Sunday




















- Anticipating an overall dry upcoming work week. Precip chances look to come back in next weekend.
