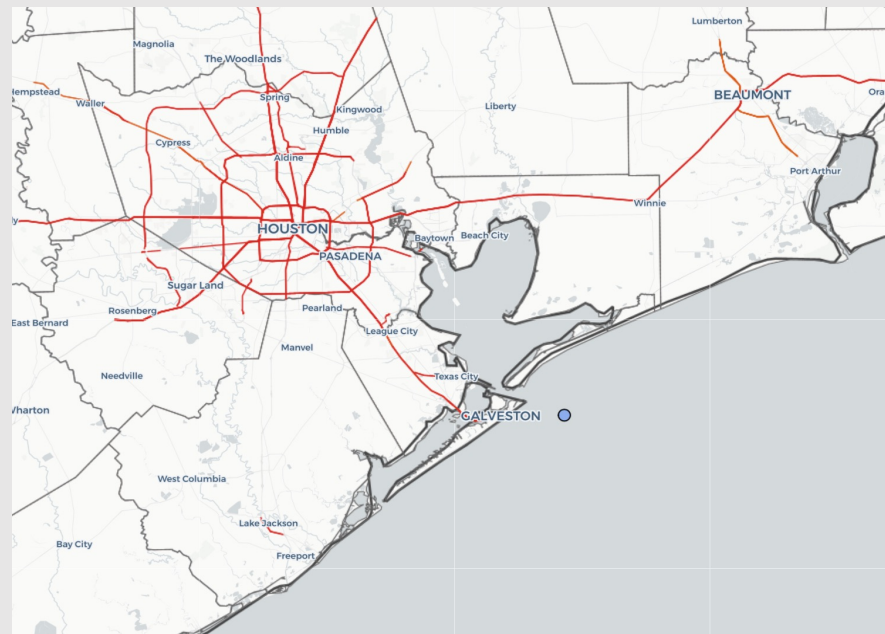

## Friday, 2/11/22

Patchy “in-land” fog cannot be ruled out for Friday AM with calm/light winds. Better chance for sea fog could come Fri night into Sat AM with southerly winds.

Not anticipating fog on Sunday with elevated northerly winds.

## Forecast Discussion

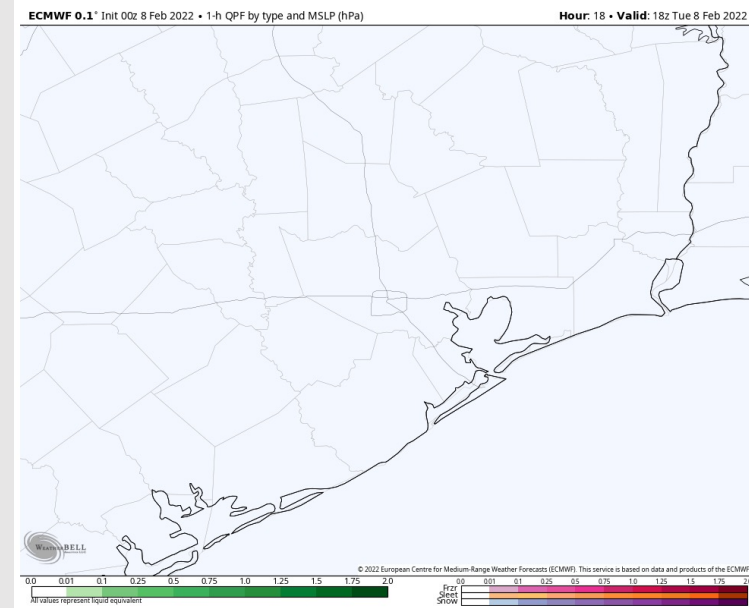
**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions for our stations today.

**Wind:** Sustained winds look to briefly be 13 – 18 MPH, with gusts up to 20 MPH at the boarding station until decreasing ~10 AM to 5 – 10 MPH. Winds rotate from NW to NE ~7AM. Winds veer again ~2PM to be out of the SSW, which continues through midnight.

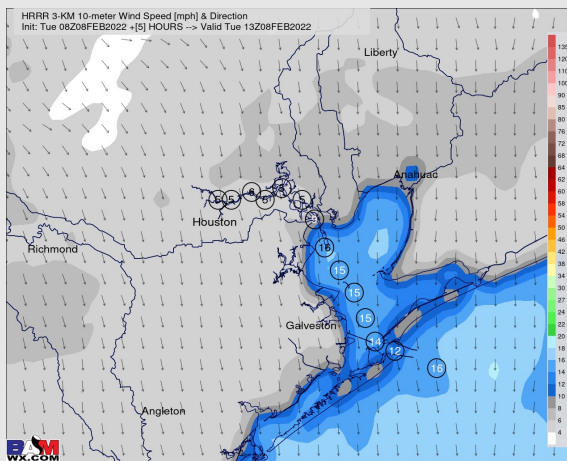
**Temps:** High Temps Tuesday sit in the upper 50s to low 60s F.

**Visibility:** Not anticipating fog for our stations today.

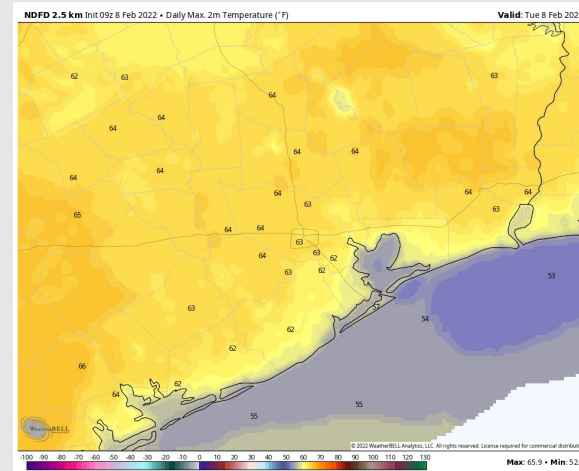

## Forecast Discussion

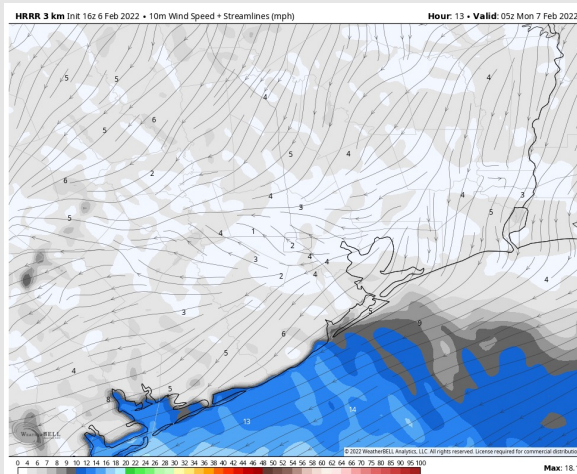
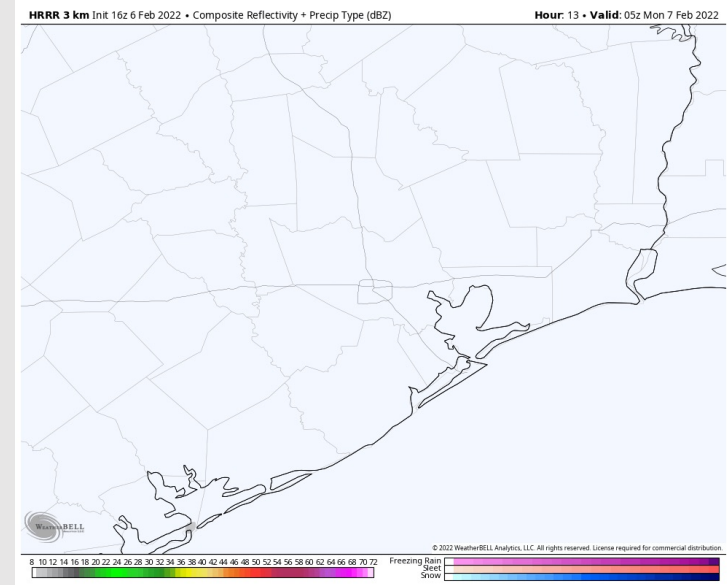
**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions for Wednesday.

**Wind:** Sustained winds look to be out of the WSW at 3 – 8 MPH before picking up ~2-3PM to 8 – 13 MPH and veer more out of the SW. Gusts up to 15 MPH will be possible at the boarding station through the day.

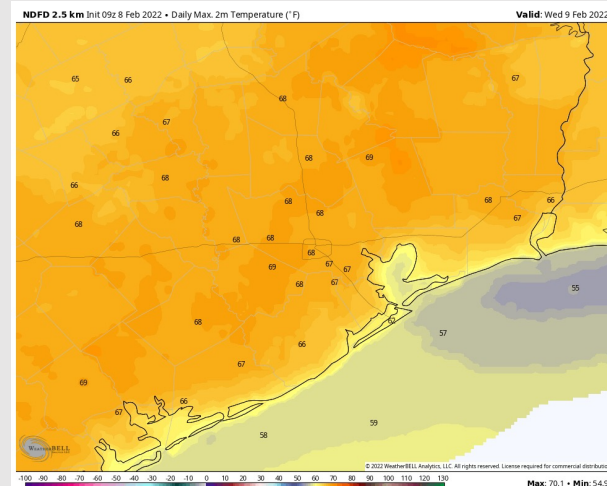
**Temps:** High temps Wednesday are in the high 50s to low 60s F.

**Visibility:** Not anticipating fog for our stations Wednesday.

# Houston Pilots: Thu. 2/10/2022

## Forecast Discussion

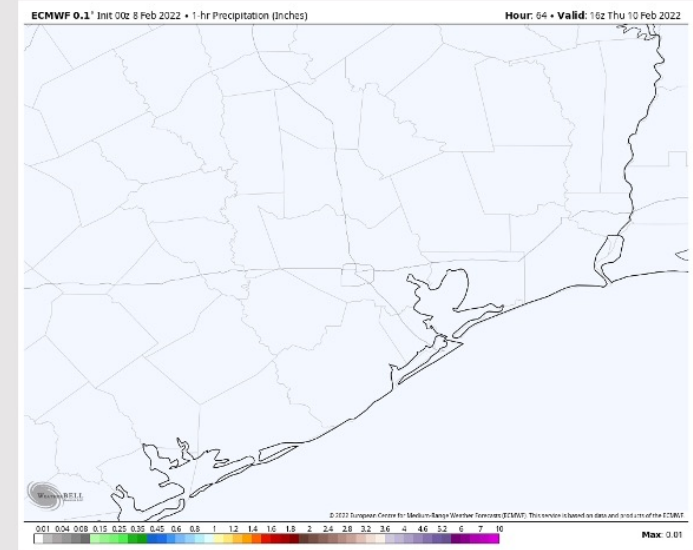
**Precip:** Dry conditions are favored to continue Thursday.

**Wind:** Sustained winds look to be 3-8 MPH for most of the day on Thursday, veering from the west to SW in the AM hours. Sustained winds look to be closer to 5-10 MPH at the boarding station after ~3-4 PM and beyond, veering out of the SSW.

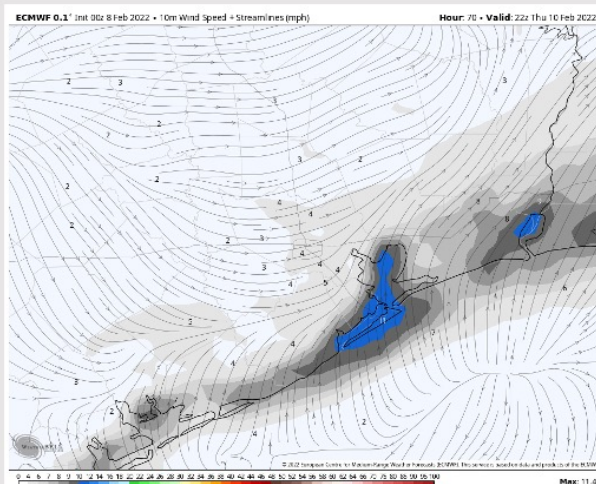
**Temps:** High temps Thursday sit in the mid to upper 60s F.

**Visibility:** Not favoring sea fog with westerly winds, however, patchy "in-land" fog looks to be possible. Keeping an eye on this potential, however, data currently has most of the threat north of our stations.
