Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions the rest of today with rain chances staying NW/W of stations.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the ESE for the rest of the day. Winds N of Morgan's point between 4 – 9 kts with winds S of Morgan's Point between 8 – 13 kts. After 7/8 PM, winds in the Gulf will pick up to 15 kts.


Temps: Low temps Thursday morning in the upper 60s F near the boarding station and in the low 60s F for all other stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating a rainy day. Isolated chances for showers/storms will begin around 5 AM. Scattered showers/thunderstorm coverage will increase for the region around 10 AM and become fairly widespread until 8 PM (~80%). From 8 PM through the rest of the night, rain chances will drop to ~40%. A few locally stronger thunderstorms cannot be ruled out on the day Thursday.

Wind: Favoring winds out of the ESE for the morning and early afternoon. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be at 3 – 8 kts and S of Morgan's Point will be 9 – 14 kts. After 12 PM winds will subside to 2 – 7 kts with variable directions for most stations with the boarding station seeing between 21 – 26 kts after 12 PM where they continue the rest of the night.


Temps: Warming trend continues. High temps will be in the upper 60s F to lower 70s F across all stations.


Visibility: Visibilities could briefly reduce to less than 3 miles under moderate rain bands.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A slight chance (30%) for exiting showers and storms in the early morning from 12 AM – 2 AM. Then anticipating a dry slot from 2 AM – 9 AM. By 11 AM / 12 PM, more widespread showers and storms will enter the region (70 % chance) and last through the rest of the night.

Wind: Clam and variable winds in the early morning will gradually increase to 8 – 13 kts across all stations by 5 AM. Winds will then increase even more from 12 PM – 3PM to 12 – 17 kts N of Morgan's Point, and 17 – 23 kts S of Morgan's Point and remain elevated from 3 PM – 12 AM. Wind gusts could be as high as 27 - 30 kts at the Boarding Station and 11/12 from 3 – 7 PM.


Temps: High temps Friday will be in the mid 60s F across all stations.


Visibility: Reduction in visibility to less than 3 miles will be possible for brief periods (30 minutes) under heavier rain cells

Wind Speed 5 PM CT



























- > Temperatures expected to be above normal this week. A quieter mid-week is followed by rain chances Thursday/ Friday.
