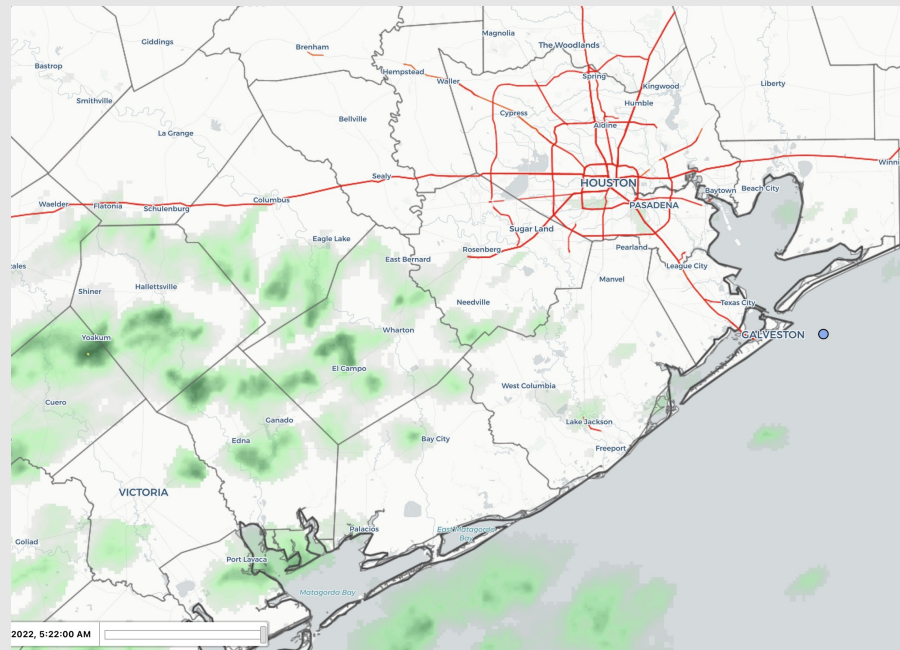

- Signal for fog continues to look weak over the next several days.

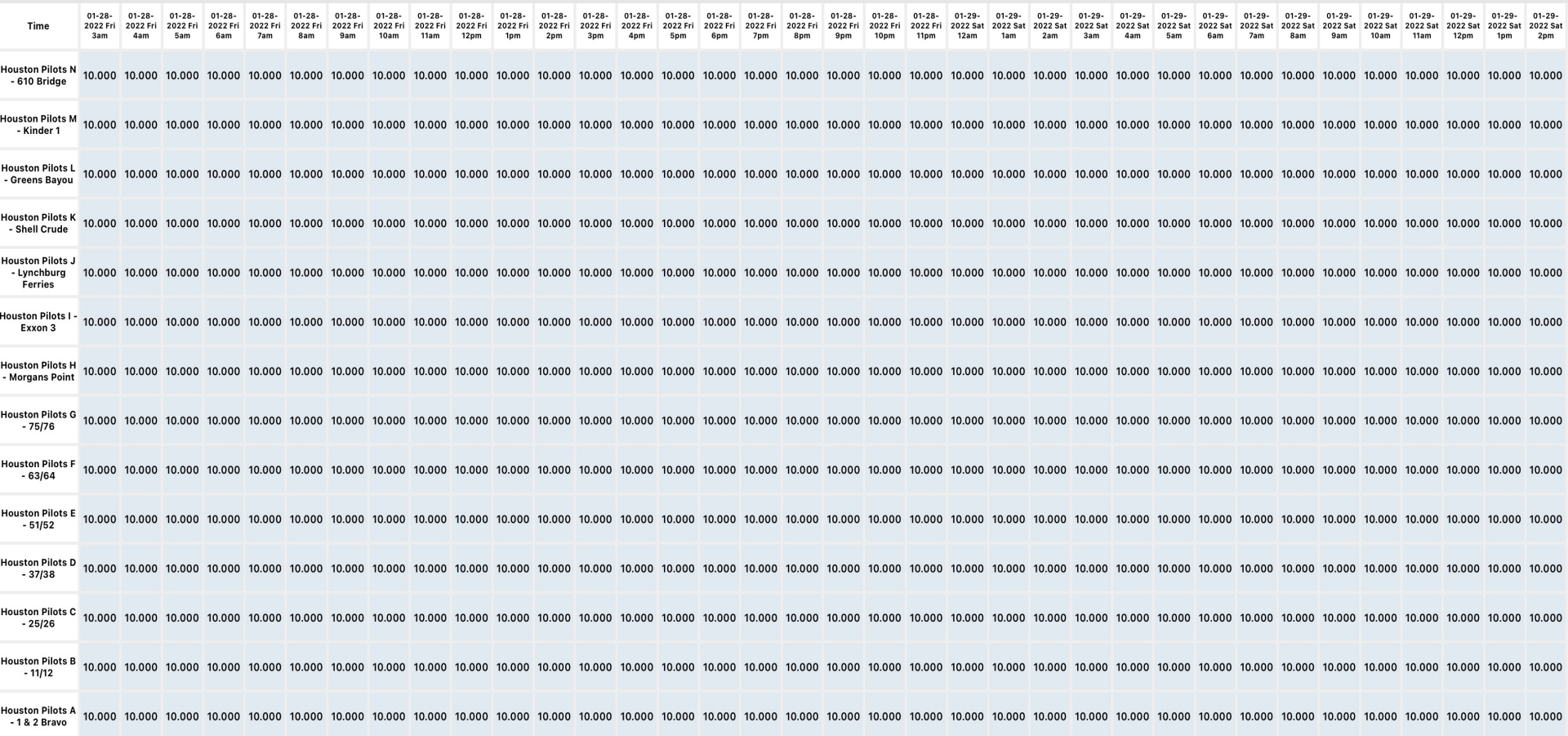

## Monday, 1/31/22

Worth watching trends on Monday out ahead of a shot of precipitation, but fog is currently not in the forecast.



## Wednesday, 2/2/22

Fog is currently not anticipated for Wednesday.



## Tuesday, 2/1/22

Pending timing of precipitation exit on Monday, patchy fog could be possible. This would not be sea fog, but rather fog that mainly impacts inland areas and is out in a couple hours in the AM.

## Forecast Discussion

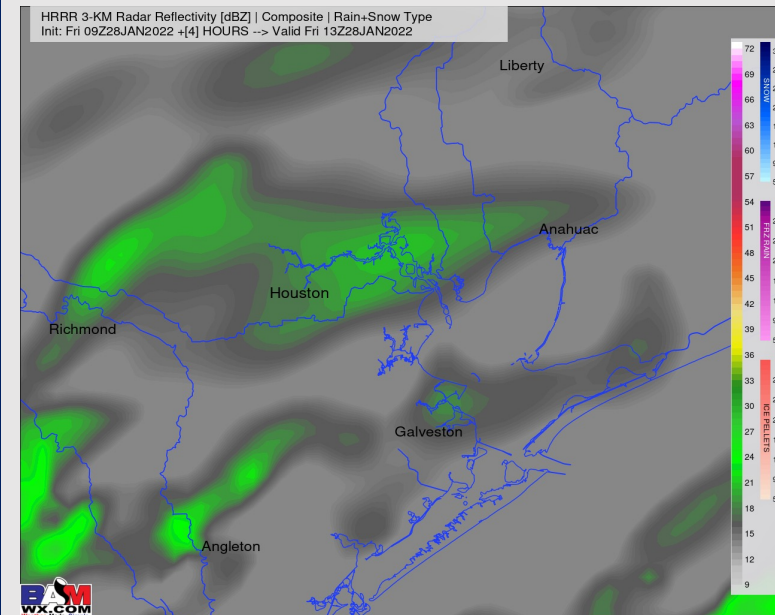
**Precip:** Out through ~10 AM, scattered chances for hit and miss pockets of light precip will be possible. As previously noted the bulk of moisture with this wave stays south, but we still favor for some light showers to be able to work through the stations. Any moisture looks to be short lived and rather light.

**Wind:** Winds most of the daytime hours will be coming out of the N/NNE sustained at 18 - 23 MPH with gusts 23 - 28 MPH.

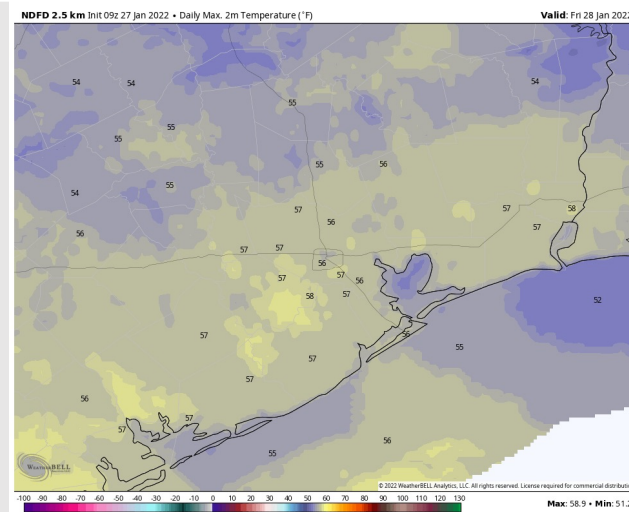
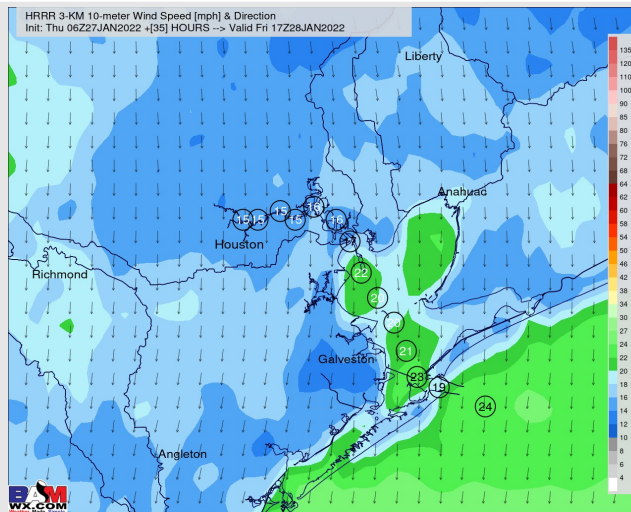
**Temps:** Looking at highs in the mid 50s.

## Forecast Discussion

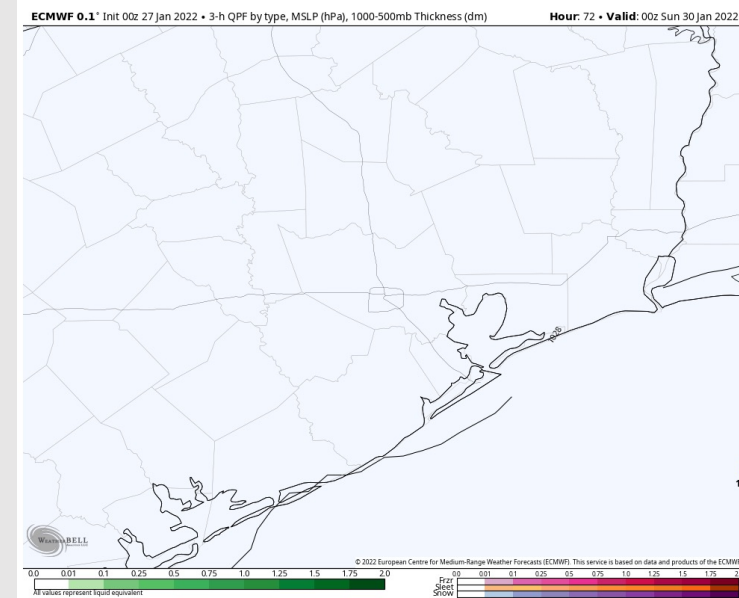
**Precip:** Favoring a quiet Saturday.

**Wind:** Winds will start out the day at 5-10 MPH with gusts locally higher (10-15 MPH) from the N. Around ~1-3 PM winds will calm and flip directions to the S/SSW at 8-13 MPH (gusts to 18 MPH).

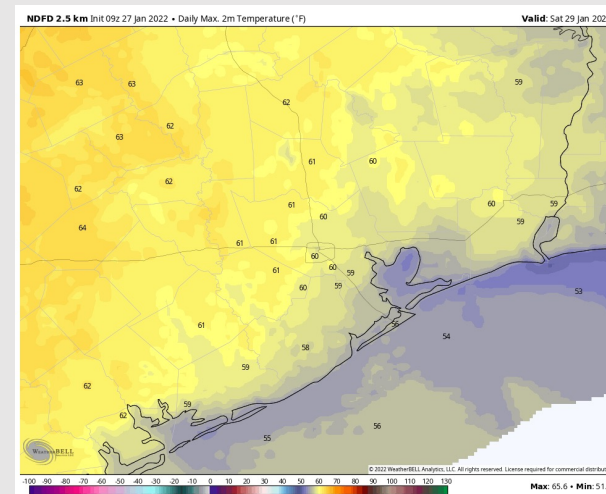
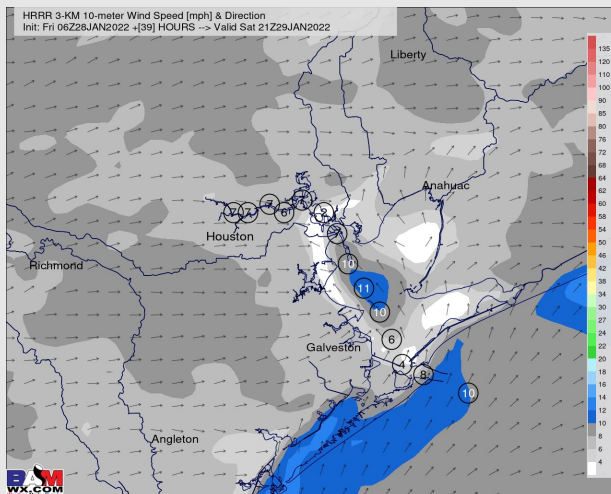
**Temps:** Highs again Saturday will be in the mid to upper 50s.

## Forecast Discussion

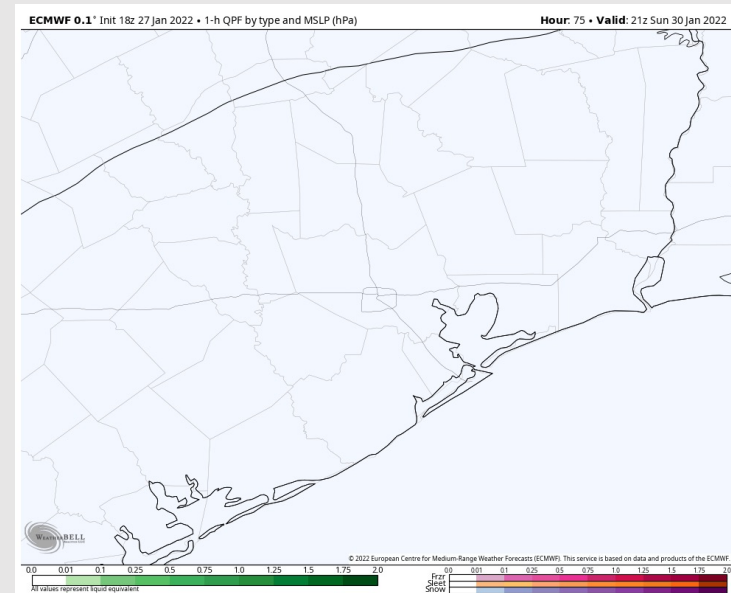
**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions Sunday.

**Wind:** Winds look to sit 5-10 MPH with a few gusts of 10-15 MPH possible. Winds do vary in direction a bit from W to SW through the day. Before turning more southerly and increasing after sundown.

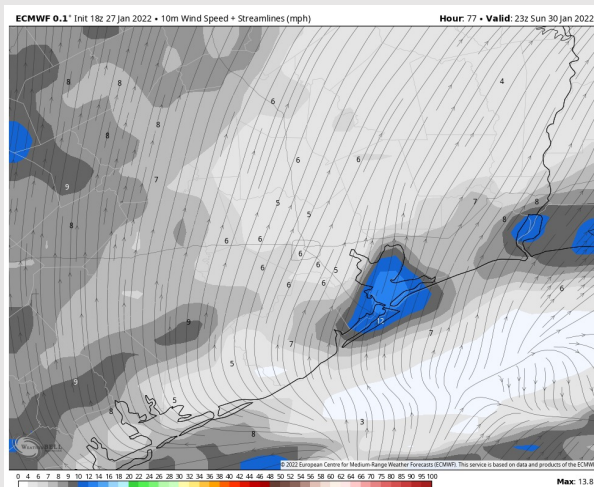
**Temps:** Highs anticipated to be in the upper 50s and lower 60s for the stations.

**Visibility:** No fog expected for Sunday.

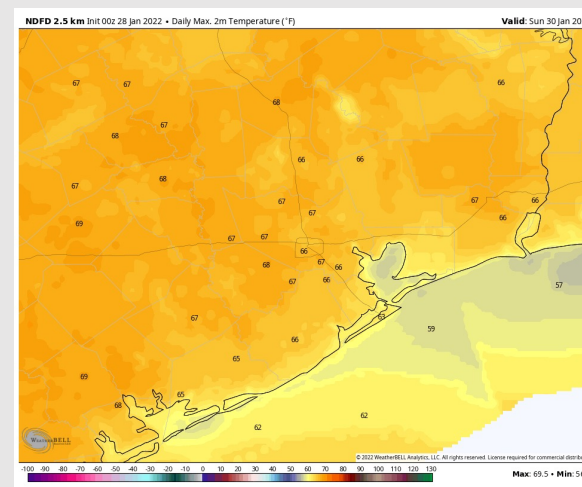

# Houston Pilots: 1/28/22



- Next best chances for precipitation will be coming Monday in the PM hours and then again Wednesday night.
- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have above normal temperatures with near normal risks for precip.
- Right now, we are favoring above normal risks for temperatures and slightly below normal risks for precip for the weeks 3 and 4 timeframe.
