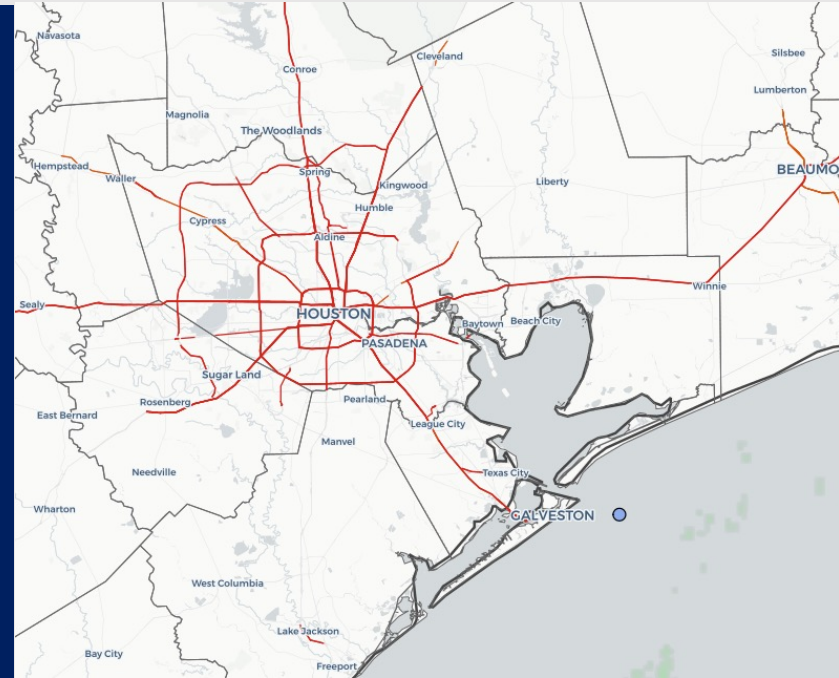

# Houston Pilots Extended Range Visibility Report



## Saturday, 5/21/22

A line of showers and thunderstorms are possible from 1 PM to 7 PM on Saturday. Winds can gust to 35 MPH when the line moves through. Visibility of less than 2 miles is possible in locally heavier rains.



## Sunday, 5/22/22

Spotty showers and thunderstorms are possible until ~ 4 PM. There is the potential for areas in reduced visibility in heavier rains.



## Monday 5/23/22

Spotty light to moderate rain is possible for Monday. Reduced visibility is not expected at this time.

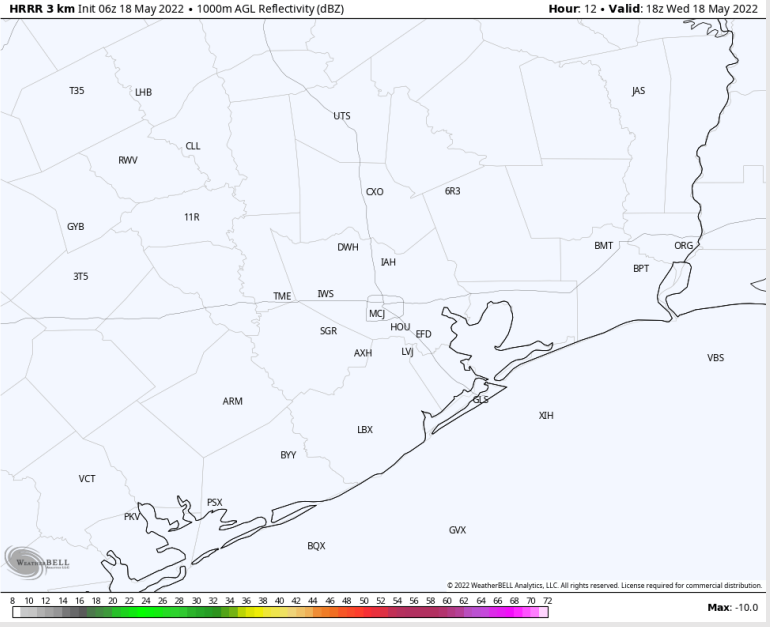
**Precip:** Dry conditions anticipated for today.

**Wind:** Winds look to be 15-20 MPH sustained out of the south for most of the day today with gusts to 25 MPH possible.

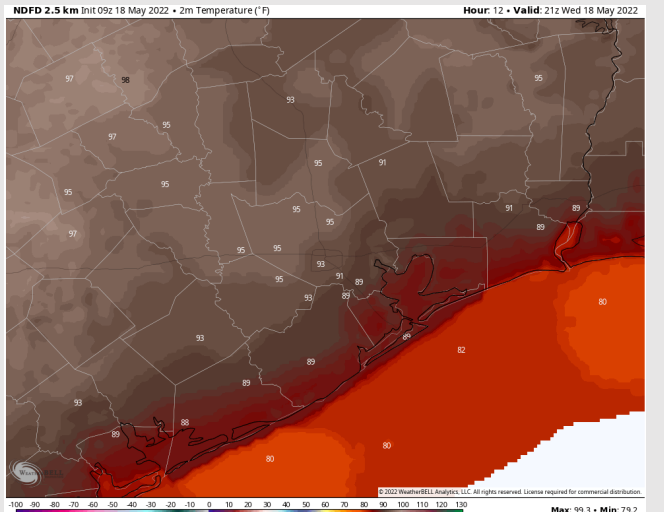
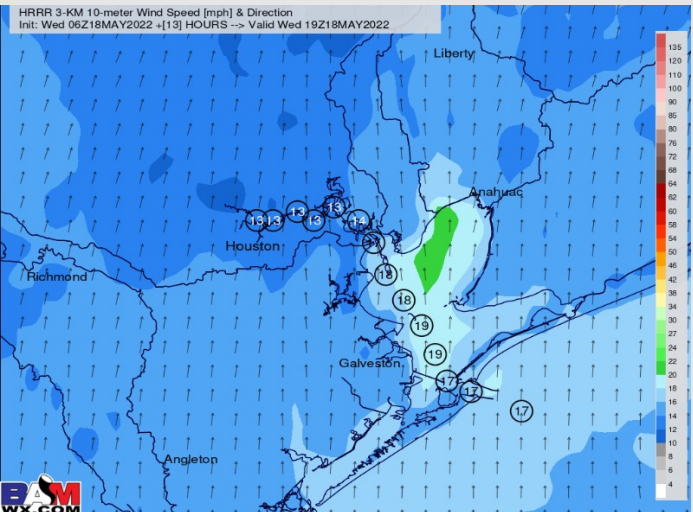
**Temps:** Highs today reach the upper 80s F to 90 F for the stations.

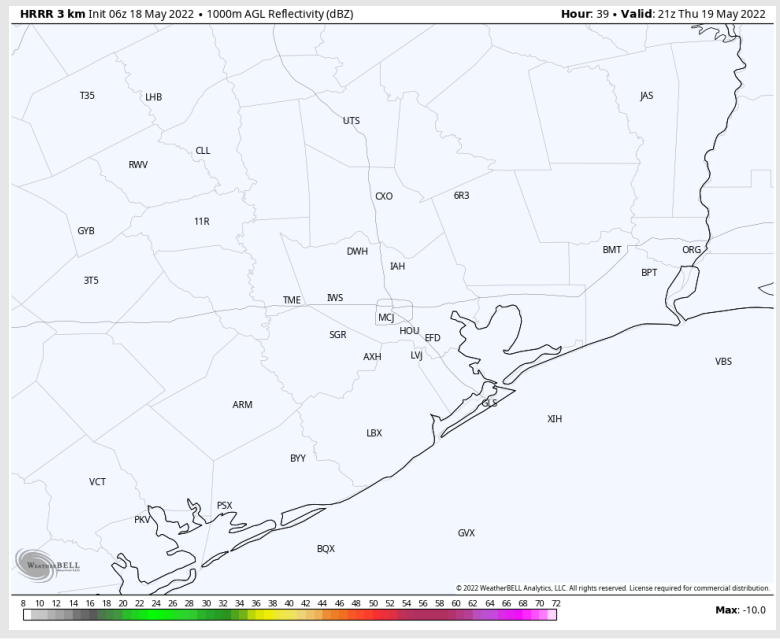

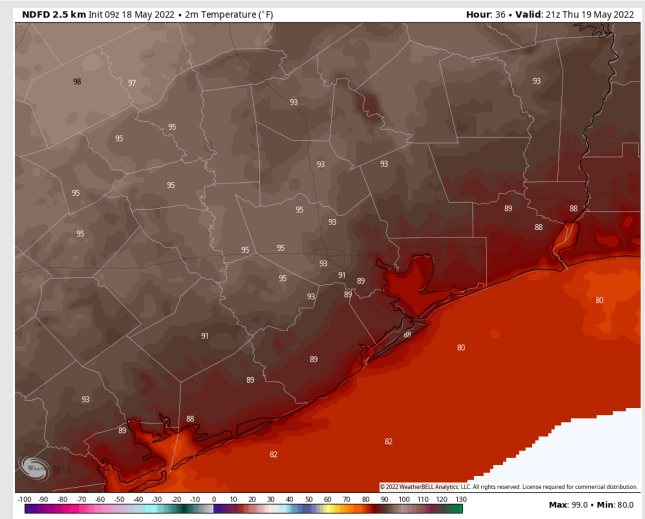
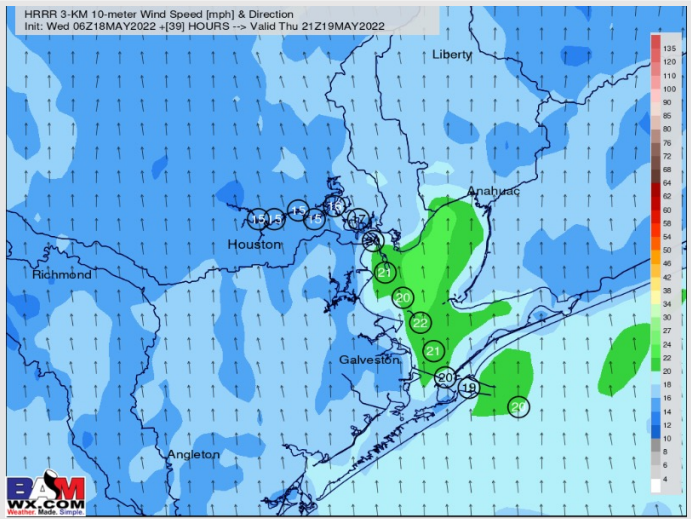
## Forecast Discussion

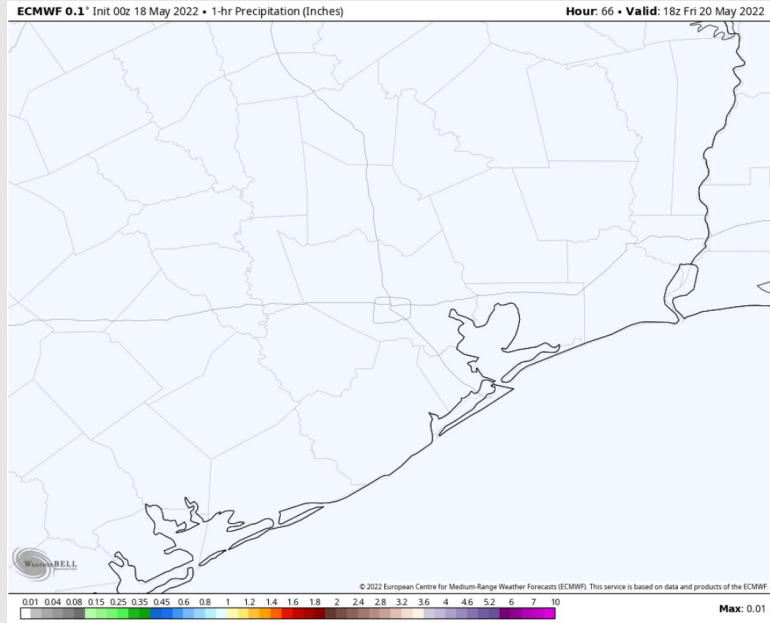

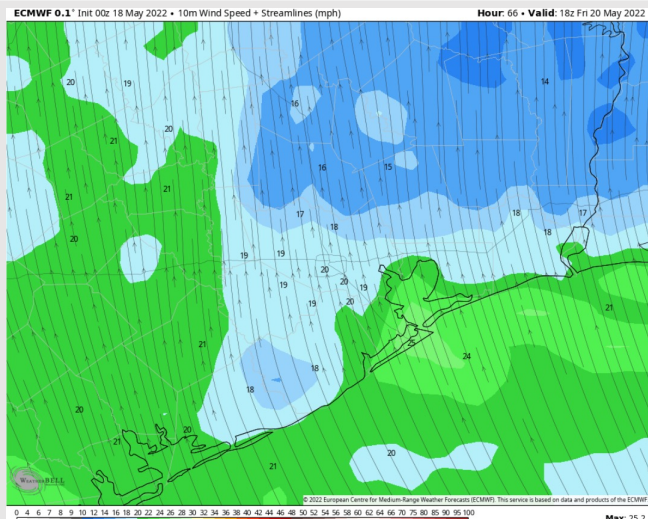
## Forecast Discussion

- Visibility:** No reduced visibility expected.

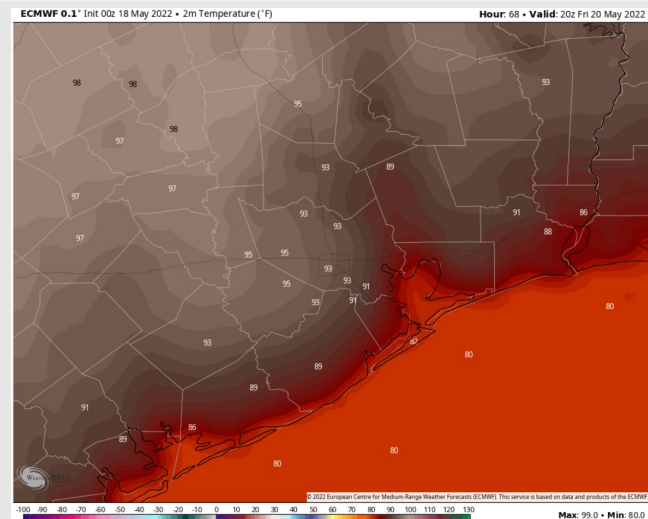
