





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions until 5PM. After 5PM, expecting scattered showers to work into the area at 60-70% and continue for the rest of the evening.

Wind: Sustained winds from the E/NE all day today. Winds starting at 1-5 kts for stations N of Morgan's Point and 10 – 15 kts for stations S of Morgan's Point gradually increase through the AM. By 8 AM, winds N of Morgan's Point at 8-13 kts and 15-20 kts for stations S of Morgan's Point. These winds sustain for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of up to 25 kts are possible around 8 AM around the boarding station.


Temps: High temperatures near 60 F at the boarding station and in the upper 50s for all other stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating widespread showers/storms to continue throughout the day on Saturday. By 5 PM, chances decrease to 40% as showers/storms become more scattered continuing into the overnight.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the N/NE for the entire day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be at 9 - 14 kts for the entire day. Winds S of Morgan's Point will be at 15-20 kts until 9 AM, when they increase to 18-23 kts for the rest of the day. Around 12 PM, winds near the boarding station increase to 22-27 kts. Gusts of 30-40 kts will be possible throughout the afternoon.


Temps: High temperatures will be in the mid 50s near the boarding station and near 50 F at all other stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions throughout the day Sunday.

Wind: Sustained winds from the E/NE throughout the day Sunday. Sustained winds at 8-10 kts N of Morgan's Point and 12-20 kts S of Morgan's Point Sunday AM. By 1 PM winds N of Morgan's Point will die down to 5-7 kts, wile winds S of Morgan's Point will decrease to 8-15 kts for the rest of the day.


Temps: High temperatures will be in the mid 50s F across all stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Wind Speed 8 AM CT









