



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions this afternoon and overnight.

Wind: Variable winds at 3 PM will favor a SE direction by 5 PM with speeds of 3 – 7 kts. By 4 AM winds will shift E and pick up slightly at the Boarding Station to 7 – 11 kts.


Temps: Low temps Tues AM will be in the Lower 60s F west of Shell Crude Station, and mid to upper 60s F for all other stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Anticipating widespread showers/t-storms to begin around 6 AM Tuesday, transitioning to spotty showers around 7 PM. Scattered showers will remain in the area from 7PM – 11 PM. Dry conditions favored beyond 12 AM. Locally heavy downpours and sporadic lightning possible under strongest cells.

Wind: Sustained winds early Tuesday morning out of the NE at 3-8 kts. By 12 PM, winds shift from the ENE and remain as such for the rest of the day. In the afternoon, winds S of Morgan's Point expected to be 11 – 16 kts while stations N can expect winds of 7 - 12 kts. By 8 PM winds N of Morgan's point subside to 3 – 8 kts but remain elevated at the Boarding Station. Gusts of 16- 20 kts possible throughout the evening.





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring mostly dry conditions Wednesday.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the NE Wednesday at 10-15 kts for stations S of Morgan's Point and 5-10 knots for stations N of Morgan's Point. By 12 PM, winds will then begin to shift out of the SE for all stations.


Temps: High temps Wednesday in the low 70s F at the boarding station and in the mid 70s F at all other stations.


Visibility: Not favoring any concerns for reduced visibility.

Wind Speed 7 PM CT
























- > Temperatures expected to be slightly above normal next week. More widespread chances of rain going into Tuesday, Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday.
