

- Little to no precipitation over the next week.
- Above average temperatures likely to continue the next several days.
- A southerly wind (varying at times to SE & SW) will continue.
- Disturbance to monitor potentially working near the Yucatan around this time next weekend, however way too many unknowns. More on slide below.






Tropical Model Tracks the Next 10 Days

No "high confidence" tropical threats noted over the next 10 days as model data (see above) keeps SE Texas rather quiet in this timeframe. However, we do want to mention a potential system near the day 10 period which will need to be monitored. At this distance, there are more questions vs answers. However, it is worth watching the Yucatan around ~June 19th which is around the time when any potential system would work in to that area.





Forecast Discussion

- Precip:** Continuing to favor dry conditions to close the weekend.
- Wind:** Southwest winds of 15-20MPH will continue most of the day, becoming southerly by 3PM. Gusts throughout the day to 20 - 25MPH will be possible. Weaker winds will be possible into the Buffalo Bayou.
- Temps:** Record heat expected tomorrow with high temps into the low to mid 90's F over open waters and around 100 F towards the HOU metro. "Feels-like" temperatures approaching 110 F will be possible.
- Visibility:** Not anticipating any fog concerns.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Dry conditions are favored to continue Monday.

Wind: Winds look to be 15-20 MPH sustained into the pre-dawn hours of Monday with gusts to 25 MPH possible. After 9 – 10 AM winds are 13-18 MPH sustained for the rest of the day with gusts to 23 MPH. Winds remain out of the SSW/S for Monday.


Temps: Highs once again reach the upper 80s to low 90s F for the stations and upper 90's F towards HOU metro. "Feels like" temperatures into the mid to even upper 100's F will be possible.

Visibility: No fog is expected for Monday.


Precip Forecast: 1 PM CT





Forecast Discussion

- Precip:** No precip anticipated for Tuesday.
- Wind:** Sustained winds look to be 13-18 MPH with gusts to 18 - 23 MPH for most of the day on Tuesday. Winds will be out of the SSW/S for most of the day.
- Temps:** Highs on Tuesday once again reach the upper 80s to low 90s F for most stations.
- Visibility:** Not anticipating fog.

Precip Forecast: 12 PM CT









Wind Speed:

- The weeks ¾ timeframe looks to feature much above normal temperatures and much below normal risks for precip.
