

Currently not favoring fog Sun AM for our stations.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: A 20-30% chance for a few sprinkles/ very light rain showers will continue to be this morning. Any precip would likely be very short lived. 10-20% chance for the afternoon hours exists, but drier conditions are favored. 20-30% chances for something light return after sundown.

Wind: Sustained winds look to be 10-15 MPH out of the SE for most of the day on Wed with gusts 15-20 MPH at the boarding station throughout the day. After sundown, winds look to pick up to 15-20 MPH with gusts 20-25 MPH at the boarding station into the overnight.


Temps: High temps look to sit in the upper 60s to low 70s F on Wed (warmer inland, cooler closer to boarding station).


Visibility: Patchy mist looks to be possible this morning as a sprinkle moves overhead and may produce pockets of reduced visibility. Reduced visibility looks to be possible again ~4PM through at least midnight. At the moment, not anticipating visibilities less than 3 miles, but this will need to be monitored.






- Tricky forecast here as there will plenty of lower level saturation that would lend toward the idea of patchy sea fog development. The wild card will be the winds as they will be very borderline to being too strong for fog development.
- We are going to mention the risk of **patchy** fog possible starting in the overnight hours and being possible through mid-AM Thursday. Winds will be 10-15 MPH with gusts higher which makes things very borderline regarding when/if fog develops.
- Lower confidence on fog details as only a few MPH less/more than what model guidance has for winds can be the difference between fog development or not. *If* fog can develop, we do think it will be rather patchy. Locations S of Morgan's Point run this risk.


Forecast Discussion

Precip: Anticipating the main line of showers with the front to arrive in the 7AM – 10 AM timeframe and continue through late morning – noon. Lightning will be possible. Anticipating drier conditions for the PM hours behind the front.


Wind: Sustained winds look to be 10-15 MPH out of the SSE into Thu AM with gusts to 15-20 MPH at the boarding station. Winds veer out of the SW/WSW into the mid-late AM hours. After ~noon, sustained winds are 15-20 MPH out of the WNW with gusts 20-25 MPH. After sundown, winds look to pick up quickly again to 23-28 MPH sustained at the boarding station with gusts 30-40 MPH possible into the overnight from the N. Temps: High temps look to sit in the upper 60s to low 70s F on Wed (warmer inland, cooler closer to boarding station).




Precip: No precip expected Friday.

Wind: Winds will be out of the N on Friday. Through midday 18-23 MPH sustained with gusts to 30 MPH possible. Afternoon hours taper a bit to 10-15 MPH sustained at the boarding station with gusts 15-20 MPH possible.


Temps: Behind the front, highs look to top out in the mid 50s.


Visibility: No visibility concerns expected Friday.

Wind Speed 6 PM CT



























- Isolated to scattered chances for a few showers will be possible Today Wed out ahead of the front. Anticipating the main line of precip with the front Thu AM. Temps average out slightly above normal this week.
- The week 2 timeframe is expected to have near normal risks for temperatures and near normal to slightly above normal risks for precip.
- ➤ Right now, we are favoring near normal to slightly below normal temperatures and near normal to slightly above normal risks for precip for the weeks 3-4 timeframe.
