

- Calm/light winds are favored to continue for the next few days.
- Next front works through Saturday PM and brings minor precip chances + elevated NW winds for Sat night/ Sun AM

## **Forecast Discussion**


*Precip:* Anticipating dry conditions the rest of today.

Wind: Winds shift back out of the SSW for the remainder of the day and will be sustained 3-8 MPH with a few gusts at the boarding station reaching 8-13 MPH.


Temps: Lows likely sit in the lower 50s for the stations, cooler inland where temps drop back into the lower 40s.


Visibility: Not anticipating fog for our stations this evening.







#### 6 AM THU Visibility (miles)

### Fog Threat

- The threat for fog continues to remain on the lower end tomorrow, however there does look to be a very brief window tomorrow AM where some very patchy may be able to creep into the stations (current thinking would be ~30% probability of occurrence for the stations with higher chances coming further inland from the Gulf/ Galveston Bay coastlines).
- Currently eyeing the 5 8 AM window for the best threat from Morgan's Point to 25/26. This is not sea fog and any fog would likely burn off very shortly after sunrise.
- Fog may be around areas further inland earlier in the AM as these setups allow for fog development better over land vs over water. Any fog likely remains patchy in nature. We would lean toward any fog not impacting stations, but wanted to make sure the low end threat was mentioned.

## **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: No precip concerns expected Thursday.

Wind: With a weak front passing in the AM, winds will once again be coming from the NW from daybreak out through about midday at 3-8 MPH. Winds the back half of the day will be from the SSW at 8-13 MPH sustained, gusts locally higher.


Temps: Highs Thursday work into the lower to mid 60s. Upper 60s are favored North of the stations.






## **Forecast Discussion**




Visibility: Friday AM may be another morning for patchy fog further inland, but currently do not see a threat for the stations.

Wind Speed 5 PM CT























- Dry conditions are favored for at least the next several days. Temps average out slightly below normal this week.
