

- Hit and miss pockets of drizzle will be possible the next few days. Not expecting a washout of precipitation.
- Winds will generally stay within the 5 − 15 kt range over the next three days. Winds will be generally out of the ESE/SE and continue at this direction for the next three days. Friday looks to have the calmest winds.






Reduced Visibility Threat


- Areas of patchy to widespread dense fog / reduced visibilities of 0.5 mile or less ongoing for all pilot locations south of Morgan's Point.
- ➤ Between 10 AM and 5 PM Thursday, widespread fog will begin to recede, pulling away first from stations 610 Bridge through 75/76 and become patchier for stations south of 75/76 as winds veer out of the East. Boarding Station will still be at risk for dense fog.
- After 5 PM Thursday, winds will shift back out of the SE allowing for fog to again expand over the region becoming more widespread. The greatest risk for dense fog at all stations will begin again after 12 AM Friday.
- Areas with visibilities less than 0.5 mile will be possible with this threat.








12 AM FRI - 12 AM SAT

Medium -High

- Fog risk will carry over from Thursday. Favoring fog to be most widespread and dense from 12 AM – 10 AM Friday.
- Between 10 AM and 3 PM Friday, widespread fog will become patchier for all stations as winds temporarily lose their SE flow, angling a bit more out of the East. Boarding Station will be at the greatest risk for continued patchy dense fog.
- After 3 PM Friday, winds will shift again directly out of the SE allowing for fog to again be possible over the region, potentially impacting all stations through 12 AM Saturday, however confidence is low for exact coverage and timing at this distance.
- Areas with visibilities less than 0.5 mile will be possible with this threat.

Sunday 12/11/22

Slightly lower confidence on the specifics as a front will turn winds more variable and lead to the lowest potential of fog out through the weekend.



Tuesday 12/13/22

Anticipating wind vectors to remain out of the SW pending an approaching front. Warmer than average temperatures in addition to higher dew points may allow for some fog during the evening hours.


Forecast Discussion

Precip: A slight chance (20%) for a few pockets of drizzle/ light showers during the 11 AM – 4 PM timeframe. A few hundredths of an inch will be possible, but the showers will be very spotty in coverage. Dry conditions outside of this timeframe today.


Wind: Sustained winds from the SE for the entire day. Winds will start out at 5-10 kts until 1 PM, before increasing to 8-13 kts. Winds will stay here until 8 PM, when they will decrease back down to 5-10 kts.


Temps: High temperatures will be near 80 F N of Morgan's Point and in the mid to lower 70s F S of Morgan's Point.

Visibility: Patchy dense / widespread dense fog will again be possible throughout the day today. More details on the slides above.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A 20% chance for isolated showers will be possible from the 6 AM – 6 PM timeframe Friday. Pockets of precip is expected to be hit and miss and rather light in terms on intensity, with higher intensity rains staying north and west of HOU.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE for almost the entire day. Winds will be at 3-8 kts until 12 PM. After 3 PM, winds will increase to 6-11 kts and remain here throughout the PM hours on Friday.


Temps: High temps Friday will be in the mid to upper 70s F north of the Boarding Station, and around 70 F at the Boarding Station.


Visibility: Patchy and perhaps dense fog will certainly be possible once again for the AM hours and early afternoon. More details in the slides above.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Dry conditions until 12 PM on Saturday. From 12-5 PM, 30% chance of scattered showers/storms around the area, with coverage increasing to 70-80% after 5 PM and continuing throughout the rest of the evening.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the S/SE throughout the day. Winds at 5-10 kts until 11 AM. From 11 AM – 5 PM, winds will increase to 8-13kts. After 5 PM, winds will calm down to 2-7 kts throughout the rest of the evening.


Temps: High temperatures for Saturday will be near 80 F/high 70's north of the boarding station and low 70's near the boarding station.


Visibility: Patchy fog is possible during the AM hours, with lower confidence in fog due to elevated winds in the afternoon hours.

Wind Speed 11 AM CT







