

### **Weather Headlines**

- Rainfall chances continue this morning before a calmer Saturday PM – Monday. Next shot of rain comes into the area Tuesday.
- Winds will continue to remain elevated over the next few days with winds \*generally\* sitting 15-20 knots at the boarding station (more info on slides below).
- Extended reduced visibility forecast slide is now in place of the extended tropical forecast.
- Eyeing potential fog/reduced visibility from rain/low clouds on Tuesday.
- The tropical storm threat is all but nonexistent moving forward.

### **Houston Pilots Extended Range Visibility Report**





#### Monday 11/28/22



#### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Widespread showers/and heavier storms (90% chance) will continue through 8 AM. Chances will begin to decrease after 8 AM to 70% as showers/ storms become more scattered throughout the area. Anticipating dry conditions by 12 PM that will continue for the rest of the day. Currently targeting the 6 - 8 AM window for the best threat of seeing a few stronger storms capable of producing lightning, heavy rain, and gusty winds.

Wind: Sustained winds this morning out of the ENE at 13-18 kts at the boarding station (gusts 18-23 kts possible). Winds then shift out of the E in the 7 - 8 AM timeframe when the best strong storm risk is. Winds will then stay out of the W/WSW at 15-20 kts with gusts reaching 20-25 knots. Under the heaviest cells in the morning, a few gusts of 29 - 32 kts will be possible. Winds N of Morgan's Point 3 - 7 kts after 6 PM.


Temps: High temperatures on Saturday in the high 60s F to low 70s F.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns the rest of the day.

### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions Sunday.

Wind: Sustained winds generally out of the W throughout the day. Winds S of Morgan's Point 13 -19 kts early in the AM with winds N of Morgan's Point 5 – 10 kts. After 10 AM, all winds 8 – 14 kts.


**Temps:** Highs temps Sunday near 70 F across all stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating fog at this time.

### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions Monday.

Wind: Variable winds all day Monday. Winds N of Morgan's Point 3 – 8 kts. Winds S of Morgan's Point 8 – 13 kts. Although winds are variable, winds will generally be out of the ESE/SE Monday evening into Tues.


**Temps:** High Temps Monday near 70 F for all stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns Monday AM.

Wind Speed 9 PM CT





















- Rain chances through tomorrow AM where heavy rain will be possible. A break Saturday PM –
