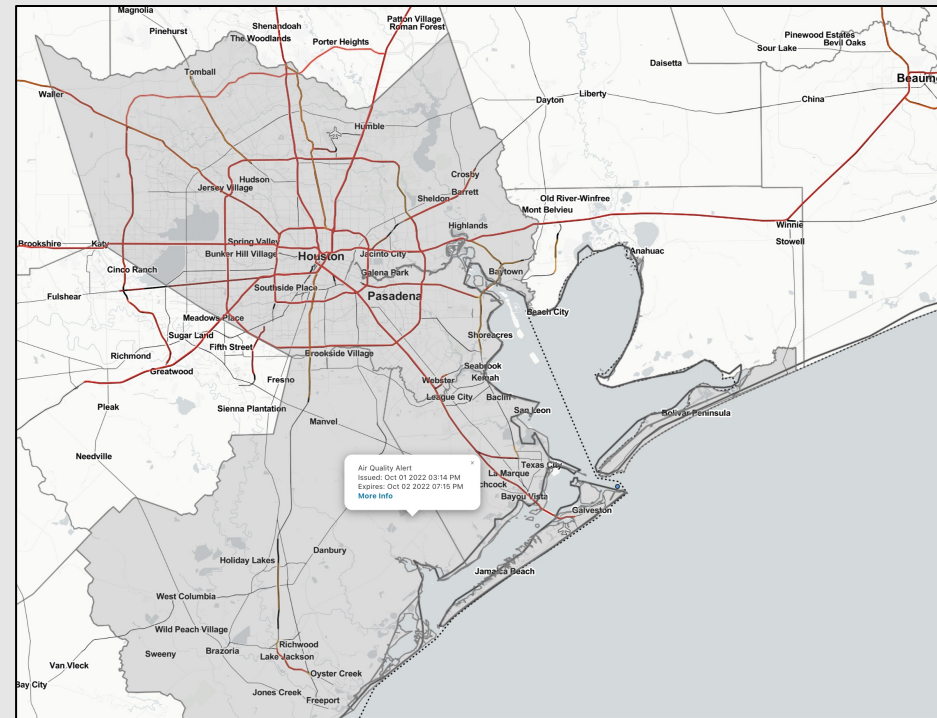

- No concerns for reduced visibility at this time.

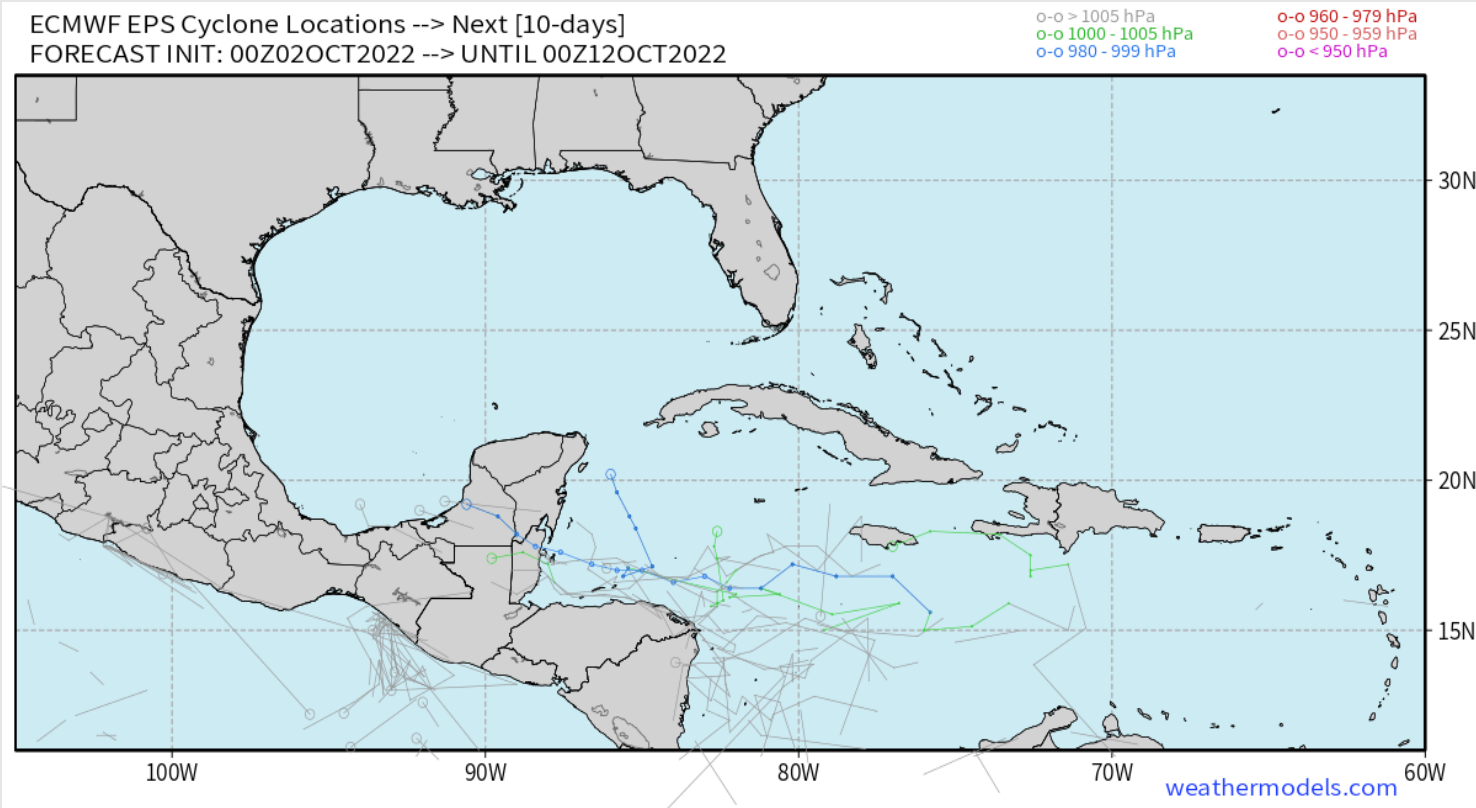

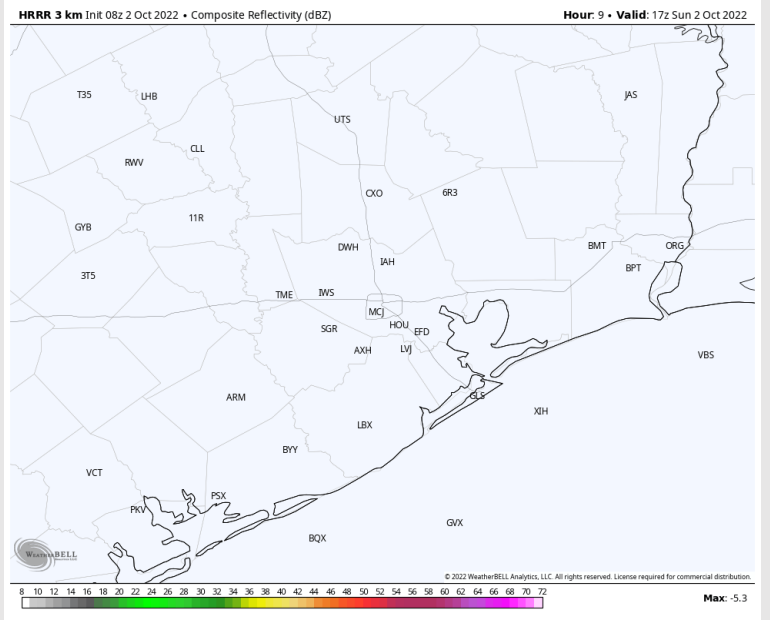


Forecast Discussion

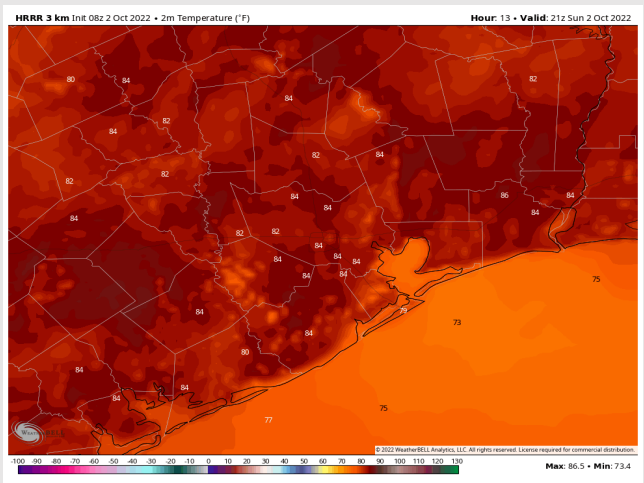
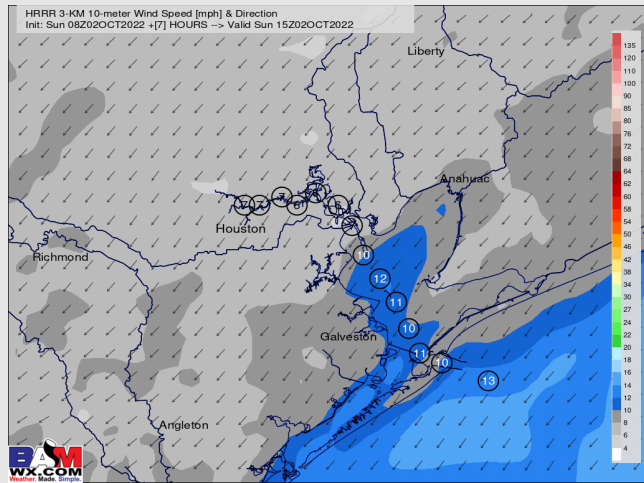
- Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions all day today.
- Wind:** Sustained winds this AM out of the NE at 10-15 MPH until 11 AM. Winds then become more variable at 3-8 MPH, maintaining speed through the evening and veering SE.
- Temps:** High temps today in the low 80s F near the boarding station and in the mid to upper 80s F at all other stations.

Visibility: Not anticipating fog concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion

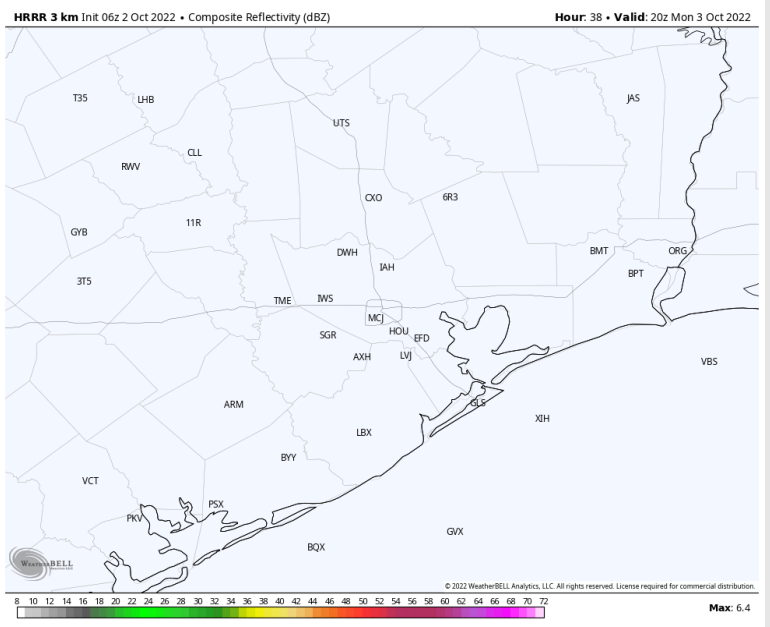
Precip: Anticipating dry conditions throughout the day Monday.

Wind: Expecting winds out of the NE at 5-10 MPH just after midnight Monday AM through 12PM. Winds then veer more out of the South at 3-8 MPH and continues the rest of the night.

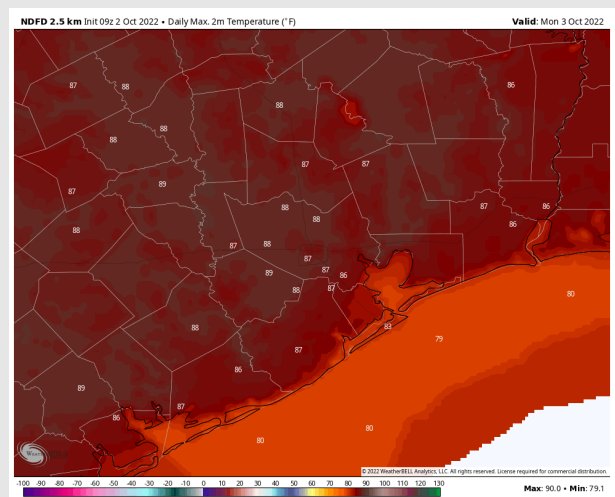
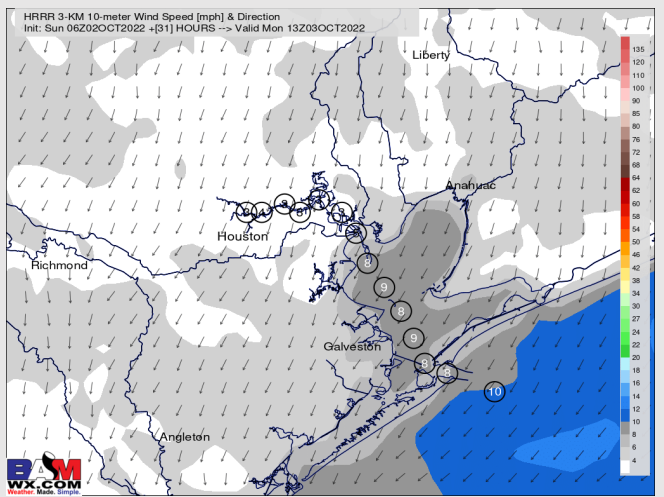
Temps: High temps near 80 F at the boarding station and in the mid to upper 80s F at all other stations.

Forecast Discussion

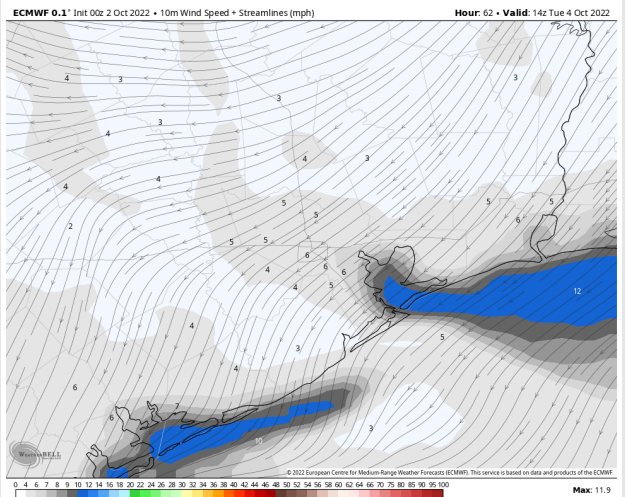
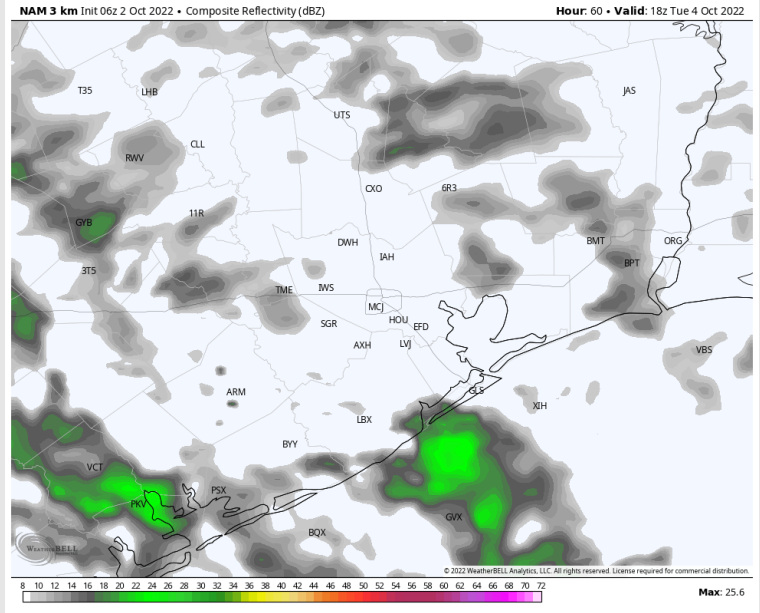
Precip: Anticipating 10% chances of an isolated shower between 3AM-12PM, with chances increasing to 30% from 12PM-9PM. Periods of light rain will be possible, with no T-Storms anticipated.

Wind: Sustained winds Tuesday morning will be out of the ENE at 5-10 MPH until 12 PM. Winds then will veer out of the SE at 3-8 MPH for the remainder of the day, with gusts of 15 MPH between 2-6 PM.

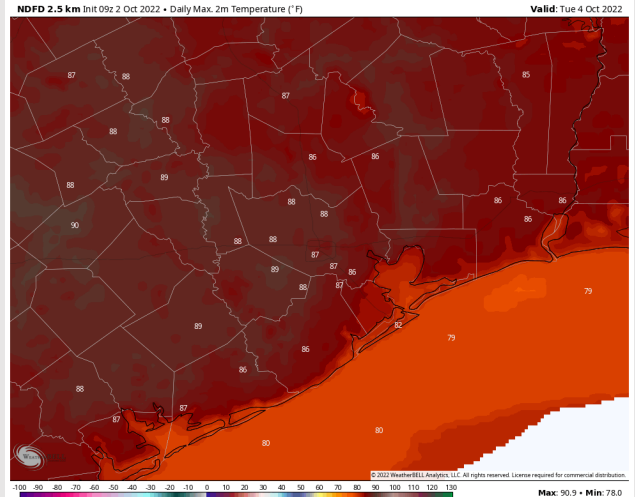
Temps: High temps Tuesday near 80 F at the boarding station and in the upper 80s F at all other stations.

Precip Forecast: 1 PM CT

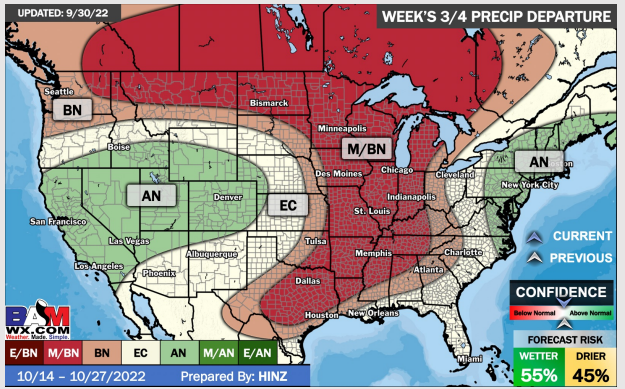
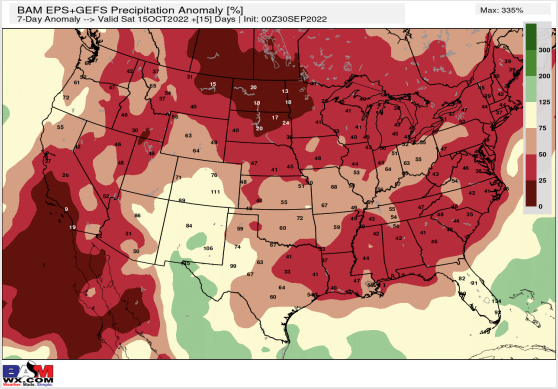
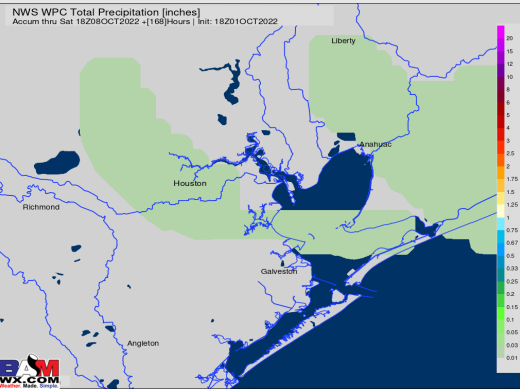
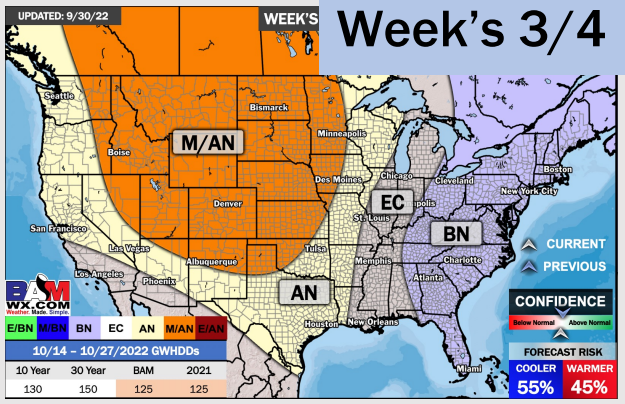
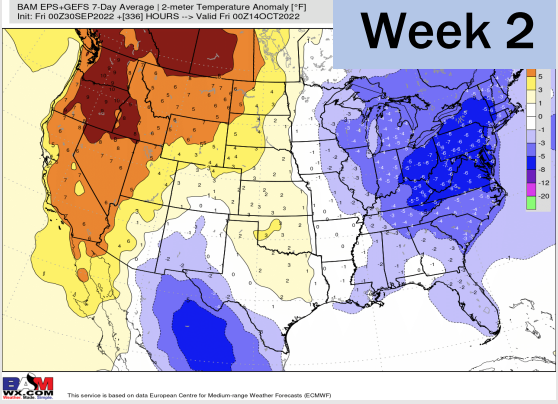
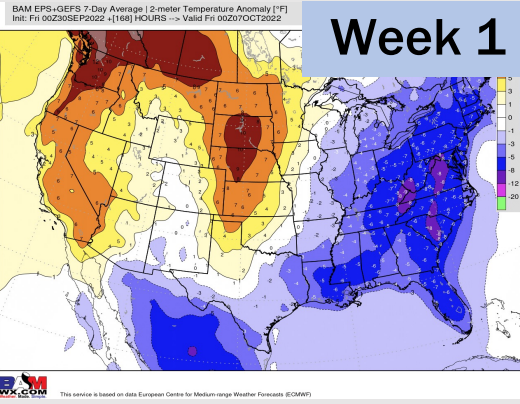


Wind Speed

Houston Pilots: 10/2/22



- Temperatures expected to be below normal for the next week. Expecting the next several days to be drier with a couple isolated chances later into the week.
- Week 2 likely features near normal temperatures and below normal precipitation.
- The weeks ¾ timeframe into mid October looks to feature slightly above normal temperatures and below normal risks for precip.
