





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions throughout today.

Wind: Sustained SE winds for the entire day. Winds north of Morgan's Point will be 3 – 7 kts, while south of Morgan's Point will be elevated at 7 – 12 kts until 12 PM. After 12 PM, winds at all stations expected to be 6 – 11 kts for the rest of the day.


Temps: High temps today will be in the mid to upper 70s F for locations near the Boarding Station and low 80s F for all other stations.


Visibility: Fog is expected to stay N/NW of HOU Metro area and not pose a visibility threat this morning. Fog N/NW of stations expected to lift by 10 AM.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions for the AM hours. Around 12 PM showers will begin to move into the area and become more widespread by 3-4 PM. Chances of storms/showers around 60% throughout the afternoon and evening.

Wind: Variable winds with a southerly orientation favored throughout the day at 1 – 6 kts across all stations. By 6 PM winds shift from the NW and increase to 12 – 17 kts for stations north of Morgan's Point and 17-22 kts south of Morgan's Point. Wind gusts of 30+ kts possible for all stations after sundown.


Temps: High temperatures will be in the mid to upper 70s/near 80 F across all stations on Friday.


Visibility: Patchy/dense fog between 2-9AM for stations N of Morgan's Point. Reduced visibility of 0.5-1 Mile will be a risk throughout this duration.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating shower chances to continue through 3 AM on Saturday morning. After 3 AM, expecting dry conditions the rest of the day.

Wind: Winds generally out of the NNW throughout majority of the day. Sustained winds for stations north of Morgan's Point at 10-15 kts and stations south of Morgan's Point at 17-23 kts. Around 8 PM, winds will veer from the NE. Winds gusts of 30+ kts possible all day Saturday.


Temps: High temperatures Saturday in the low/mid 60s F for all stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating visibility concerns at this moment.

Wind Speed 2 PM CT
























- Temperatures expected to be below normal this week. Better chances for precipitation arrive Friday afternoon into Saturday morning.
