

Weather Headlines

- Expecting scattered showers/storms over the next few days, with conditions drying out by Tuesday afternoon.
- Favoring winds primarily out of the NE for the next few days and will stay elevated with sustained winds of 15 20+ kts possible at the boarding station, primarily on Monday.
- Elevated winds + unfavorable wind direction will limit fog threat moving forward.
- Not anticipating any tropical activity concerns over the next 10 days.







Forecast Discussion


Precip: Dry conditions expected through 4 PM today. Around 4 PM, scattered showers/storms will move into the area at 30/40% and continue through the rest of the day.

Wind: Sustained winds from the E/NE throughout the day today. Sustained winds at 8-12 kts N of Morgan's Point and 16-22 kts S of Morgan's Point Sunday AM. By 1 PM winds N of Morgan's Point will die down to 4-7 kts, wile winds S of Morgan's Point will decrease to 11-16 kts for the rest of the day.


Temps: High temperatures will be in the upper 50s F near the boarding station and in the low 50s F for all other stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A 30% chance of scattered showers in the morning from 12 AM – 6 AM. Anticipating rain to become more widespread by 6 AM with showers/thunderstorms lasting until 2 PM. From 2 PM to throughout the rest of the day, shower/storm chances become more isolated with 20% chances.

Wind: Sustained winds from the NE for the entire day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 5 – 10 kts. Winds S of Morgan's Point to expected to see winds of 15 – 20 kts through 2 PM. After 2 P, winds S of Morgan's Point expected to calm a bit to 12-18 kts. Wind gusts of 20 – 22 kts will be possible all day S of Morgan's Point.


Temps: High temps will be in the mid 50s F near the boarding station and in the near 50 F for all other stations.


Visibility: Visibilities could briefly reduce to less than 3 miles under some of the moderate rain showers in the afternoon, mainly from 10 AM – 1 PM N of Morgan's Point.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A slight chance for scattered showers, (20%) from 1 AM – 10AM. Beyond 10 AM, anticipating dry conditions throughout the rest of the day on Tuesday.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the NE for the entire day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 3 – 8 kts and winds S of Morgan's Point will be 10 – 15 kts. Boarding Station will be slightly elevated at 12 – 17 kts.


Temps: High temperatures will be low 60s F across all stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Wind Speed 6 AM CT









