

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Overall favoring a dry day today.

Wind: Sustained winds look to be 5-10 MPH out of the SSE with gusts 10-15 MPH at the boarding station for most of the AM hours. By around ~1 PM, sustained winds look to increase to 10-15 MPH with gusts 15-20 MPH possible at the boarding station and continue through the afternoon. By around ~9 PM, sustained winds are 15-20 MPH out of the SSW with at the boarding station. Winds then quickly start to calm down after midnight.


Temps: High Temps are expected to reach the mid 60s F.


Visibility: Currently not favoring fog for our stations.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A stray sprinkle (10-20% chance) for the afternoon at the boarding station cannot be fully ruled out, but overall dry conditions are favored.

Wind: Sustained winds in the very early AM hours of Wed look to be 10-15 MPH out of the WSW with gusts to 18 MPH at the boarding station. By 4-5 AM, sustained winds are 5-10 MPH at the boarding station. Winds veer from the NW in the AM to the S/SE for the PM. By 3 PM, winds tick up to 8-13 MPH sustained the rest of the day.


Temps: A gradual increase in temps leads to highs in the low to mid 70s F.


Visibility: Continuing to watch for a patchy fog threat for stations N of Morgan's Point in the early morning hours of Wed. This would likely be a brief, few hour window threat (3-7 AM) and would be more of typical "inland" fog that fades in the morning rather than sea fog. A slide will be added in the PM if the threat to our stations increases.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions to continue Thursday.

Wind: Sustained winds look to be 8-13 MPH at the boarding station for Thu AM and veering from the WSW to the NNW. By \sim 6 PM winds increase to 15-20 MPH sustained with gusts 20-25 MPH at the boarding station out of the north. Around 9 PM, sustained winds look to increase again to 20-25 MPH with gusts 25-30 MPH possible at the boarding station through midnight, and turn more out of the NE.


Temps: High temps Thu look to sit in the low 70s F.


Visibility: Keeping an eye on fog for Thu. Wind forecasts vary some, (thus leading to lower confidence) but there does look to be a slightly increased period of onshore flow where some patchy sea fog could occur. Keep an eye on this period for future updates as data will likely come into better agreement as wind forecasts are refined more

Wind Speed 6 PM CT



























- Anticipating an overall dry upcoming work week. Precip chances look to come back in next weekend.
