


**Precip:** Precipitation not expected Today.


Temps: Temps Tuesday look to remain consistent, similar to the past several days into the upper 80s F. With highs in the 90s F, closer to downtown.




Precip: Dry conditions anticipated for Wednesday.

Wind: Winds look to be 18-23 MPH sustained out of the south for most of the day on Wednesday with gusts to 25 MPH possible.


Temps: Highs on Wednesday reach the upper 80s F for the stations. With 90s F inland.


Visibility: Currently not anticipating reductions in visibility on Wednesday.


Precip: Dry conditions are favored to continue Thursday.

Wind: Winds look to be 18-23 MPH sustained out of the south throughout much of the day on Thursday. Winds look to veer out of the SSE after ~5 PM.


Temps: Highs once again reach the upper 80s F on Thursday. Low 90s F inland.






















- Overall dry conditions anticipated this week. Temps continue to average out above normal.
