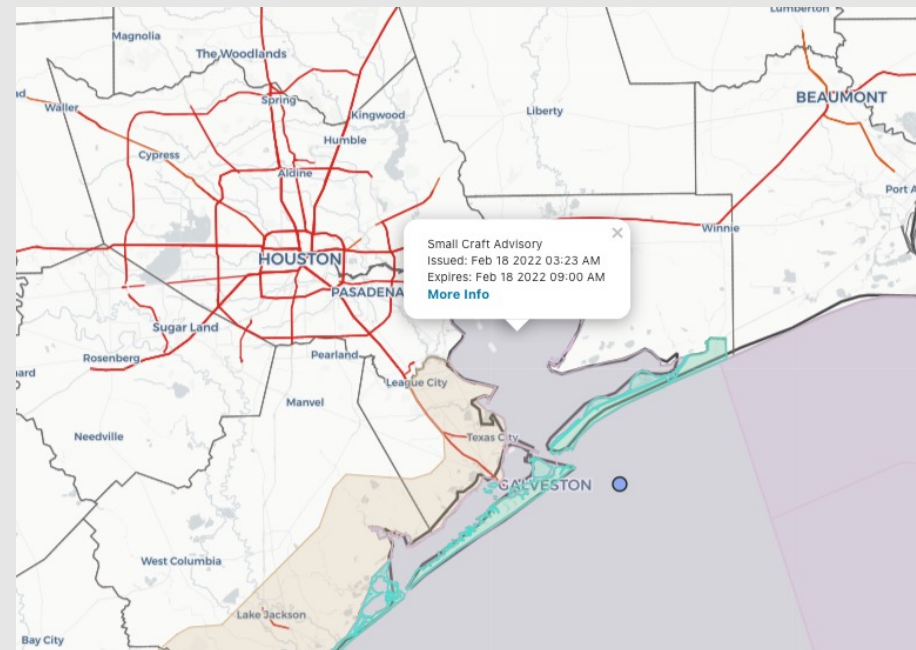

- Worth keeping an eye on early next week for another potential setup for fog development, more details to come over the weekend.

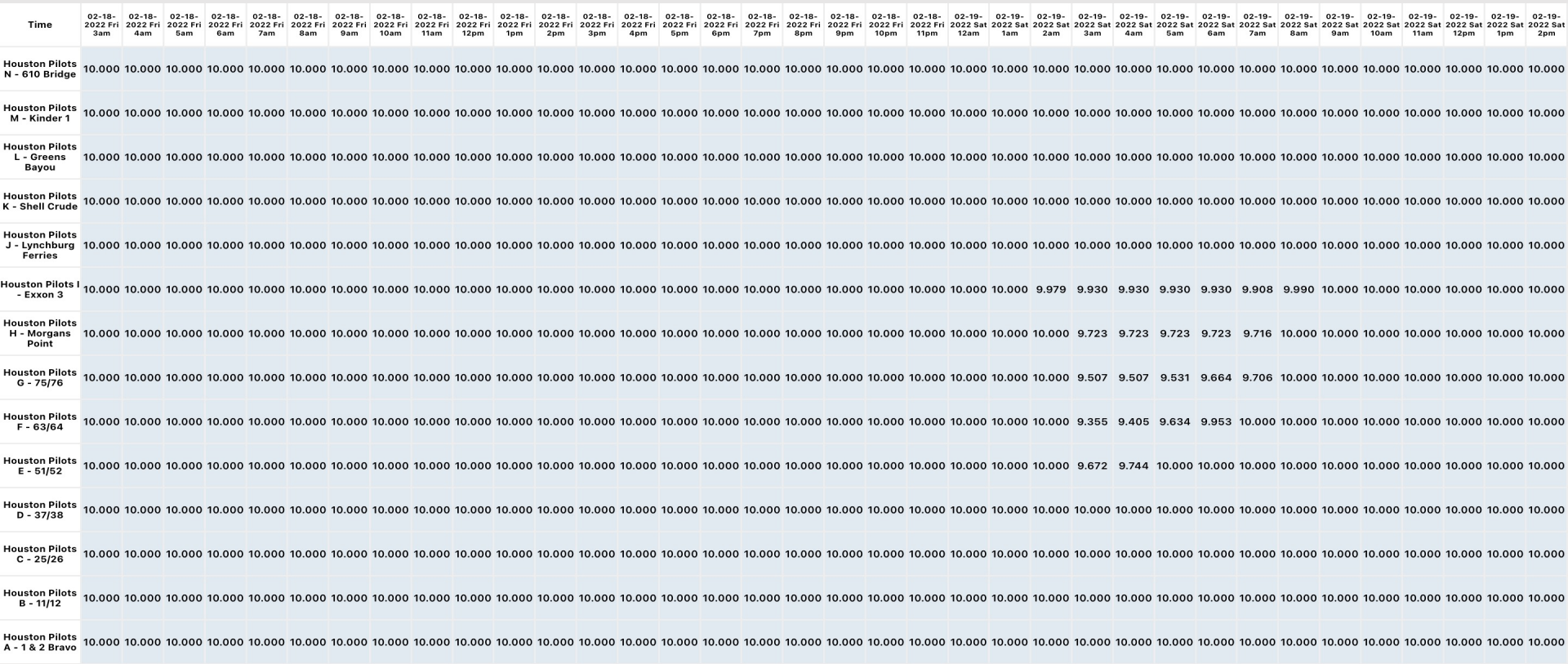

Forecast Discussion

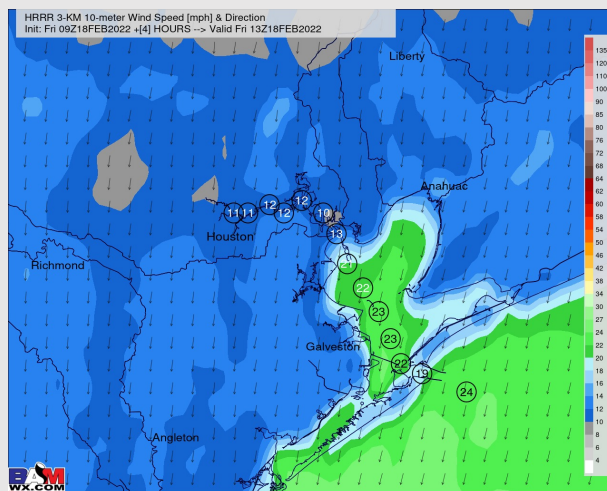
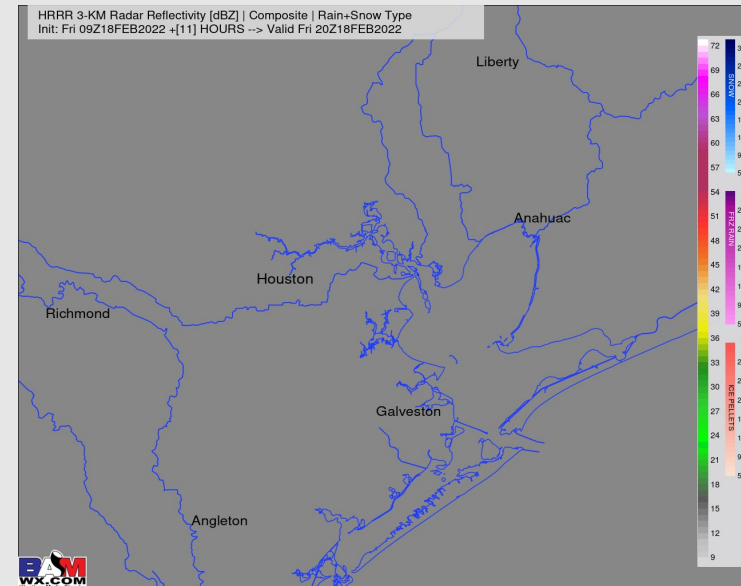
Precip: No precip expected today.

Wind: Winds will be out of the NNE today. Through mid-day 20-25 MPH sustained with gusts to 35 MPH possible. Afternoon hours taper a bit to 10-15 MPH sustained at the boarding station with gusts quickly diminishing to 15-20 MPH possible.

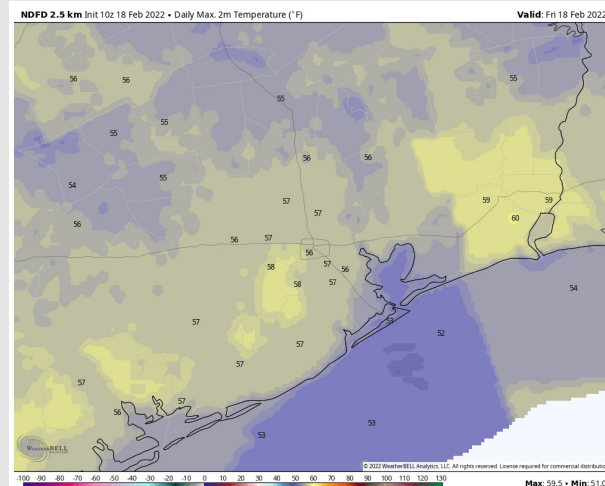
Temps: Behind the front, highs look to top out in the mid 50s.

Visibility: No visibility concerns expected today.

Forecast Discussion

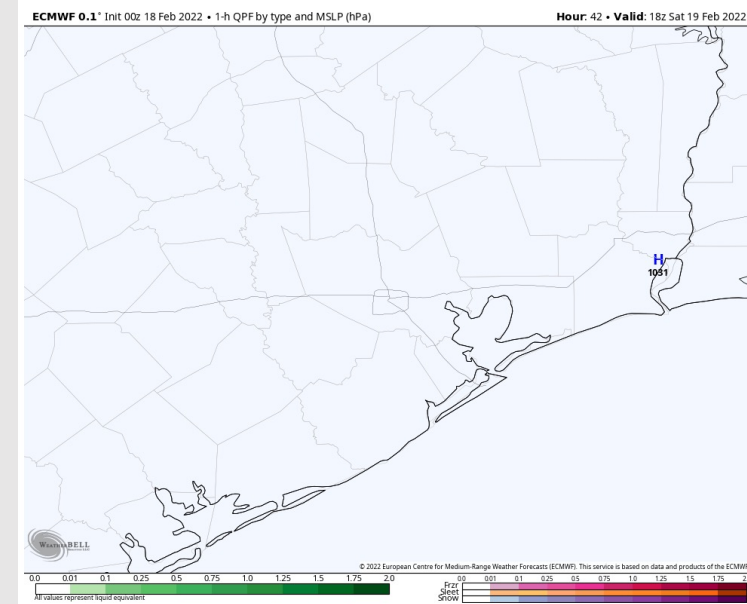
Precip: Saturday is favored to be a dry day at this distance.

Wind: Saturday likely starts out with a NE wind of 10-15 MPH with gusts to 20 MPH. Winds change more out of the E by mid day and then SE by sundown.

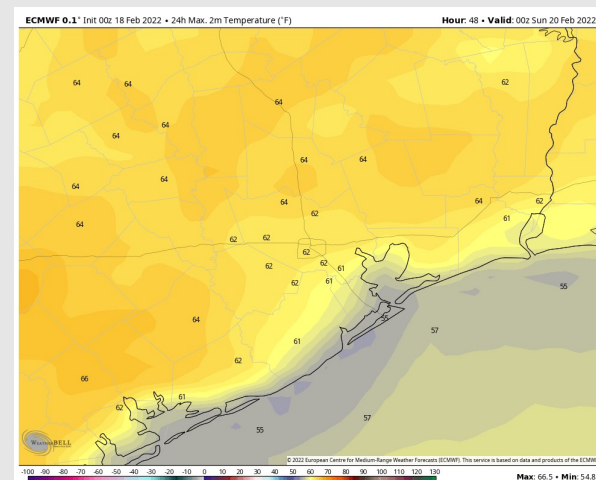
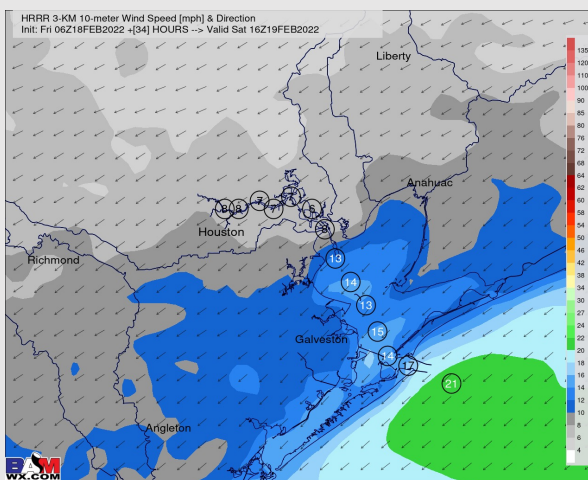
Temps: Saturday's temps look to top out near 60F.

Forecast Discussion

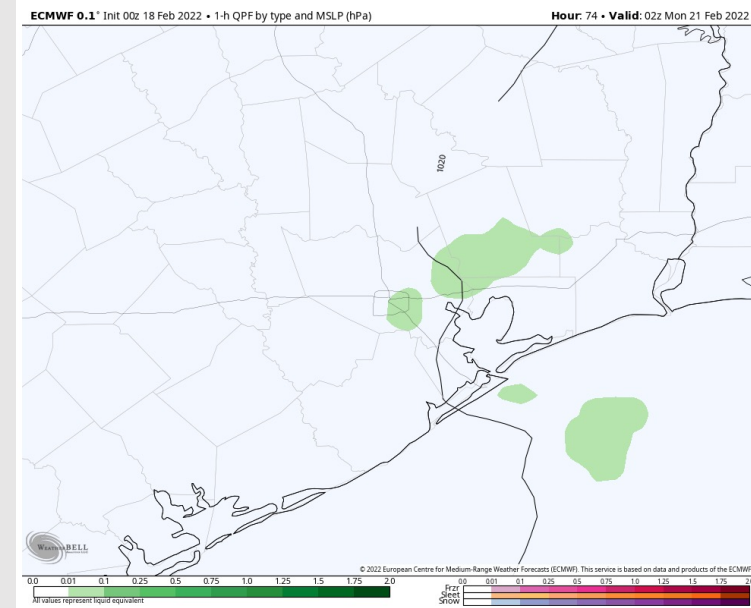
Precip: Overall, dry conditions are expected most of the day Sunday. ~10% chance of seeing a brief shower will be possible in the evening hours.

Wind: Sustained winds begin at 7-12MPH out of the SE and continue throughout the day. Winds pick up slightly in the evening hours to 10-15MPH through midnight, shifting out of the S at midnight.

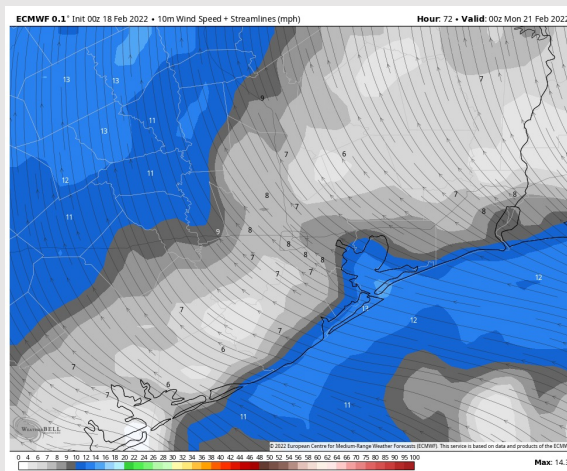
Temps: High temps Sunday look to be in the low 60s F.
