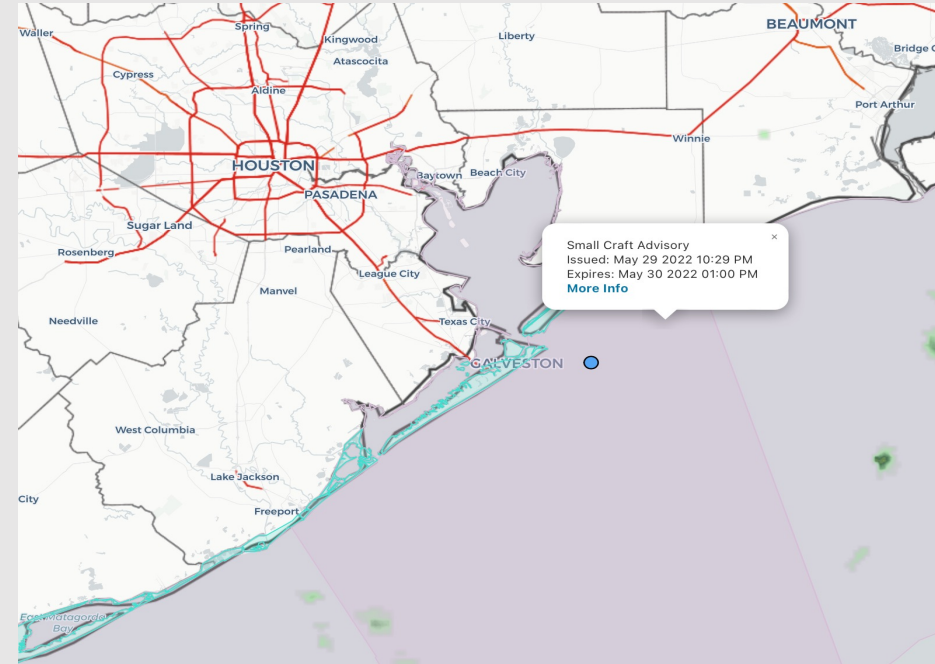

Forecast Discussion

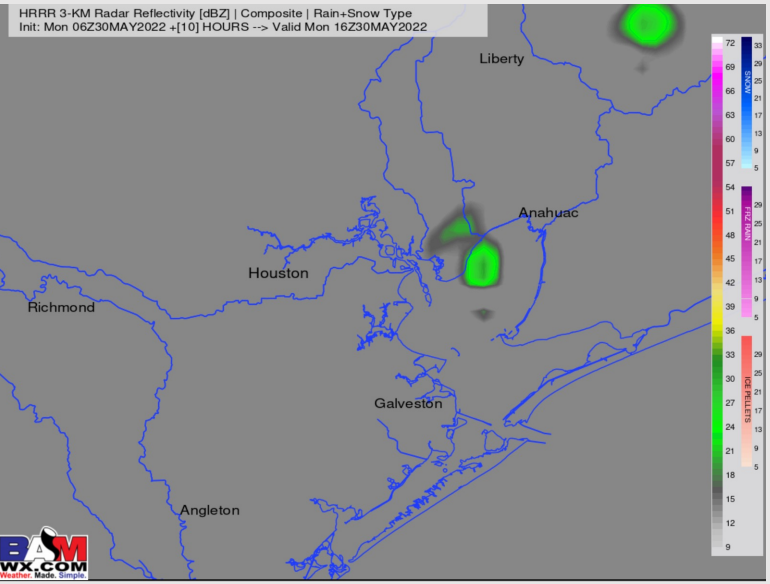
Precip: Outside of a 10% chance of a spotty shower until 1 PM, anticipating overall drier conditions for today.

Wind: Winds SSE 25-30 MPH with gusts to 35 MPH until 9 AM, then diminishing to 20-25 MPH after 9 AM from the SE.

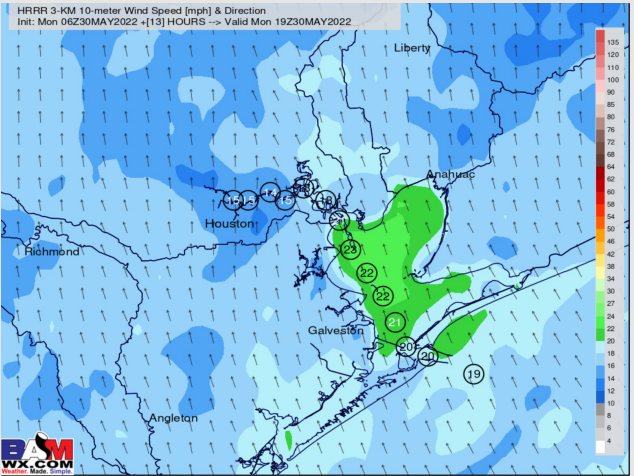
Temps: High temps on today will sit in the mid to upper 80s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating fog issues today.

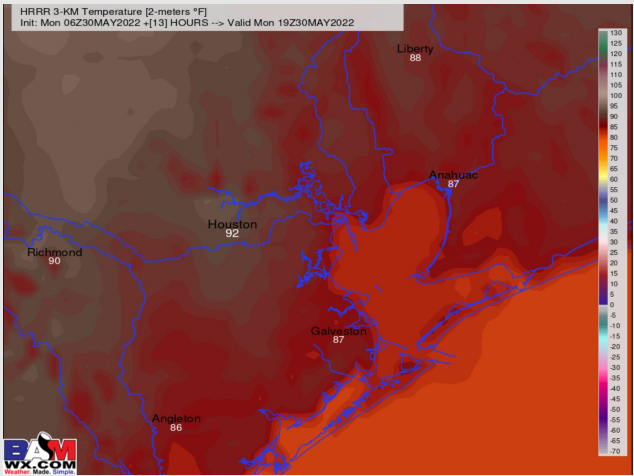

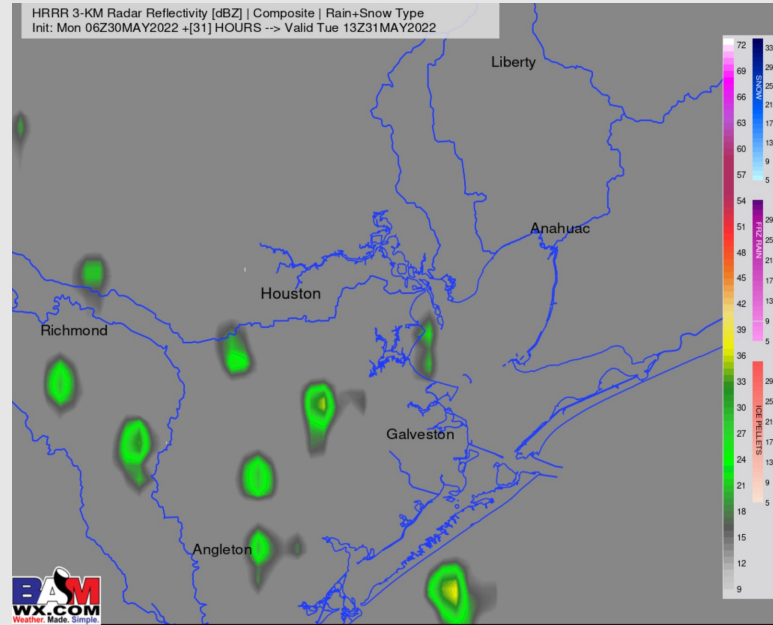

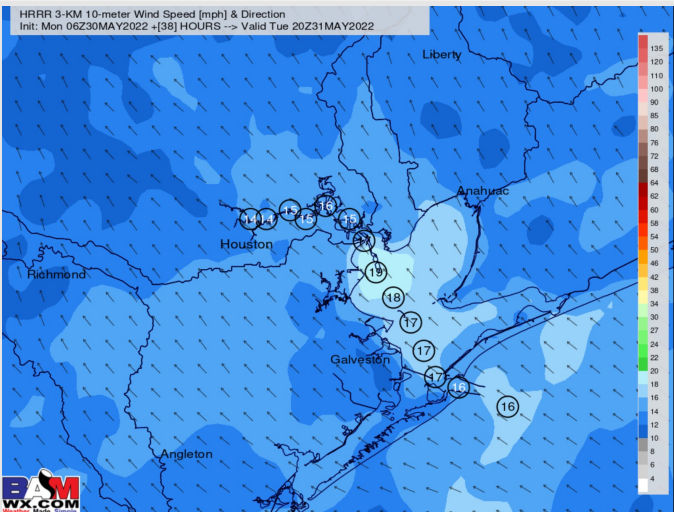
Forecast Discussion

- Precip:** Outside of a 10% chance of a very spotty light shower in the AM hours, anticipating dry conditions on Tuesday.
- Wind:** Winds look to be 18-23 MPH sustained out of the ESE until 9 AM. Then 15-20 MPH out of the SE with gusts to 25 MPH possible for the remainder of the day.
- Temps:** Highs look to once again reach the mid 80s F for the stations.
- Visibility:** Not anticipating fog on Tuesday.

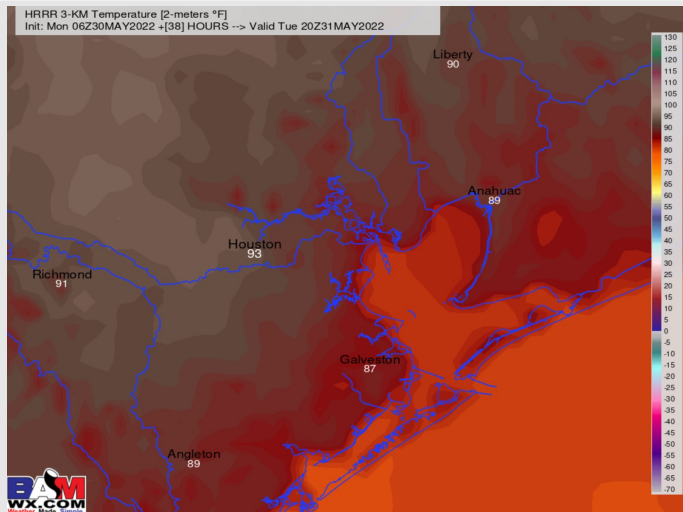
Precip Forecast: 8 AM CT

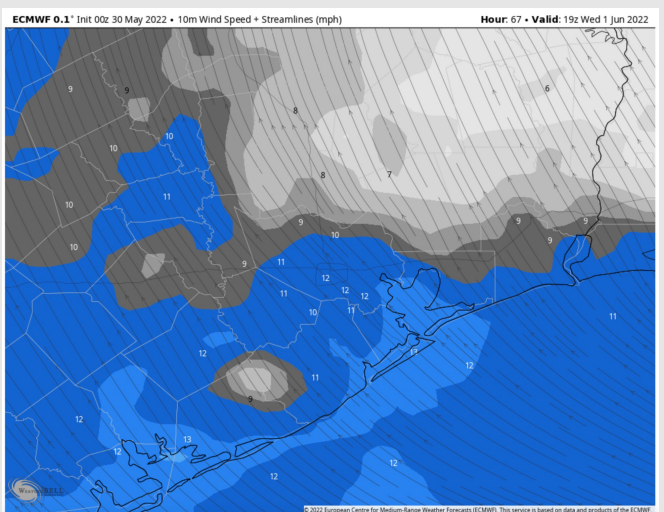
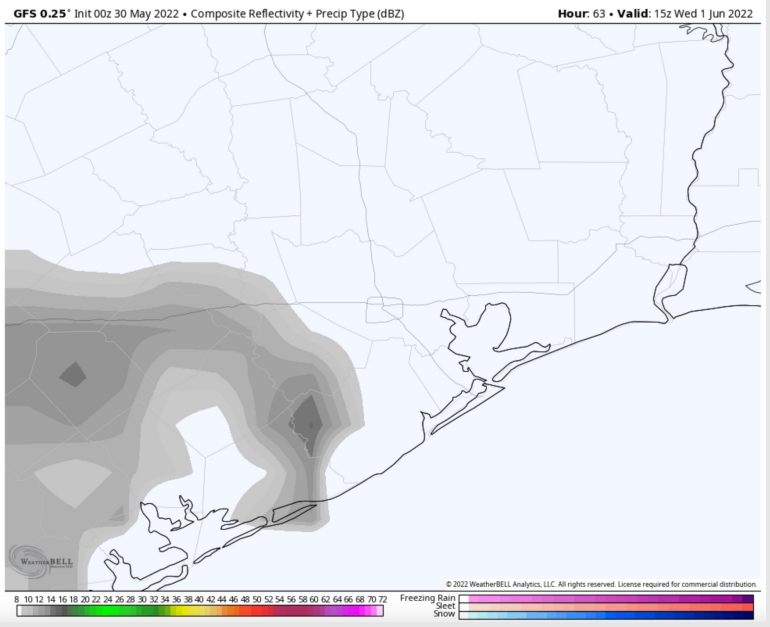
Precip: Cannot rule out a 10-20% chance of a light rain shower throughout the day Wednesday, still anticipating dry conditions.

Wind: Winds look to be 10-15 MPH sustained out of the SE throughout Wednesday. A few gusts to 20 MPH will be possible.

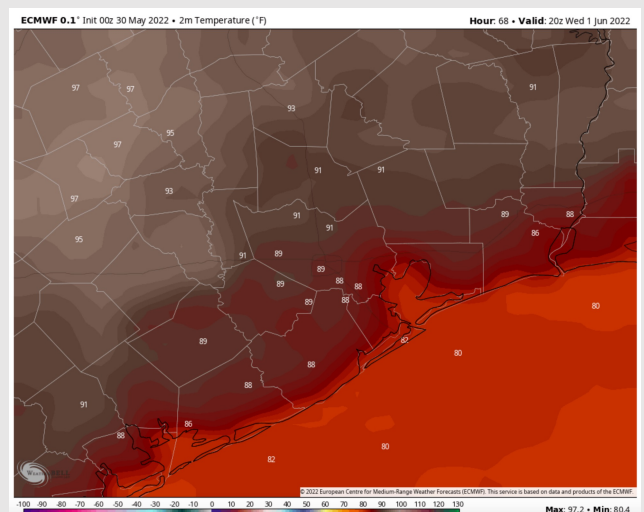
Temps: Highs on Wednesday will reach the mid to upper 80s F for the stations.

Houston Pilots: 5/30/22



- An overall warmer/ quieter week anticipated for the HOU area with only minor/ limited precipitation chances.
- Week 2 likely features above normal risks for temperatures, and below normal precipitation risks.
- The weeks ¾ timeframe looks to features above normal temperatures and slightly above normal risks for precip.
