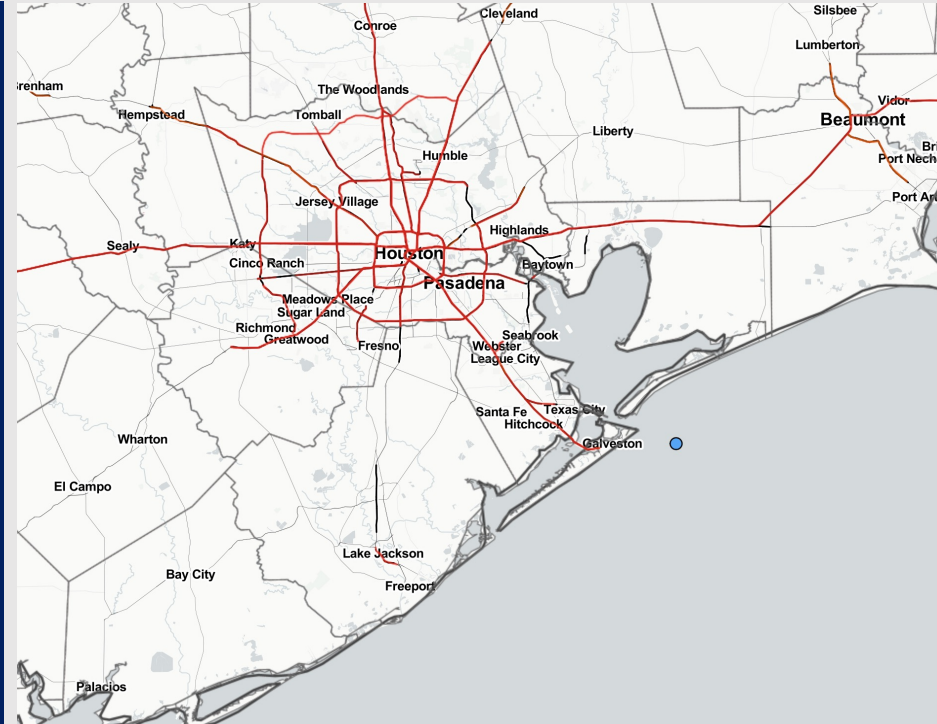

## Weather Headlines

- Anticipating a 10% chance for scattered showers today with mostly dry conditions favored. Both Monday and Tuesday hold slight spotty shower chances as well.
- Winds will generally stay within the 5 - 15 kt range over the next three days. Winds out of the NE for the Boarding Station and out of the N for all other stations. Winds will shift generally out of the ESE/SE early this PM and continue at this direction for the next three days.
- Anticipating a patchy dense fog risk for the Boarding Station, expanding into GALV. Bay around 12 PM and then a threat for widespread dense fog chances increasing after 4. See visibility slide for further details.
- Patchy fog threats will be ongoing over the next three days.

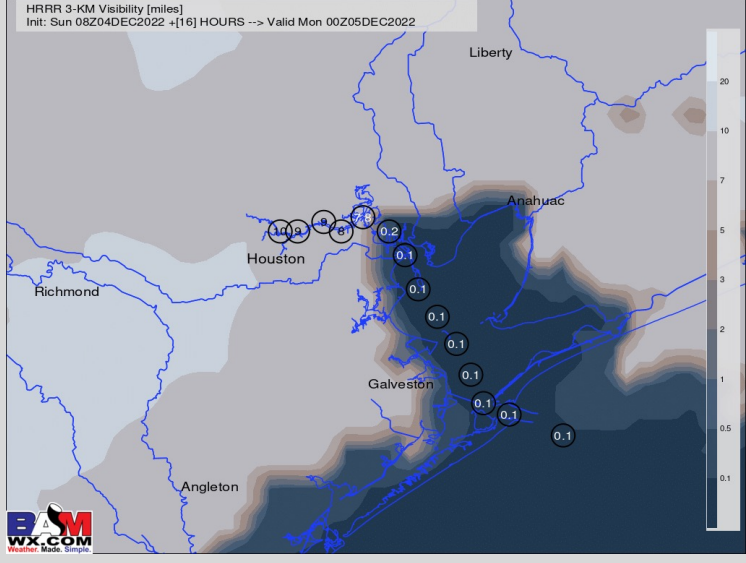
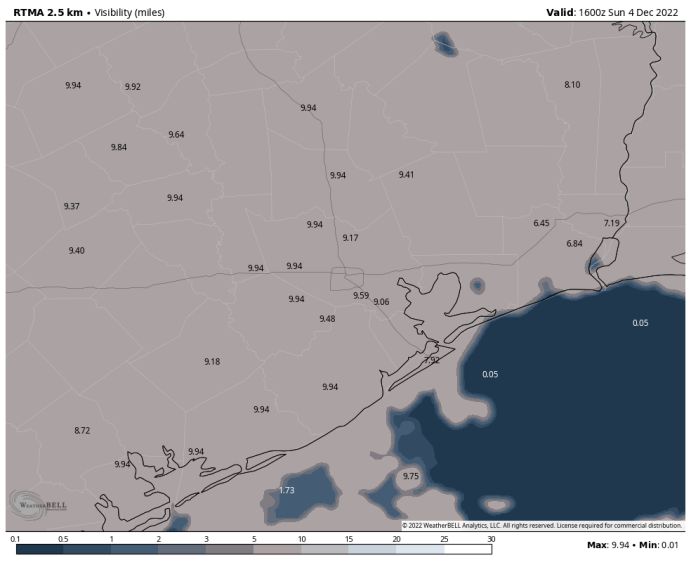

# Houston Pilots Visibility Report

**Reduced Visibility Threat**

NOW – 6 AM MON      **Medium-High**

- Patchy dense fog has been noted near the Boarding Station as the NNE/NE winds bring in fog that is lingering over the Gulf (primary east of stations).
- Anticipating the risk for patchy dense fog coverage to increase around 12 PM today for the Boarding Station and stations South of Morgan’s Point through 4 PM.
- After 4 PM, winds will veer more out of the SE, increasing the likelihood of widespread dense fog with highest risk being around 12 AM – 6 AM MON. Stations South of Morgan’s Point will be at the greatest risk for seeing dense fog with visibilities of 0.5 miles or less.
- Confidence for when this fog event will end Monday is low as winds will continue to be out of the S/SE Monday, allowing for patchy /dense fog to remain a risk. Favoring the 3– 6 AM timeframe for there to be a break as winds briefly shift from the WSW over GALV. Bay.

# Houston Pilots Extended Range Visibility Report



## Wednesday 12/7/22

Southerly flow probable. Patchy fog setup looks possible south of Morgan's Point. Winds over the Houston Metro area look too strong.



## Thursday 12/8/22

Spotty showers with SSW flow will allow for the possibility of patchy fog across all stations. By the afternoon, winds calm to (0 - 5 kts). Area of concern will be around the Boarding Station. All other stations appear to receive patchy fog.



## Friday 12/9/22

Calm winds of less than 5 kts in the AM will allow for patchy fog. By the afternoon, winds shift from the east but still allow for potential patchy fog.

## Forecast Discussion

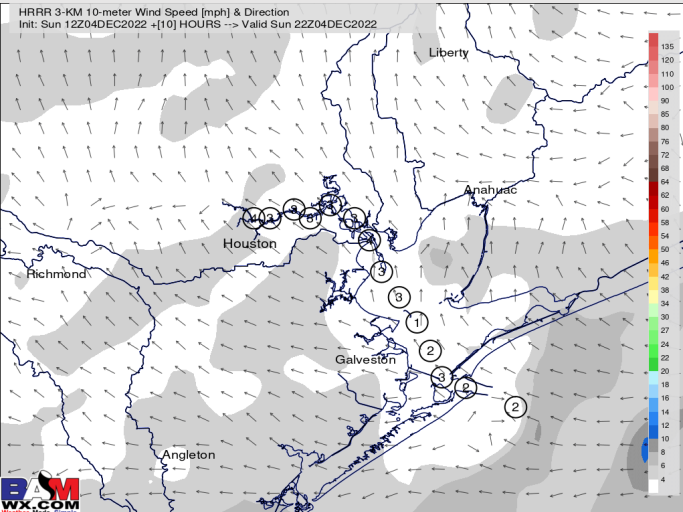
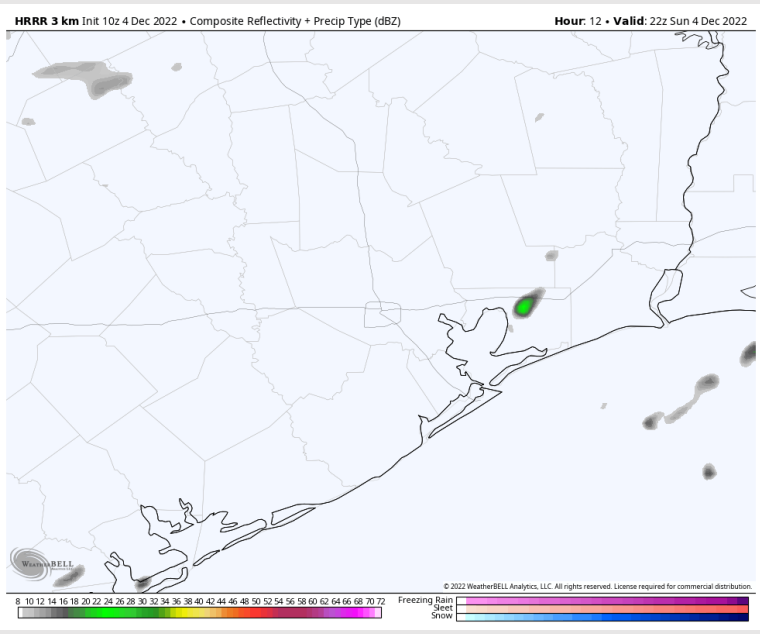
**Precip:** Anticipating mostly dry conditions with a 10% chance for sprinkles / light showers between 3 – 5 PM.

**Wind:** Sustained winds out of the ENE/E through 2PM at 4 – 8 kts, 6 – 10 kts near Alpha / Bravo stations. After 2PM, winds shift to out of the SE through the remainder of the evening, with winds 6 – 10 kts.

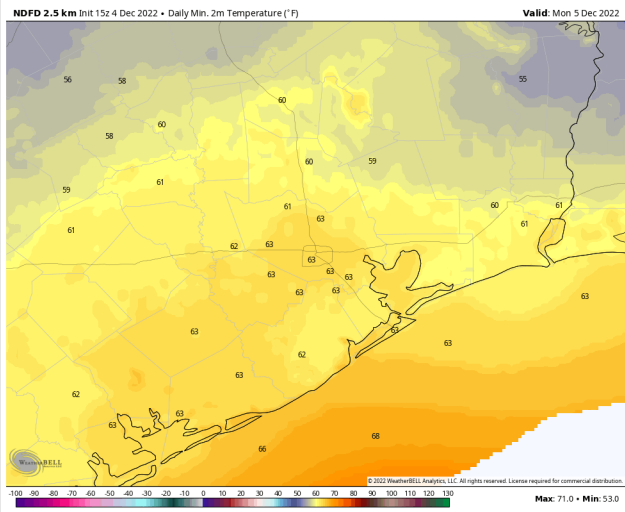
**Temps:** Low temps Monday AM in the low 60s F for all stations.

**Visibility:** Patchy dense fog possible between 12 PM – 4 PM today with widespread dense chances increasing after 4 PM. See visibility slide for more details.

## Forecast Discussion

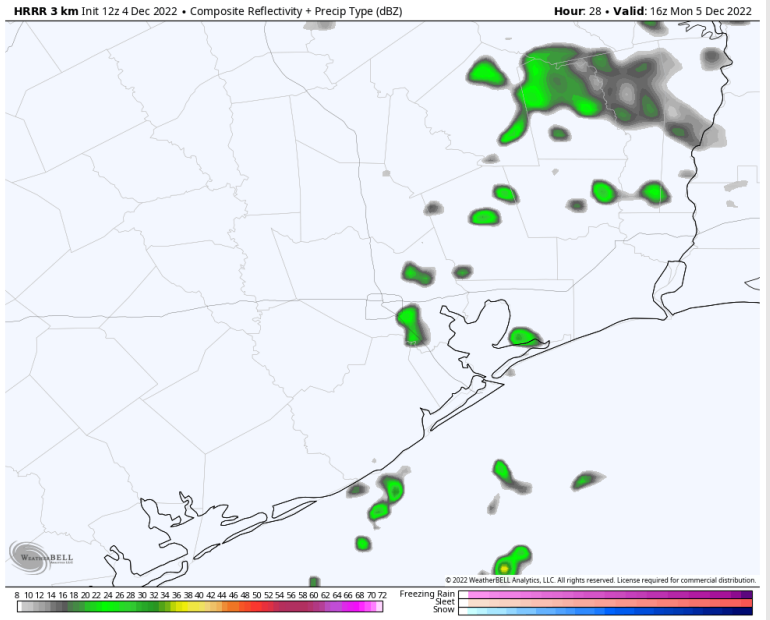
**Precip:** A slight chance (20%) for scattered showers after 4 AM. Anticipating dry conditions after 4 PM.

**Wind:** SSE winds in the morning will shift from the S/SSW by 8 AM and continue for the remainder of the day. Winds N of Morgan's Point will start out at 2 – 7 kts and S of Morgan's Point will be elevated at 5 – 10 kts. By 12 PM winds will pickup across all stations to 10 – 16 kts for the afternoon and evening. An occasional wind gust up to 20 kts will be possible at the Boarding station in the late evening 10 PM – 12 AM timeframe.

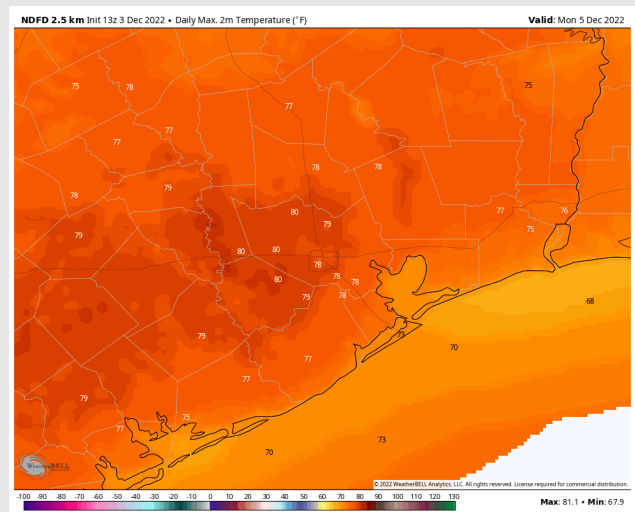
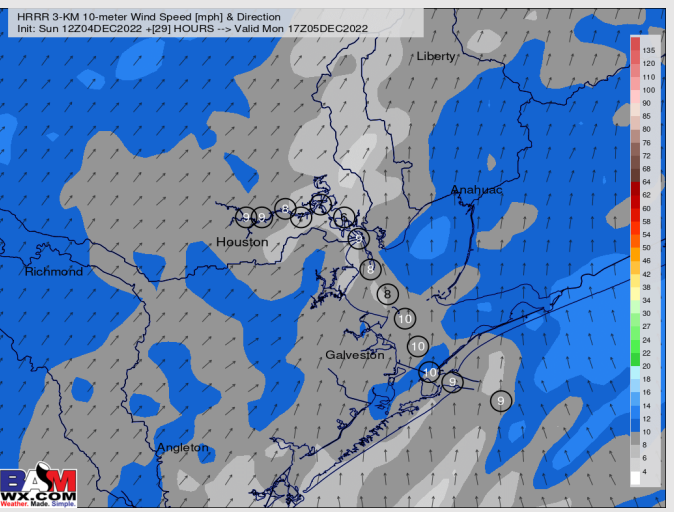
**Temps:** High temperatures Friday will be in the mid to upper 70s F across all stations except the Boarding Station, where temperatures will be around 70 F.

**Visibility:** Patchy dense / dense fog risk Sunday Night will continue into Monday as winds remain out of the S/SE. Winds will briefly veer out of the WSW between 3 – 6 AM possibly allowing for a break in fog. Then winds will resume out of the S/SE. Confidence and coverage of this fog is still low.

## Forecast Discussion

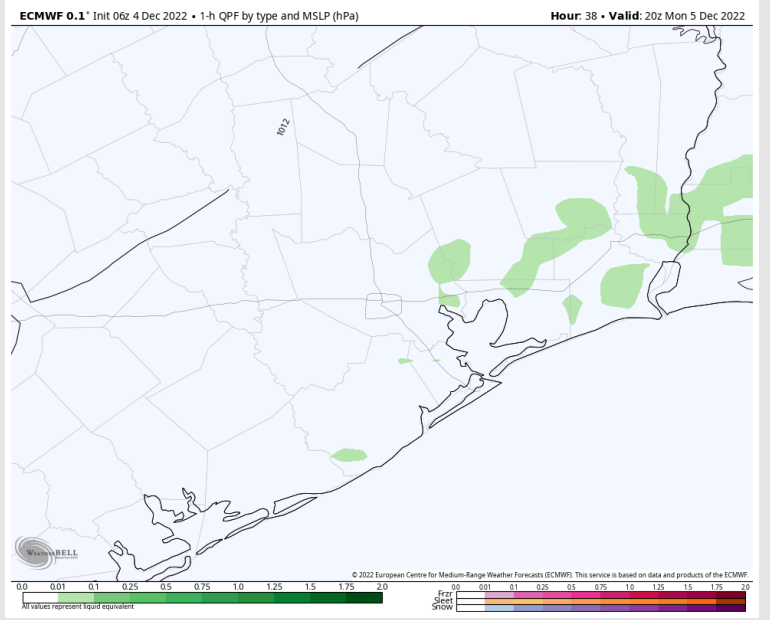
**Precip:** A slight chance (20%) for a pop-up spotty shower in the 12 – 5 PM timeframe, otherwise anticipating dry conditions.

**Wind:** Sustained winds from the S the entire day. Winds N of Morgan’s point will start out at 5 – 9 kts and S of Morgan’s Point will be 9 – 14 kts. Around 10 AM, winds will pickup across all stations to 10 – 15 kts and remain as such for the rest of the evening. Gusts of up to 23 kts will be possible from 11 AM – 5 PM N of Morgan’s Point.

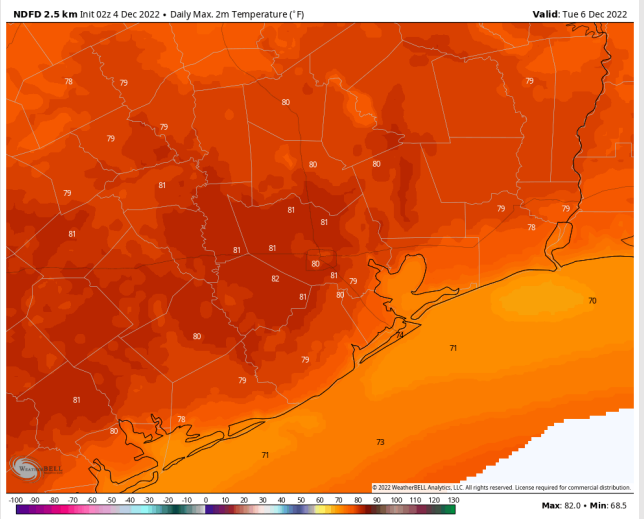
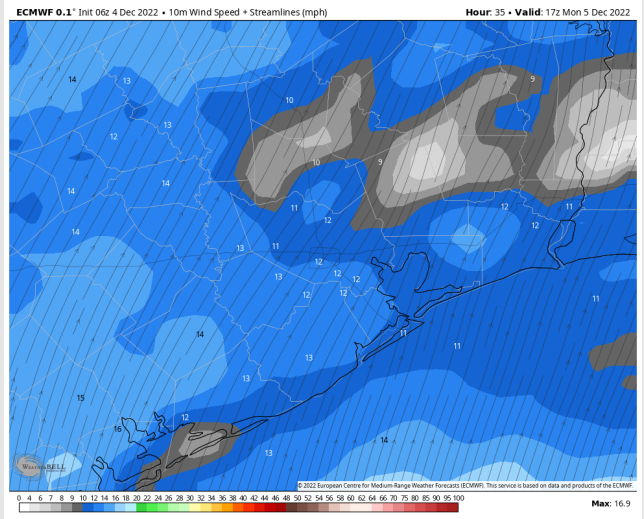
**Temps:** High temps will be in the upper 70s to near 80 F N of Morgan’s Point and in the mid to lower 70s F S of Morgan’s Point.

**Visibility:** A chance for patchy fog will be possible south of station 63/64 in both the morning hours and afternoon. More information will be added in future updates.
