

Weather Headlines

- Anticipating scattered showers and storms in a hit-ormiss fashion today. Favoring dry conditions for Wednesday and Thursday.
- Eyeing rather gusty winds after a cold front passes the area Wednesday AM. Gusts of 25-30+ knots will be possible at the boarding station Wednesday.
- Potential for fog in the evening in spots to linger into Wednesday AM. More details on the slides below. Anticipating improvements in visibility Wednesday post-daybreak and Thursday.
- Eyeing additional fog threats toward the end of the week/weekend.






- Still eyeing the ~5-7 PM timeframe Tuesday where the potential for more dense / widespread fog would start to increase again.
- Within the overall Tuesday PM to Wednesday AM window, the highest overall risk for the most widespread and most dense fog comes between 2 AM and 6 AM Wednesday before the front passes.
- Currently targeting the ~6 AM timeframe Wednesday as a cold front will sweep through the area and turn the winds out of the N and eliminate the fog threat.
- > This threat for fog and less than 1 mile visibility exists for all stations.

Pending how quickly some of the winds can turn out of the SE, Friday AM could be the start of a multi-day stretch where fog will be possible. Best risk of now would be Friday evening into Saturday AM, but more details need ironed out on specifics.

Continued SE flow with scattered showers filling in during the late morning hours hint at a favorable fog setup. Towards the evening hours, spotty shower chances clear the region, but plentiful low-level moisture and SE flow will allow for fog potential. Winds of around 10 kts support sea breeze transport fog potential as well.

Saturday 12/3/22

Favorable wind pattern for fog with winds from the SE to SSE on Saturday. While the AM hours initially look a little dry, spotty showers will work their way towards the region with relatively calm winds (3 – 7 kts) in the afternoon. Air will become much more saturated at the low levels with the onset of spotty showers.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered, hit and miss showers will continue to work through the area at ~60% chance given the spotty nature. Chances will continue through 5 PM, where shower/storm chances decrease to 30% until 10 PM. Favoring only a few pockets of drizzle/ very light rain heading into the overnight.

Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SSW most of the day. Sustained winds of 10-15 kts across all stations (a few gusts 15-20 kts will be possible). Around 8 PM winds will begin to calm to 4 – 7 kts N of Morgan's Point and 9 – 11 kts S of Morgan's Point.


Temps: Low temps will be upper 50s F N of Morgan's Point and near 60s F S of Morgan's Point.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: A slight chance (~20%) for leftover showers at the boarding station through ~7 AM exists. The rest of Wednesday looks dry.

Wind: SW winds near midnight will gradually shift to N/NNE by 9 AM and remain as such for the rest of the day. By 5 AM winds N of Morgan's Point will be at 10 – 16 kts and S of Morgan's Point will be elevated at 20-25 kts. Wind gust of up to 35-40 kts will be possible across all stations, mainly from 5 AM – 2 PM.


Temps: High temps Wednesday will be in the mid 60s F across all stations, Boarding station will be in the upper 60s F.


Visibility: Patchy fog will continue to be possible before daybreak, however the cold front likely ushers any fog out of the area around daybreak. More on the slides above.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions Thursday.

Wind: Sustained winds from the NE throughout the majority of the day will shift more easterly by 6 PM and remain as such for the rest of the evening. Winds N of Morgan's Point will be 5 - 10 kts and winds S of Morgan's Point will be more elevated at 10 - 16 kts. Wind gust of up to 18 kts will be possible N of Morgan's point until 12 PM, and gusts S of Morgan's Point of up to 25 kts will be possible until 2 PM.


Temps: High temps Thursday will be in the mid to upper 70s F. The Boarding Station will be sitting around 70 F.


Visibility: Not anticipating visibility concerns, as winds will be elevated + unfavorable direction.

Wind Speed 10 AM CT


























- After rain moves out today, very low rain chances Fri/Sat/Sun afternoons. Week 1 temperatures to be above normal.
