



- Waves at the boarding station of 5-7 feet will be possible out through the early AM hours Tuesday (~9 AM).
- Please check slides below for increased winds today that continue into the overnight hours.
- The fog / high wind threat fade for Tue PM/Wed/Thu/Friday AM.






- ➤ While most of the widespread dense fog has lifted around the area, pockets of reduced visibility of less than 3 miles continue to be noted.
- ➤ Out through ~6-7 PM there can be isolated pockets of reduced visibility around the stations (best risk south of 51/52) before chances then rise for more widespread fog into the evening hours.
- ➤ There's some uncertainty in the forecast after ~ 11 PM tonight as winds may turn just SSW enough to limit the fog potential for the pre-dawn hours Tuesday. Updates will be sent on this into the evening.
- > Stations North of Morgan's Point hold the best opportunity to avoid seeing widespread fog through the evening hours.






- As touched on the prior slide, from 11 PM Mon to 5 AM Tue there is lower confidence on just how expansive the fog can be as just a very slight shift in the wind will have a big impact on fog potential. We will favor patchy fog in that window with fog chances increasing into the daybreak hours.
- ➤ The main focus later into Tuesday will be the timing of a cold front that will finally!! usher out fog chances. Currently targeting this to occur in the 11 AM 1 PM window Tuesday (northern stations near 610 bridge in the earlier portion of that window, southern stations near the boarding station toward the end of the timeframe).

Forecast Discussion

Precip: On and off pockets of drizzle to light rain showers will continue to be possible as the low cloud deck sticks around. Any precip likely stays rather light, but likely looking at precip chances continuing through the day today.

Wind: Sustained winds will continue from the S for the majority of the day, veering from the SSW by 8 PM. Winds will continue to sit 10-15 knots for all stations, with the boarding station closer to 15-20 knots. After 3 PM winds at the boarding station run the biggest risk of sitting 18-23 knots sustained, however there is slightly lower confidence on just how high winds can reach.


Temps: Low Temps will fade into the lower to mid 60s for the stations.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Precip continues through the early morning hours until coverage become a bit more increased between 6 – 11 AM. After ~1PM, favoring dry conditions for the rest of the day. A few stronger storms with gusts 20-25+ knots cannot be ruled out.

Wind: Sustained winds out of the SSW at 10 – 15 kts with gusts of 13 – 18 kts before front moves through around 11 AM – 1 PM. After 1 PM, winds shift from the NW at 7 – 12 kts and last through the rest of the day.


Temps: High temperatures on Tuesday will be upper 60s F near the Boarding Station and lower 70s F for all other stations.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring a dry day for Wednesday.

Wind: Light westerly winds in the AM will be more sustained from the NW by 12 PM, and then veer from the north during the late evening (10 PM). Winds will be 7 – 11 kts from 9 AM – 4 PM across all stations. After 4 PM winds will subside to 4 – 7 kts. A few pockets of up to 11 kts will be possible at the Boarding Station and 11/12 from 5 PM – 12 AM. A few wind gusts of up to 18 kts will be possible north of Morgan's Point from 11 AM – 3 PM.


Temps: High temperatures Monday will be in the upper 60s F north of Morgan's Point and in the mid to lower 60s F south of Morgan's Point.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns at this time.

Wind Speed 1 PM CT



























- Rain chances today and tomorrow looking like rather high chances for precip. Mid to late this week will be on the drier side. Temperatures expected to be much above average.
