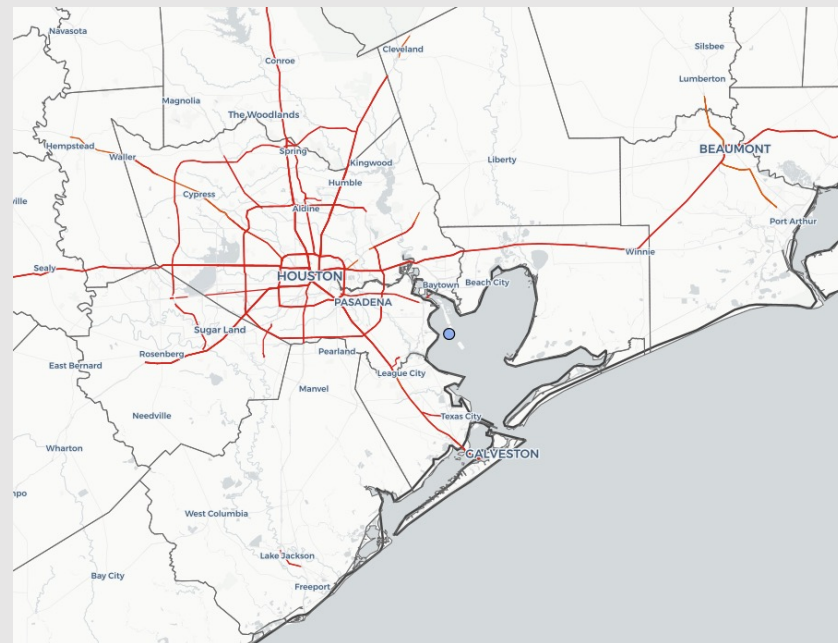

- Fog does not look to be anticipated over the next several days.

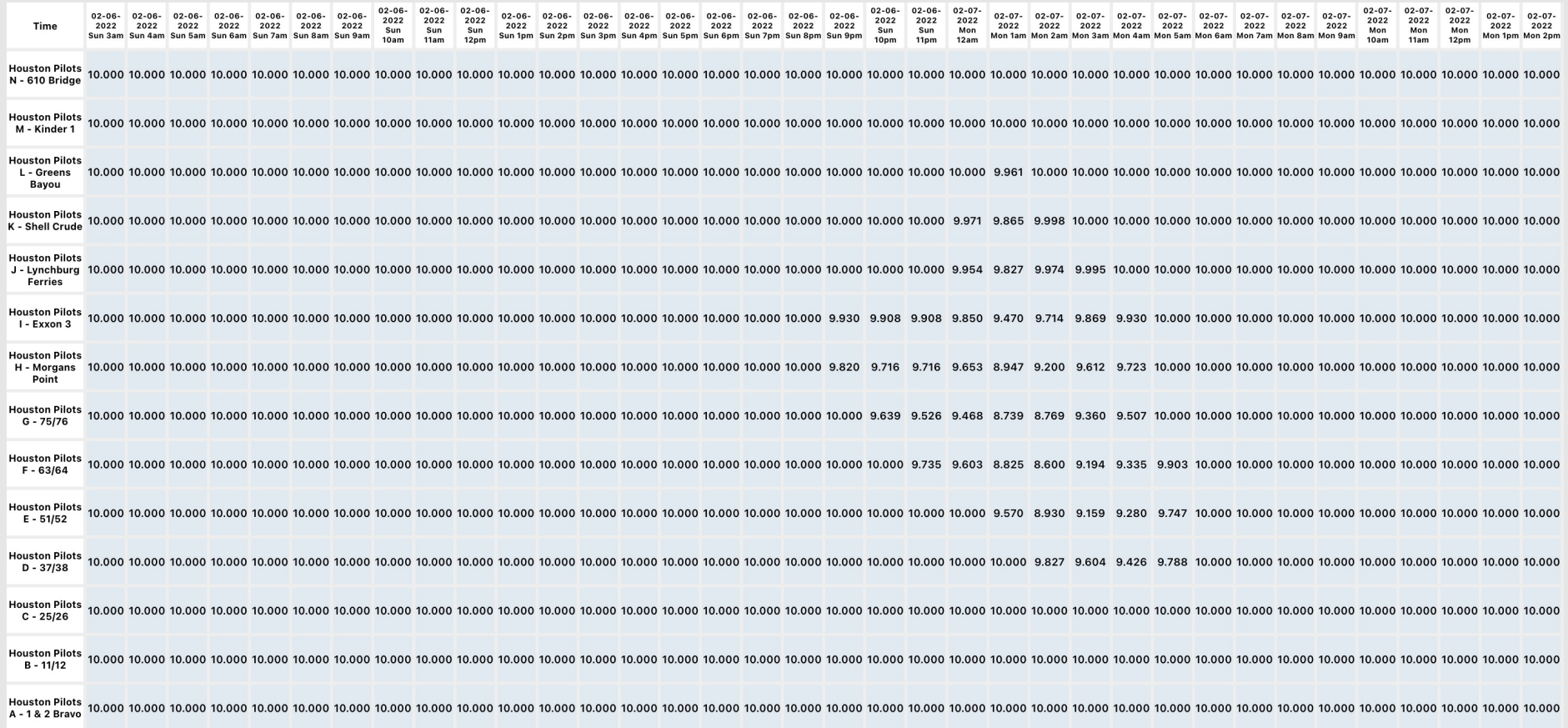

## Forecast Discussion

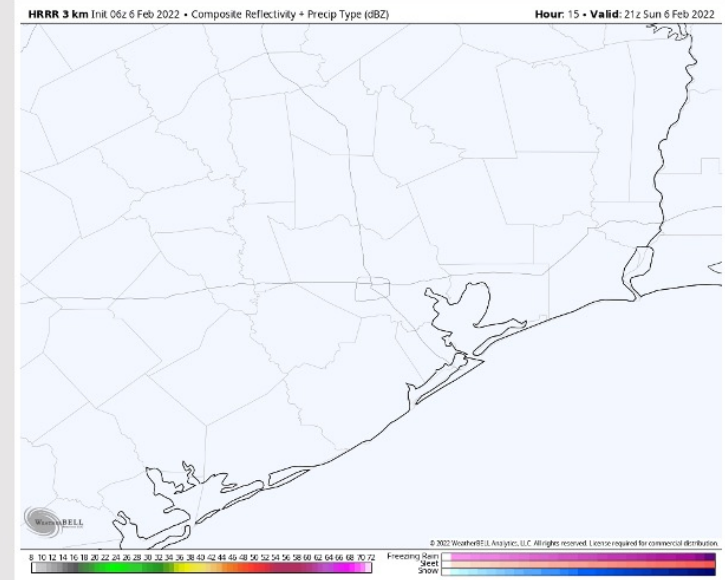
**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions for our stations today.

**Wind:** Sustained winds are 5-10 MPH out of the N/NE through the ~mid morning hours today. After ~9 AM, winds turn out of the SE at 3-8 MPH through sundown. After sundown winds turn again out of the NE at 3-8 MPH sustained.

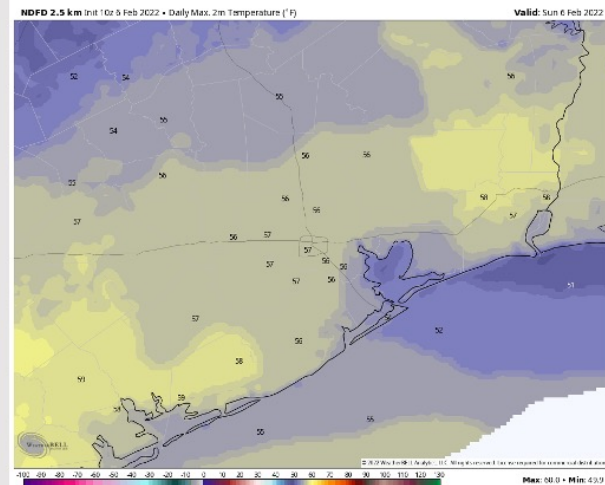
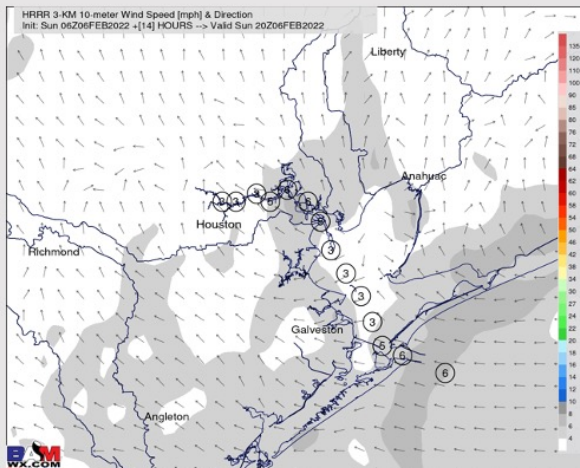
**Temps:** High temps today sit in the low to mid 50s F.

**Visibility:** Patchy fog/reduced visibility has stayed clear of our stations so far this morning. Data is now less in favor of any patchy fog development making its way closer to the stations. Currently favoring any patchy reduced visibility to continue to stay away from the stations this AM.

## Forecast Discussion

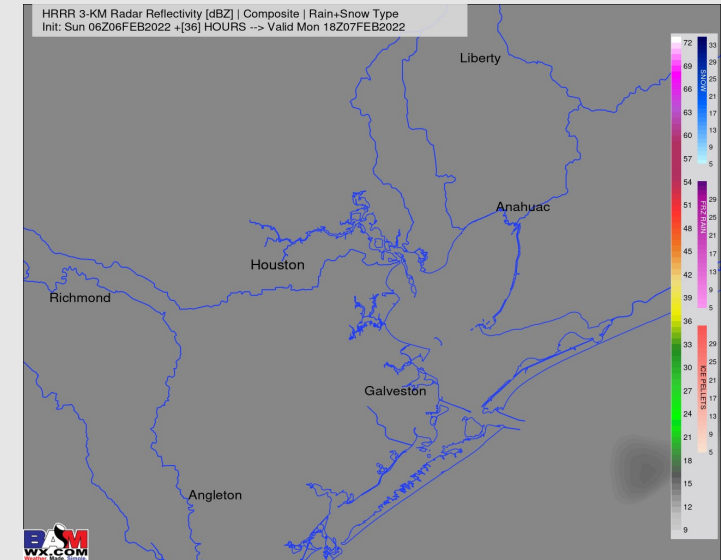
**Precip:** Dry conditions are favored for Monday.

**Wind:** Sustained winds out of the N at 8 – 13 MPH veer out of the NNW ~1PM. Gusts up to 20 MPH will be possible throughout the day. Winds looks to pick up to 15 – 20 MPH with gusts up to 25 MPH ~10PM.

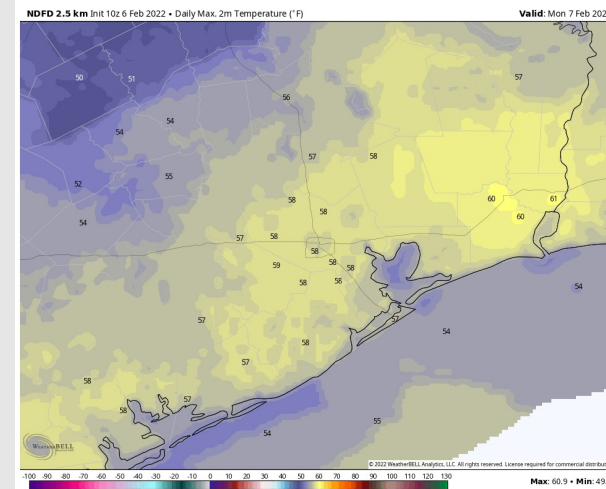
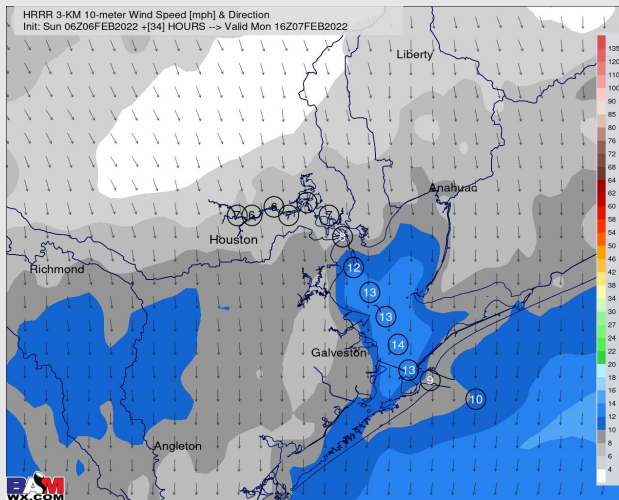
**Temps:** Highs on Monday look to sit in the mid 50s F.

## Forecast Discussion

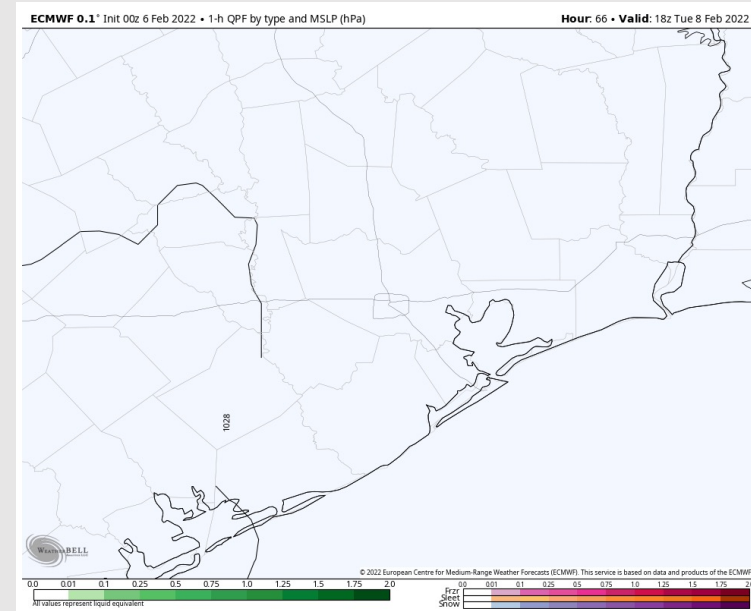
**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions for our stations today.

**Wind:** Sustained winds at 13 – 18 MPH and gusts up to 20 MPH in the overnight hours look to decrease to 8 – 13 MPH by 5AM out of the N. By late morning, winds decrease again to 5 – 10 MPH out of the NNW and continue through midnight. At ~7PM, winds veer out of the WSW.

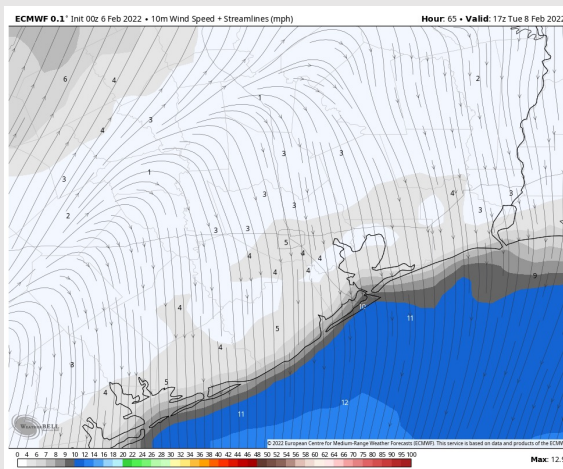
**Temps:** Highs Tuesday look to sit in the mid to upper 50s F.
