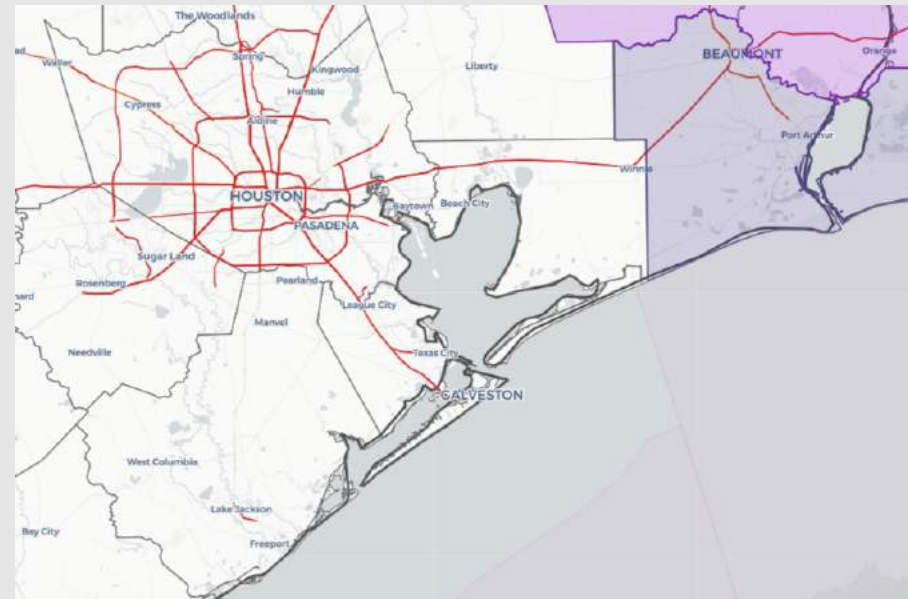

Forecast Discussion

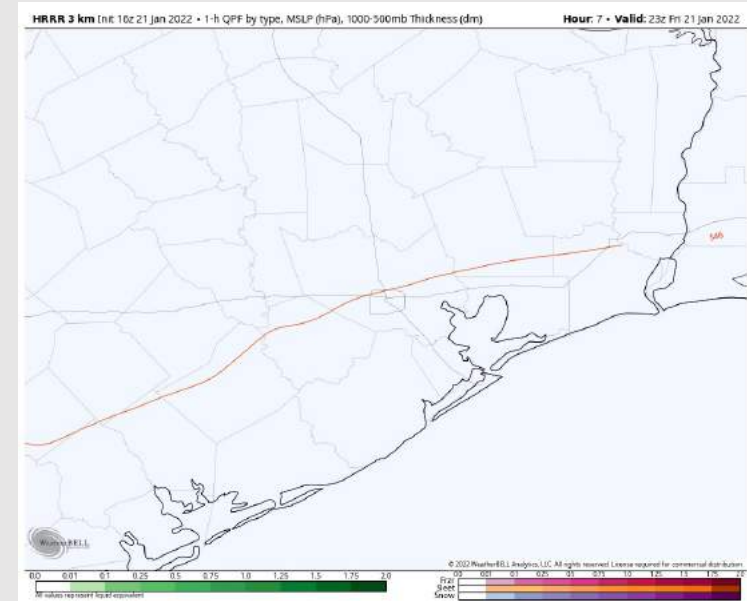
Precip: Dry conditions are expected for the remainder of the day.

Wind: Winds look to be sustained out of the NE from 10 – 15 MPH, until picking up slightly this evening to 15 – 20 MPH at the boarding station, with gusts up to 25 MPH being possible.

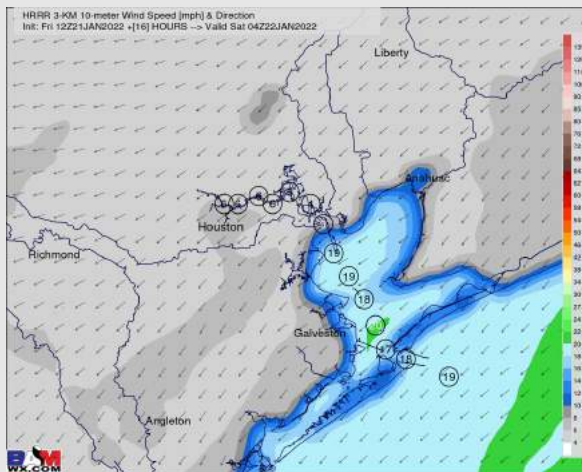
Temps: Low temps expected to be in the low 40s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating fog Friday.

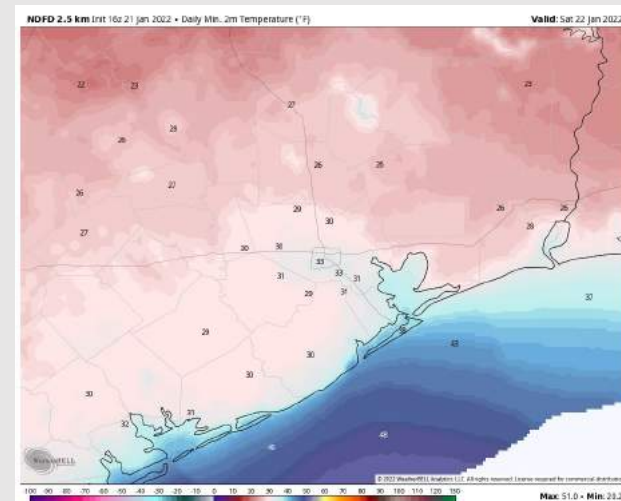

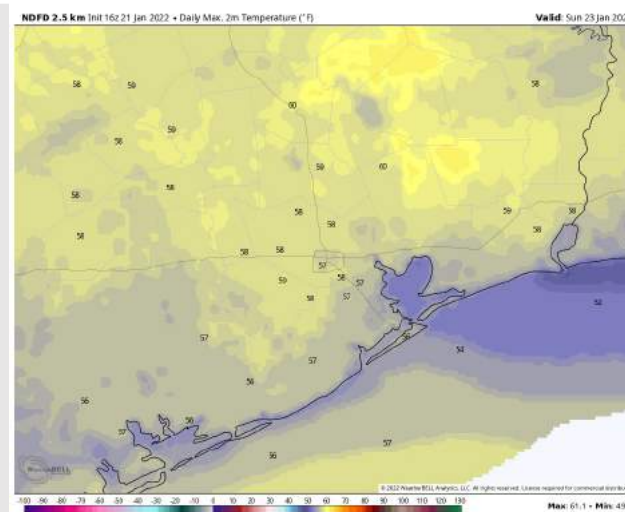
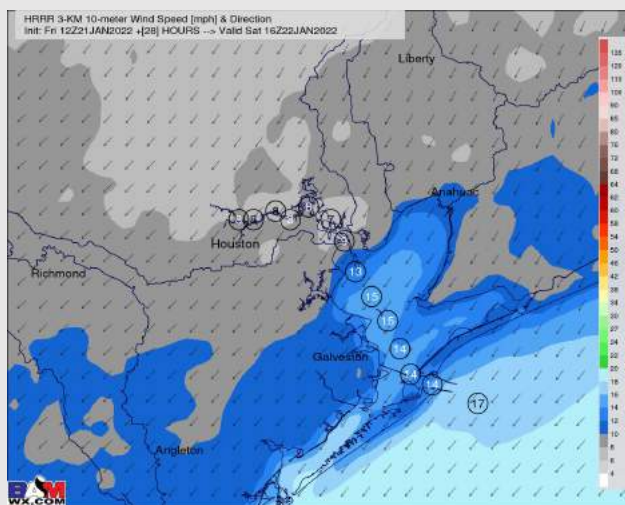
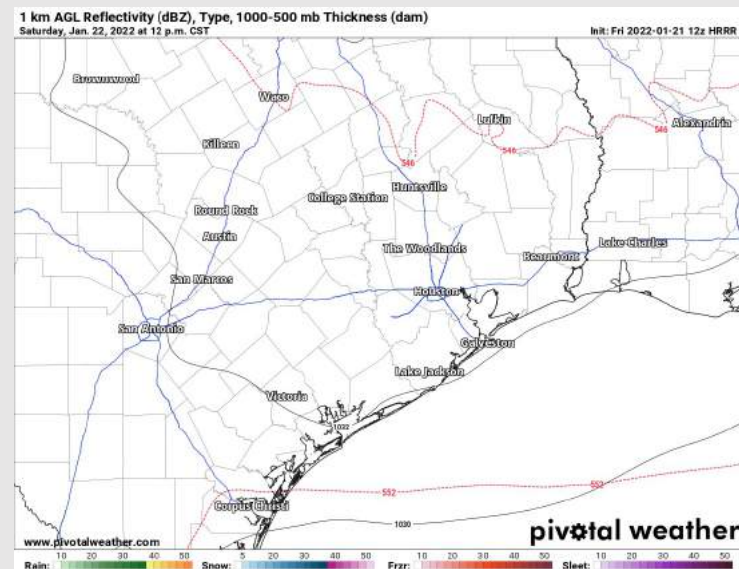
Precip: Saturday is favored to stay quiet around the area.

Wind: Once again, winds look to be out of the NE throughout the day. In the AM, the 10 – 15 MPH sustained winds continue (weaker towards the Buffalo Bayou), with a gradual weakening into the afternoon/ evening to 8 – 13 MPH in the afternoon, and closer to 5 – 10 MPH later in the evening.

Temps: Saturday likely tops out in the lower 50s.

Visibility: No fog expected Saturday.

Forecast Discussion

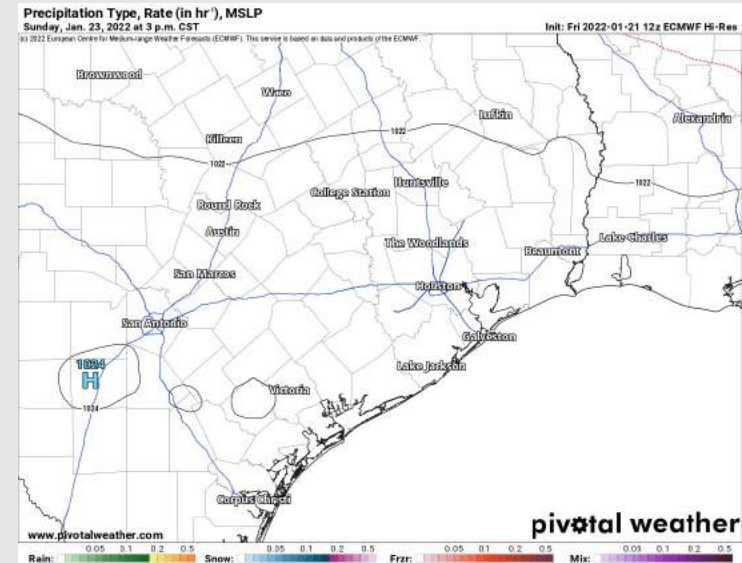
Precip: A dry day is favored for Sunday. Rain chances return getting into Monday.

Wind: Generally lighter winds continue from the north for the first half of the day on Sunday then shift from the south into the evening. Winds in the evening hours of Sunday look to be sustained around 3 – 8 MPH.

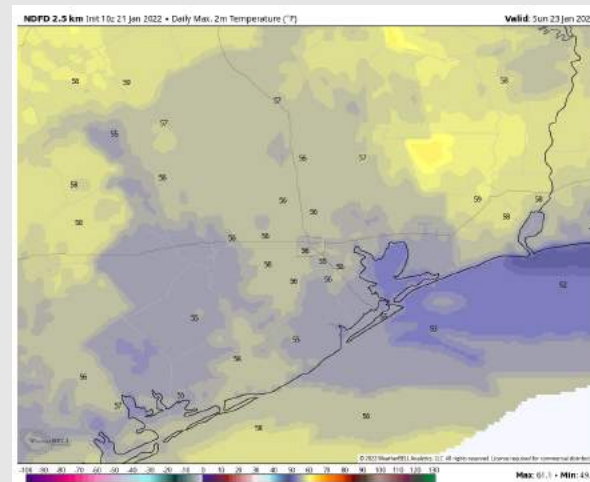
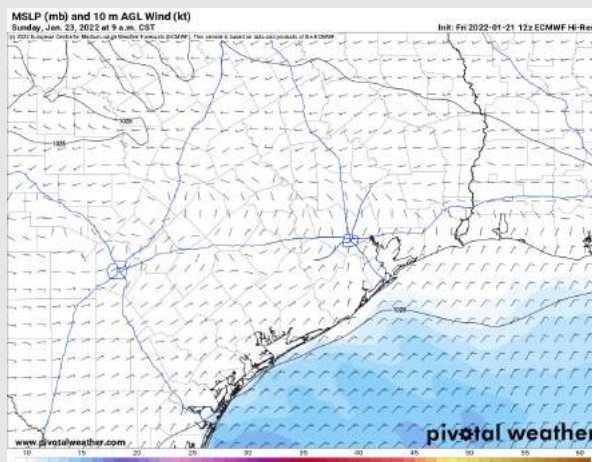
Temps: Temperatures look to get into the low-to-mid 50's F on Sunday.

Precip Forecast: 6 PM CT

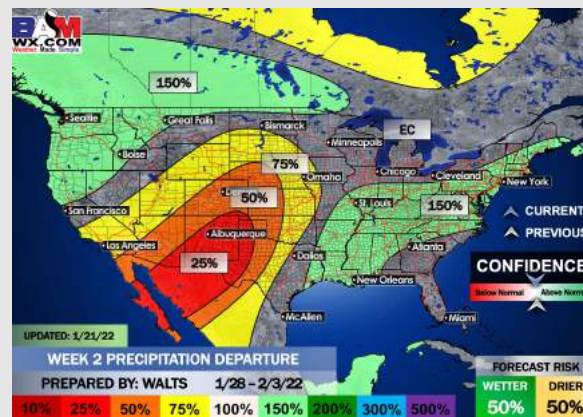
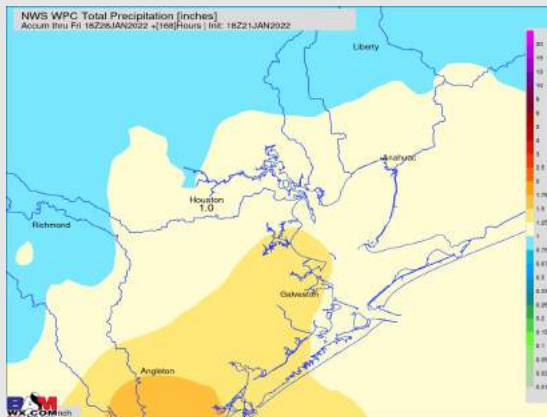
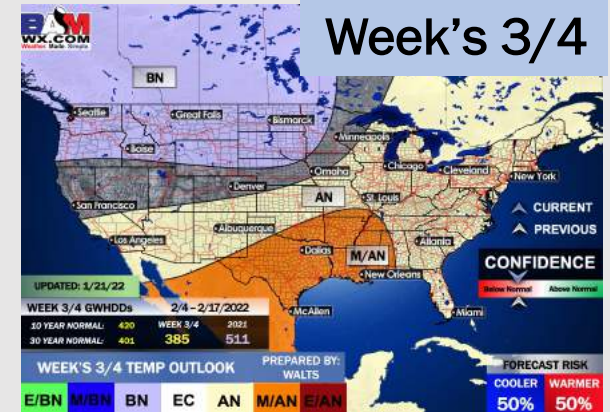
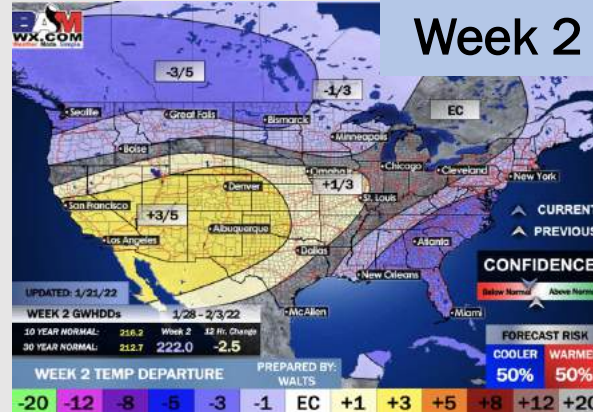
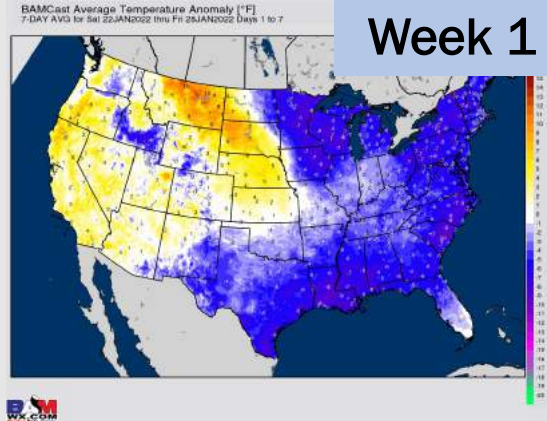

Houston Pilots: 1/21/22



- Overall temperatures are expected to be below normal for the next 7 days with the best shot of precipitation occurring Monday into TUE morning.
- The week 2 timeframe offers up some slightly above normal precipitation risks with cooler temperatures as we see some influence from the southern jet.
- Right now, we are favoring above normal risks for temperatures and slightly below normal risks for precip for the weeks 3 and 4 timeframe.
