



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions today.

Wind: Winds will be coming from the NW from daybreak through Noon. After this, winds shift back out of the SW. Much of the day will be sustained winds of 5-10 MPH with a few gusts at the boarding station reaching 15 MPH.


Temps: High temps Wednesday are in the high 50s to low 60s F for our stations, mid 60s downtown HOU.


Visibility: Not anticipating fog for our stations today.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: No precip concerns expected Thursday.

Wind: With a weak front passing in the AM, winds will once again be coming from the NW from daybreak out through about midday at 3-8 MPH. Winds the back half of the day will be from the SSW at 8-13 MPH sustained, gusts locally higher.


Temps: Highs Thursday work into the lower to mid 60s. Upper 60s are favored North of the stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating fog impacts Thursday, however we may need to watch for patchy fog inland in the AM hours (further inland from the stations). Sea fog is not favored. More details will be provided in PM update.




Forecast Discussion




Visibility: Friday AM may be another morning for patchy fog further inland, but currently do not see a threat for the stations.

Wind Speed 5 PM CT



























- Dry conditions are favored for at least the next several days. Temps average out slightly below normal this week.
