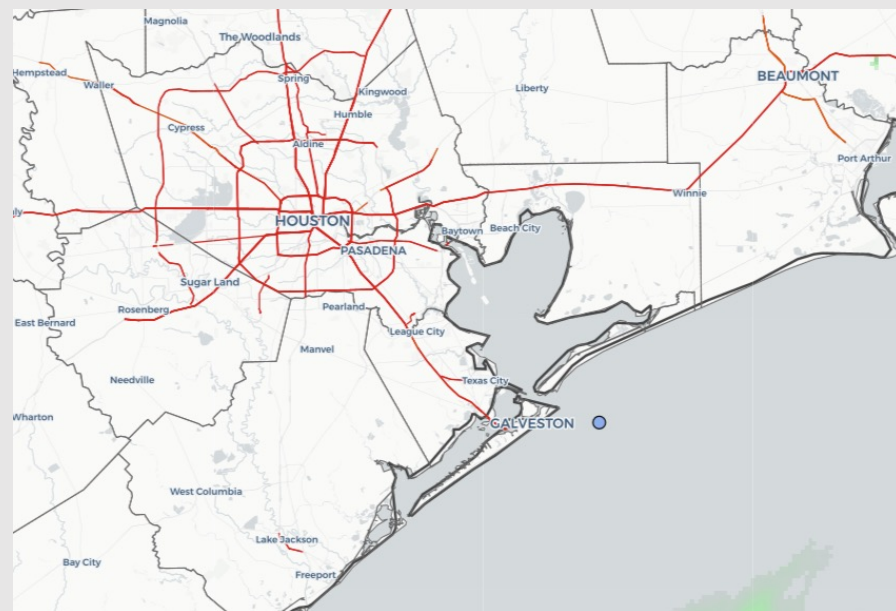

With light SSW winds in the early pre—dawn hours of Thu, fog development looks to be possible. Low confidence further into Thu AM as winds veer out of the NW.

Forecast Discussion

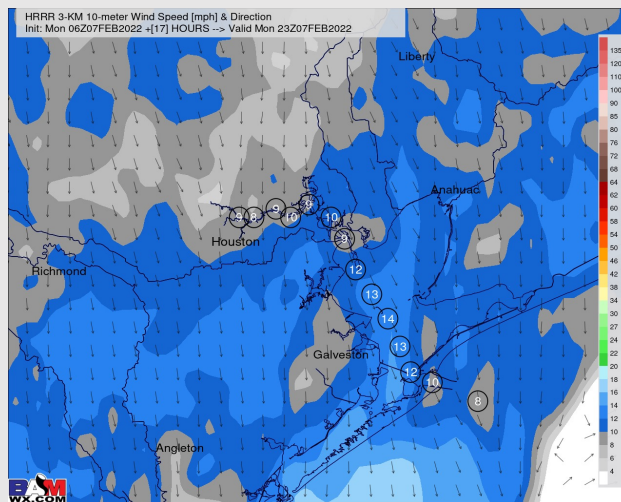
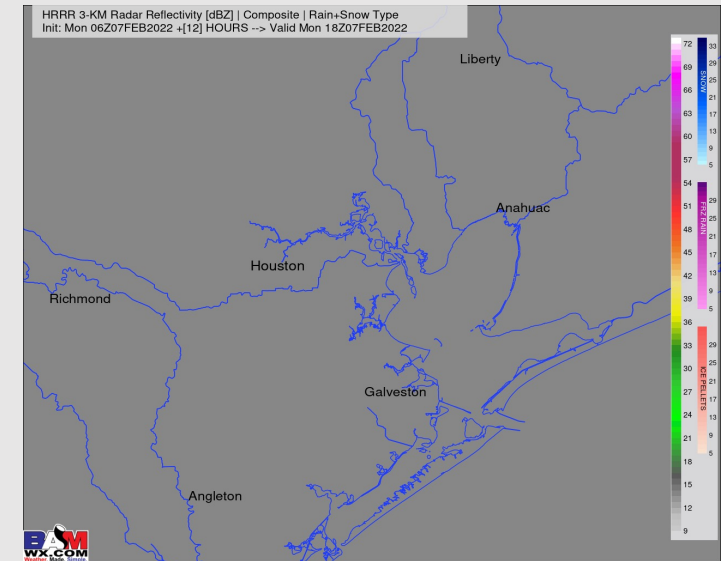
Precip: Dry conditions are favored for today.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the NE at 13 – 18 MPH and gusts up to 20 MPH look to decrease to 5 – 10 MPH ~6AM. Gusts up to 25 MPH at times can't be ruled out. Winds look to pick up to 10 – 15 MPH ~midnight.

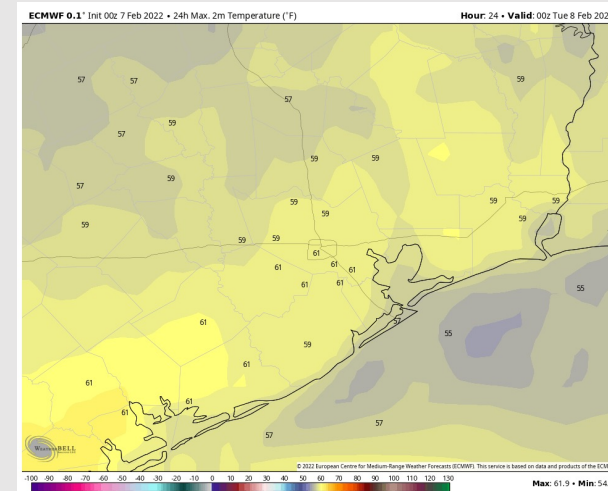
Temps: Highs on Monday look to sit in the mid 50s F.

Visibility: Currently not anticipating fog for our stations Monday.

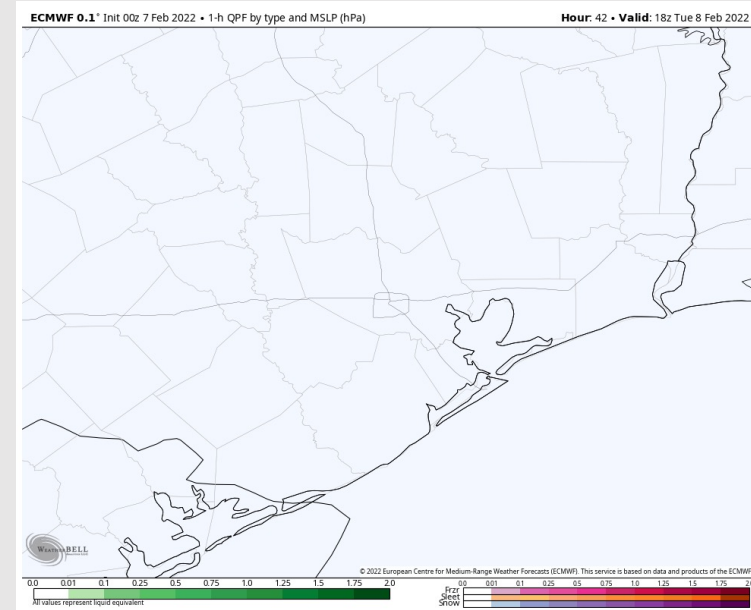
Precip: Anticipating dry conditions for our stations Tuesday.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the N at 8 – 13 MPH with gusts 13 – 18 MPH decrease ~6AM. Winds then drop to 3 – 8 MPH as winds veer out of the SW ~1PM.

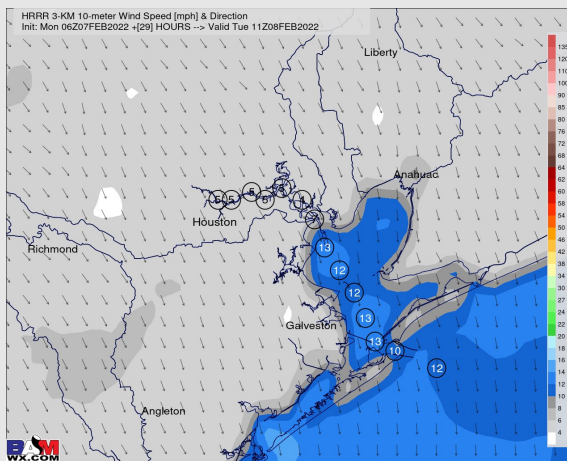
Temps: Highs Tuesday look to sit in the mid to upper 50s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating fog for our stations Tuesday.

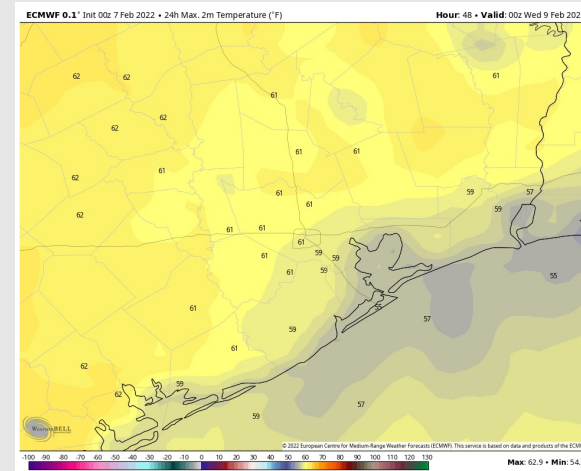

Forecast Discussion

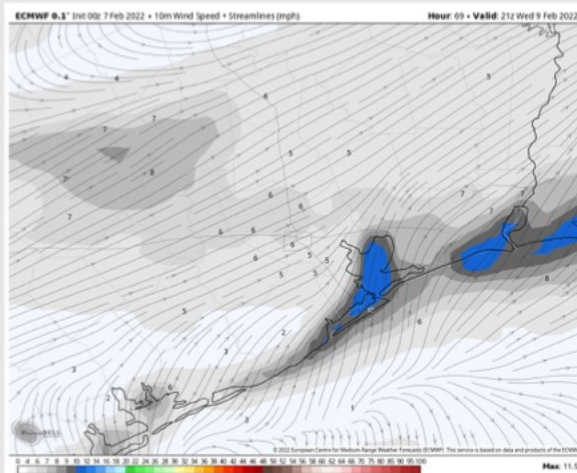
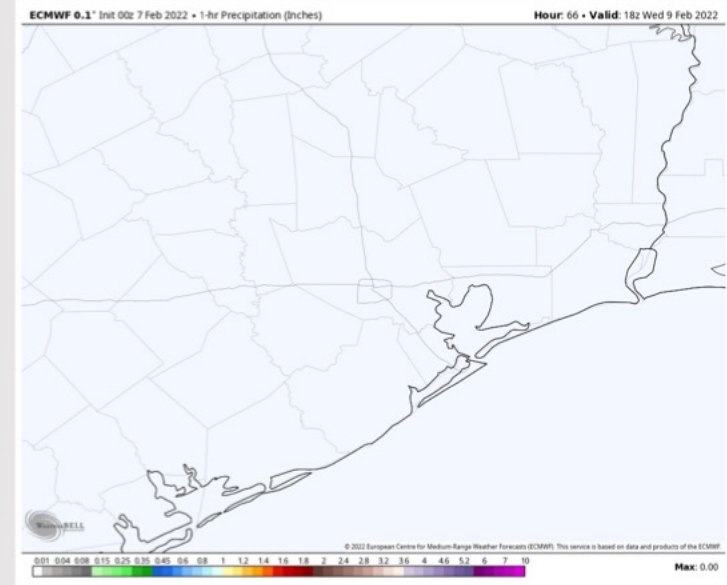
Precip: Anticipating dry conditions for our stations on Wednesday.

Wind: Sustained winds look to be 3-8 MPH out of the WSW for Wednesday AM and into the early afternoon hours. After ~2-3 PM, sustained winds are 5-10 MPH and veer out of the south at the boarding station through midnight.

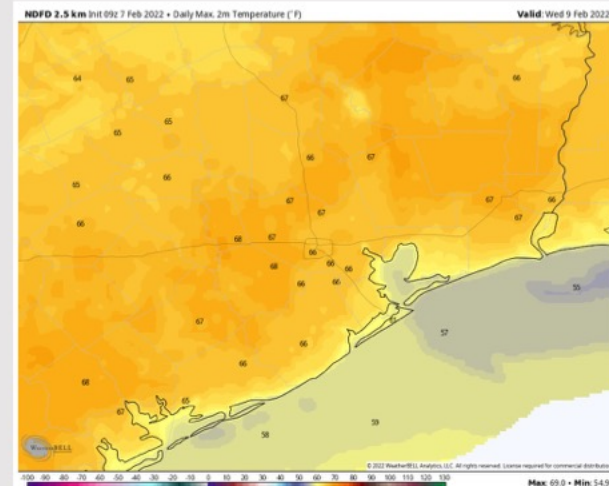
Temps: High temps Wednesday look to be in the low to mid 60s F.

Visibility: Some data is trying to pick up on patchy "in-land" fog Wed AM with calm SW winds. Keeping an eye on this for more details in future updates.
