

Weather Headlines

- A slight chance for sprinkles this afternoon.
 Increasing chances for showers and storms will
 exist for Tuesday and Wednesday thanks to a cold
 front expected to work through the area.
- Winds will be generally from the SE for today and tomorrow with a frontal passage shifting winds from the NW and keeping winds from the NW for awhile on Wednesday – Saturday. Tuesday/Wednesday look to be a breezy days with wind gusts of 25 – 30 kts possible.
- The front passing Wednesday AM will wipe out fog chances. Low to almost 0 fog threat for the back half of the week with NW winds.





Low

- The threat fog widespread fog remains low, however the threat for reduced visibility of a few miles is there given a very low cloud deck.
- A few pockets of rather patchy fog and a low cloud deck holds the potential to drop visibilities of 2-4 miles. This threat primarily exists for stations south of 25/26. The "best" threat for this reduced visibilities will be from 6 AM CT this morning out through ~10 AM CT.
- Working through the rest of the day, a low cloud deck/misty haze can keep visibilities lower than 5 miles, but dense fog of <1 mile is not favored.
- Winds look to be just high enough to prevent widespread fog.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions for the morning and early afternoon. A 10% chance for a pocket of drizzle will be possible from 2 PM through 6 PM.

Wind: Winds will begin from the NE in the morning and shift from the East by 9 AM, then finally from the ESE from 1 PM to the remainder of the day. Winds will be at 4 – 9 kts across all stations through 8 AM, then pickup to 8 – 13 kts by 10 AM. Winds will increase even more S of Morgan's point in the afternoon to 12 – 16 kts by 7 PM and remain as such for the evening.


Temps: High temps Monday will be in the mid 70s F north of Morgan's Point and in the low 70s F south of Morgan's Point.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for the early morning hours. At around 7 AM, very hit and miss rain showers will enter the region and last through mid-afternoon (30% chances). Increased chances for precipitation (showers and thunderstorms) happen between 5 – 11 PM. Spotty showers could linger through midnight as a cold front passes the area.

Wind: SSE winds in the morning and afternoon will before shifting out of the SW around sundown. Winds will start out at 9 – 14 kts in the morning then increase to 13 – 18 kts by noon with gusts of 18 – 23 knots at the boarding station. Winds likely calm closer to midnight before the next front arrives early Wed AM.


Temps: High temps Tuesday will be in the upper 70s F north of Morgan's Point and in the mid 70s F south of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Certainly worth watching, but currently favoring winds to be just strong enough to limit fog potential.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: As a cold front passes the area in the 12-3 AM window Wednesday, showers and a few thunderstorms will be around the area. Lower confidence on exact specifics as data differs on how quickly the front can depart offshore, but hit and miss precip continuing into the afternoon and evening certainly looks possible at this distance. Would favor chances of 40% beyond 6 AM.

Wind: Variable wind direction in the early morning hours from 12 AM – 7 AM will favor a NW wind by 8 AM and remain as such for the rest of the day. Winds north of the Boarding Station will start out at 4 – 7 kts, and while the Boarding Station will be around 9 – 12 kts. By 10 AM winds will pickup across all stations to 11 – 14 kts N of Morgan's point and 16 – 23 kts S of Morgan's Point. From 1 PM through 5 PM winds will calm to 3 – 6 kts N of Morgan's Point for the rest of the day, and 8 – 14 kts S of Morgan's point for the rest of the day. Wind gusts 8 – 11 AM will be around 22 – 25 kts for a brief period across all stations. After 12 PM, Gusts can be as high as 32 kts S of Morgan's Point. After 3 PM expecting gusty winds to subside, with pockets of up to 20 kts still possible at the Boarding Station.


Temps: Much cooler. High temps Wednesday will be in the mid 60s F across all stations.


Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns once the front passes. However, heavier thunderstorms could reduce visibilities to less than 2 miles for brief periods mainly at the Boarding Station.

Wind Speed 10 AM CT
























- Minor, hit and miss light rain chances will be possible tomorrow with better rain chances moving in Tuesday and Wednesday. Anticipating temps staying above average.
